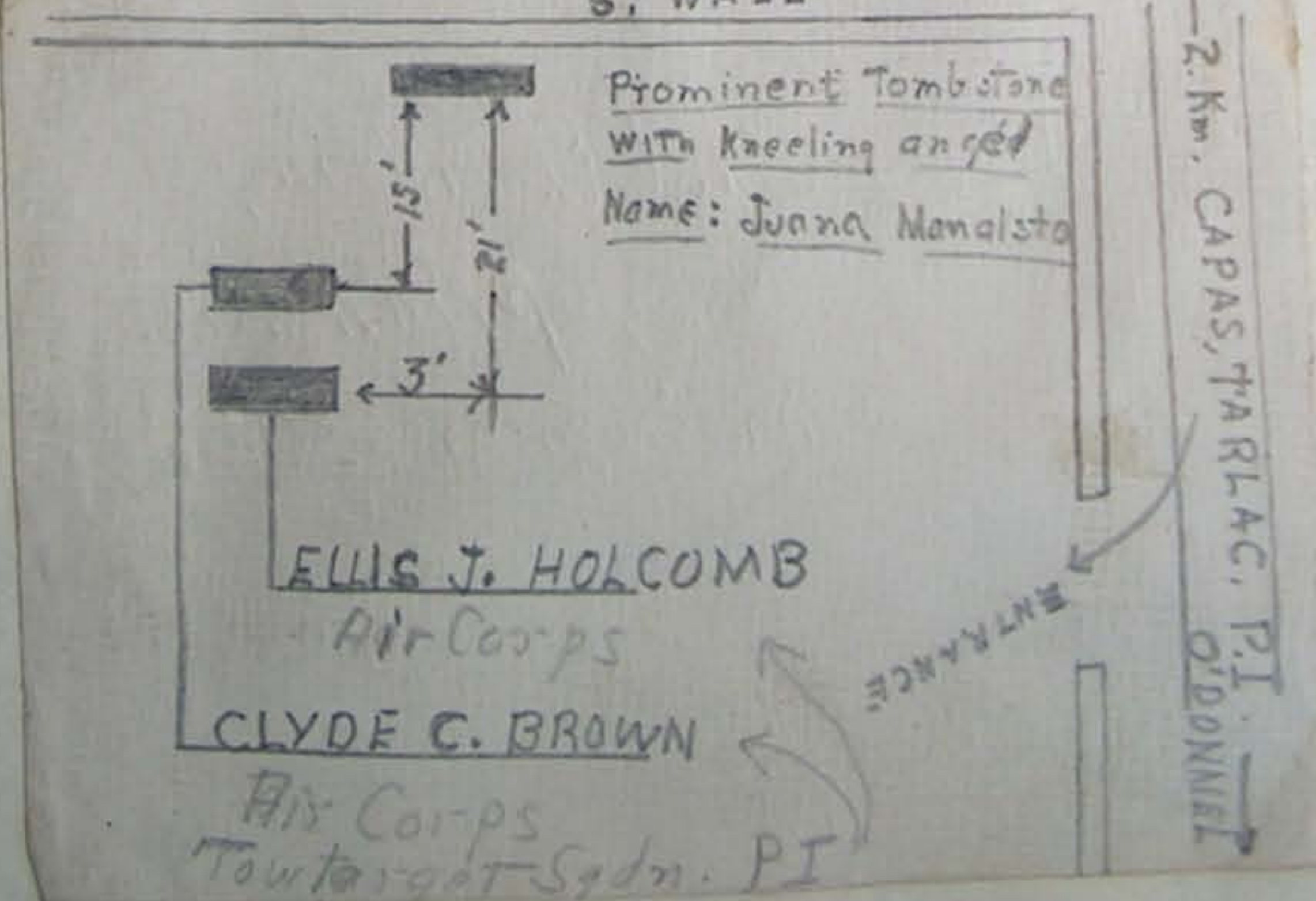
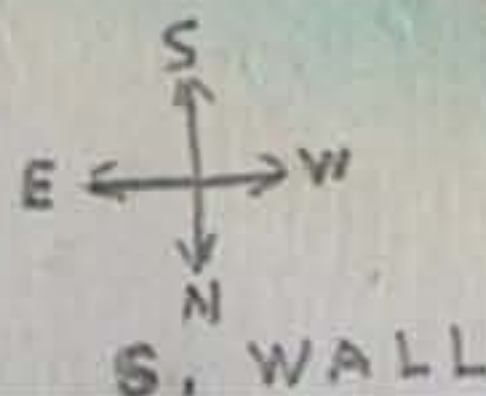



It being impracticable for the Government to furnish rations in kind, three (3) meals each for twenty-one (21) men will be furnished on party meal tickets under the provisions of paragraph 2, AR 30-2215, as published in War Department Circular No. 51, 1941 as amended by War Department Circulars Nos. 73 and 87, 1941, for such meals as the length of the journey may require at a rate not to exceed \$0.75 per meal or not to exceed \$1.00 per meal per man when meals are taken in the dining car.

The Quartermaster Corps will furnish the necessary rail transportation. The travel directed is necessary in the military service and payment when made is chargeable to procurement authorities FD 1437 P 3-06 A 0410-2 and QM 1620 P 54-01, 54-02, 54-13, 54-07 A 0525-"D".


