SUBJECT: BC Activities, Report of

TO : CO, 118th Inf., 106th Div.
(Thru CO, 2nd Bn., 118th Inf. Regt.)

1. The following activities of the B.C. under Capt. S. Javeloza who patrolled the places of Maganoy, Sapakan and adjoining sities are hereby submitted to wit:

(a) On Feb. 15, 1944 seventeen (17) BC men of Capt. Javeloza with only six (6) of them armed attacked and killed six (6) innocent moros namely: Kalim; Sangcad; Manwagan; Makakana; Dolunan and Nunuken, at Sampao Maganoy.

(b) On Feb. 16, the following day the same number of BC men attacked the same place and killed again eight (8) innocent moros namely: Mateng; Agao; Katine; Guiadel; Asi; Kalingket; Tomanas and Cosin.

(c) They proceeded to Karandangan, Maganoy where almost all the properties of the victims in their attack at Sampao and also the properties of those who had evacuated. Then got all the properties that they can see such as Palay, jewelries, money, clothes and etc. amounting more than TEN THOUSAND (P10,000.00) PESOS.

(d) Capt. Javeloza with his men then proceeded to Kayakaya then to Nabundas. Then from here he was ordered to meet Gen. Paulino Santos at Takurong.

2. The undersigned fully believed that Capt. Cumbay and Capt. Javeloza are working together hand to hand. One proof is that the men of Lt. Bueno and Lt. Datu Disomocol Camong and themselves are always with this BC.
