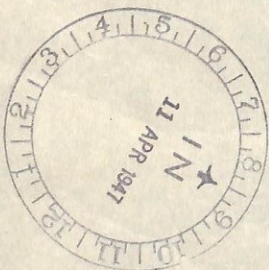

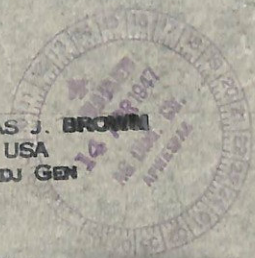
Special press release from Public Relations Office, AFWASPAC, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla units would be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946. The recent press release from Public Relations Office, PHILRYCOM, further announced the closing date of 15 March 1947 for the submission of individual claims for non-casualty recognition.

It is generally considered that all concerned had ample opportunity to prepare applications for unit recognition by 15 March 1946. In the opinion of this headquarters, your request for an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not adequately justified and, therefore, is not favorably considered.

Returned herewith is the roster of Unit II, Division IV, 95th Infantry Regiment, 92nd Division, Leyte Area Command.

This decision does not preclude individual request for casualty recognition by injured personnel or their heirs. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.
