Pasay Concentration Camp Camp Rules

1. Anyone trying to escape will be shot. If he escapes all other men will be shot. Anyone trying to communicate with persons on the outside will be shot.
2. Reading only from 7 to 9 P.M.
3. All Japanese sentries and soldiers will be saluted at all times except when men are working.
4. Military discipline and courtesy will be enforced at all times.
5. Daily Schedule:
 - 4:30 a.m. Gally force gets up begins to get breakfast
 - 6:00 a.m. Get up, clean rooms, stay outside till 8
 - 6:30 a.m. Morning muster and ten minute exercise
 - 7:00 a.m. Breakfast 1
 - 7:30 a.m. Outside working detail is formed, all men muster.

until 1:30 P.M. and from the

8:00 A.M. Work begins

12:00 Lunch + rest period

1:30 P.M. Resume work

4:30 P.M. Work ceases - men on inside details may use showers and wash clothes.

6:00 P.M. - Dinner

7:00 P.M. Evening muster, no more washing or taking showers.

8:00 P.M. Men return to their rooms, and may go to sleep.

9:00 P.M. All men must be in bed. All quiet until time to get up. Sick men may remain in quarters. Men going to latrine after 9 must obtain permission from the NCO on duty. During the day men may enter their rooms to obtain personal equipment, and leave immediately. In rainy weather the schedule is the same except that men not working must stay in their rooms all day except at meal time.

b. Smoking hours:

From 7 a.m. till work party forms. From

12 noon until 1:30 P.M. and from the time work party returns till 7 P.M. when there is no work, smoking ceases at 8:00 A.M. and begins at 4:30 P.M. Smoking at the barracks will be permitted only in the court. no smoking in the latrine or the area behind the building

8 - men will stay in uniform at all times with Camp no. on shirt and shoes on unless otherwise directed. Shirts will not be worn on working days from 5 P.M. to 7 P.M. but will be hung up to dry. Hats will be worn when working only. at all other times they will be at head of bed. Personal hats will not be worn at any times.

10 -

11 - no games and music will be allowed in this camp, unless there is permission obtained from the Japanese authorities.

12 - Violations of the above orders will be punished according to the seriousness of the offence committed.
