Dear Mr. Sahagun:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 12 December 1947, requesting individual reconsideration of your claim for recognition as a member of the McGuire Guerrilla Forces, Calapandayan Sector, Subic, Zambales, which unit was not favorably considered for recognition by this headquarters on 11 April 1947.

In this regard, it is desired to emphasize that each individual member and each subordinate element of a claimant querrilla unit receives separate and distinct consideration for recognition when the unit as a whole is taken under consideration, with the view that sach individual can further corroborate the alleged services claimed by the unit as a whole. Therefore, it is not the policy of this head-quarters to accept requests for reconsideration from individual members or subordinate elements of a unit which was previously not favorably considered for recognition. Taking cognizance of this, it is necessary to inform you that you as the commanding officer of the McGuire Guerrilla Forces received just and adequate consideration for recognition when your services were evaluated with the study of the unit as a whole.

In view of the above, your request for individual reconsideration of your claim for recognition as a member of the McCuire Guerrilla Forces, Calapandayan Sector, Subic, Zambales, cannot be accepted.

Report on "MacWire Guerrilla Forces, Calapandayan Sector, Subje. Zambales

- Second Lieutenant James R. Benton proceeded to Subic, Zambeles, on 12 March 1947, to investigate the MacWire Guerrilla Forces, Calapandayan Sector, Subic, Zambeles.
 - 2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached unit file)
 - 3. FINDINGS:
- a. The following persons were interviewed and their statements are reflected in the findings:

Capt Manuel Barretto CO. Maloma Sector, ZMD. Magsaysay's Guerrillas Capt L. E. Lausares Mayor, Subic (Cant) Mrs Elizabeth Fontillas Ha ZMD Cant Tazaro Cawagas CO. San Narcise Sector, ZMD. Magsaysay's Guerrillas Capt Numeriano Fabre CO. La Paz Sector, ZMD, Magsaysay's Guerrillas 1st It Benito Noveles Chief of Police, Subic, Zambales, and Sunic Sector, ZMD, Magsaysay's Guerrillas Ex-Off. Subic Sector, ZMD, Capt Edwardo Lesaca Magsavsavis Guerrillas Juan Acheta (1st Lt) MacWire Guerrilla Forces 11 Eugenio Panelo (2nd Lt) Rufino Leyda (2nd Lt) Subic Sector, ZMD, Lt Rosendo Soriano ... Magsaysay's Guerrillas

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. This organization under the command of Captain Benito Sahagun remained absolutely passive during the occupation. It was not in any sense an organized guerrilla unit due to the fact that the majority of the members were members of other guerrilla units. No supporting evidence was presented to substantiate their claims of having actively engaged in intelligence work, propagenda, or sabotage. Interviews with Juan Ancheta, Eugenio Panelo, and Rufino Leyda indicate that the unit never existed. The three men, residents of Subic, and listed on the roster of the subject unit as officers, stated that they had never heard of the MacWire Guerrilla Forces and that they had not been aware of the fact that their names had been placed on this roster. Captain L. E. Lausares, CO, Subic Sector, Squadron C, ZMD, Magsaysay's Guerrillas, verified the fact that these three men had been members of his command together with the following men whose names also appear on the roster of MacWire Guerrilla Forces: (1) 1st Sgt Jose Salang. (2) Sgt Cecilio del Carmed, (3) Sgt Jacinto Fedilus, (4) Cpl Feliciano Baloy, (5) Pfc Elino Atienza, (6) Pvt Pio Tonil, (7) Florentino Timaen, (8)

Pvt Lope Doctolero, (9) Pvt Antonio delos Santos, and (10) Pvt Gregorio Ficalle. Mrs Elizabeth Fontilles, an American women and recognized Captein of Headquarters, Zambales Military District, stated that she had never been sware of the existence of this unit. Civilians in the vicinity of Subic were not familiar with the subject unit as having been an organized guerrilla unit.

- c. This unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. Following statements of leading guerrilla leaders in this province, who are already recognized, indicate that the unit did not exist as an active guerrilla unit during the occupation.
- d. A definite organization was not established by this unit because the officers and emlisted men during the occupation were either members of other guerrilla units or lived with their families and pursued normal divilian occupation.
- e. Ferformance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its commanding officer because officers and enlisted men of this unit were members of other guerrilla units.
 - f. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization because none of the members interviewed could show any outstanding achievement accomplished during the occupation nor show any supporting evidence which would substantiate claims made in the unit history.
- g. This is an initial investigation of an initial roster. There are no members worthy of recognition and the unit suffered no ossualties.
- h. No useful purpose will be accomplished by further investigation of this unit.
- 4. POINTICAL ASPECTS: This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.
- RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the MacWire Guerrilla Forces, Galapendayan Sector, Subic, Zambales, be not favorably considered for recognition.

ISTORY

UNIT FILE

The MACKIRE CUERFILLA FORGES was organized sometimes 1942 by an American Officer named Captain Macwire in his mountain Headquarter in the wilderness of Zambales mountain.

In the town.of Subic, Zamboles, F. 1., Wwienors, humortaine Flores was appointed by ognetin Macrine to extend the organization of the Madullas GURRELLA FORUSS. Portunetely, the Calapandayan Sector was one among he successfully organized and independently carried the activities of the restatant newspert.

Not long after the organization of the golapundayan Sector, a Gonap or Sakadalian Say Propored the activities of Ka-Mayor Numriano Flores to the Japanes Garrison of Subtle, Zambales. The Japanes Gonamidia Officer of the Garrison ordered the arrest of Ka-Mayor Flores. A sound of Japanes estables searched his bruck, posted a guyrd in his house day and might. When Ka-Mayor Flores length the mostly and remained here till he contracted a decrease which forced his family and hisself to left Subte secretly for Marial, and resided there till his death.

After the death of we wayor Flores, the Calapandoyan Sector continued factioning where in this connection, 100% of moments of the organization were arrested by the Japaness solders and garrisoned for so many days in the sunstite and given no food nor water. Mostly were released and some were sent to Ibe, Zarbales for further investigation and recained there 3 months and released halfdeath due to the indumnant

panishment they suffered.

When the periosn Victorious Forces landed in Leyte, the Janesee soldiers restricted the novement of all able male restdent of Calapandaya where even to find means something to eat was impossible. We suffered great starvation, some of our members evacuated to places where they can freely find something to eat and the undersigned also went to Menila for safety as he was also being wakhed by the Sakidalist Spr.

When the 41st Division of American Forces landed in Zomboales, Acting Commander Licut, Juan Incheta with Lt. Tycenio Panelo with some of the abailable repers continued their

ectivities.

Distroying all means of Japanese Communication. Gutting trees near the road in order to imposible the Jap trucks to meet in the north the American landing forces in Sen Acresso and SanBelips.

When the American forces reached subic, all available men voluntarily assisted the advancing American Forces up to Olongano where some of the mon returned home and of them continued

their services with the advancing American forces till the liberation of all Central Luzon where they were given released and go home but they have not been paid for said services. The undersigned who was then in Manila, co-operated with the resistand movement with the President Quezon Own Guerella Unit in Velasques St., Tondo, under the Command of Captain Teigdor Batoyong. He participated with the men of said Guerellas in the famoust battle of Philippine Manufacturing Company of Velasques Street, Tondo, Manila till the defending Japanese forces were wifeout in said Factory.
