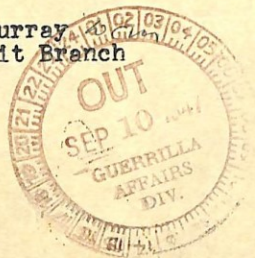

Dear Mr. Brillo:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 28 July 1947, requesting recognition of a group of patriotic citizens under the command of Raymundo G. Cantara.

As announced in a special press release from Headquarters AFWESPAC, dated 1 February 1946, the closing date for acceptance of unit requests for recognition was 15 March 1946. Your request, dated 28 July 1947, is far from complying with this closing date, and cannot, therefore, be accepted for consideration.

For your information, the closing date for acceptance of individual non-casualty requests for recognition was 15 March 1947. The closing date for acceptance of casualty claims was 31 July 1947, the date you erroneously refer to as the final date for acceptance of all types of claims for guerrilla recognition. It is considered that all persons who were qualified in applying for recognition in any one of the categories mentioned above have had ample opportunity to prepare and submit a request for recognition prior to the closing date applicable in their specific case.
