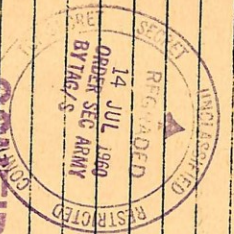

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the 94<sup>th</sup> Company Separate, Lanzo Military Sector, Kibiting Solo Battalion Unit, United States Army Forces in the Philippines, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

1. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
2. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
3. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
4. A definite organization was not established.
5. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
6. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.
7. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian cooperation and family obligations.
