1. Material inclosed has been examined by the Military Intelligence Division and noted by A. C. of S., OPD, and A. C. of S., G-1.

1. S/Sgt Edward C Witmer, Jr., ASN 33076737, ENG, Unasgd, was captured by the Japanese on Bataan, 9 April 1942, and was removed to Cabanatuan, Luzon, P.I., held there until he was released on 31 January 1945 by the Sixth Ranger Battalion of the United States Marine Corps. He is traveling under par 20, SO 67, dated 14 March 1945, issued by ASP Ninth Service Command, Letterman General Hospital, San Francisco, California, passing through this Station enroute to his home, Strasburg, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, for a ninety (90) day furlough for rehabilitation purposes.

2. Sgt Witmer stated that a Captain H. V. Ingersoll, CE, of the 803d Engineer Battalion, AVN (SEP) in August 1944 turned over to him all remaining allied papers of the 803d Engineer Battalion when he (Capt Ingersoll) was transferred to Japan as a Prisoner of war.
