① Under "Remarks," dates shown are date of Action or of wound, not date of order. G.O. # 24 PCAC was published April 14, 1942; G.O. # 29 PCAC was published April 24, 1942.

② 1st Lt. Herbert E Pace Jr. was killed in action on April 28, 1942. He was recommended for a Silver Star for Gallantry in Action on April 12, 1942; he was again recommended for citation (Oak Leaf) for Gallantry in Action on April 28, 1942. Both recommendations were approved by Bn and Regt'l Commanders and forwarded for final action to PCAC. Favorable action is known to have been given there. However, the undersigned saw no order published awarding the medals. Surrender of Corregidor intervened.

③ St Sgts Paul B. Davis and Bernard O. Hopkins,<sup>and Pfc Galen L. Martin</sup> were both recommended for citation for Gallantry in action on April 12, 1942. Letter was returned for correction, delayed in transmittal, and although approved by Regt'l C.O. was not published prior to surrender. These soldiers are highly deserving of the awards. See Note ⑤.

4. A number of Silver Stars and Purple Hearts are due to men for Gallantry in action and for wounds received in action too late for recommendations to be submitted. A brief history for the record follows:-

On May 5-6, 1942 the Japanese assaulted Corregidor. Chicago was ordered to man local defense (foxhole) positions. A heavy artillery barrage fell directly on the foxhole and M.G. positions and dive bombers bombed and strafed the vicinity. Under these conditions:- Near Sgt G.C. Smith's M.G., Sgt Smith, Pfc's Thompson and House, and Pfc's Stanfill, Freeman, and Sumrow were injured. (Stanfill and Freeman seriously) Sgt Smith, although himself wounded, helped House to the old Catalog C.P. (former West Defense Sta.) (House's leg was pierced by shell fragments). Sgt Smith went to Chicago to report to 1st Lt Fortney, Acting B.C. (Capt. Ames temporarily at Regimental Hq. on official business) Lt. Fortney gave permission for removal of the wounded to a place of shelter and first aid. (No Japanese landing forces were in the vicinity and Bn Hq. okayed men leaving foxholes). Returning to his M.G., Sgt Smith assisted by Pfc Wright, and Pfc's Creevy and Watson carried Pfc Stanfill to Catalog, while Cpl Davis, W.E. Pfc Shiflett, Pfc's Smith, G.T. and Turner, J.A. took Pfc Freeman there. Then Sgt Smith and Pfc Serna went to Chicago for stretchers but found that Pfc Holm had already left for Catalog with two. Pfc Saabiron (Pfc) and Pfc Gorman returned to Catalog with Sgt Smith to attend the wounded. Pfc Thompson was taken to the shelter of the concrete-covered gasoline tanks where Sgt Perry removed a shell fragment from Thompson's back. Pfc Shook was killed in action at his foxhole by artillery fire. Pfc.
