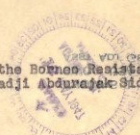

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter dated 15 November 1946,
Subject: "Re Status, Unit of," in which you request recognition of
the Borneo Resistance Force under your command.

Special press release from Public Relations Office, AFWESPAC,
dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of
guerrilla units would be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March
1946. This press release received wide circulation in the newspapers
and was broadcast over local radio stations.

Your request for recognition of the Borneo Resistance Force was
received at this headquarters 6 January 1947, in an envelope postmarked
27 December 1946 and does not meet the deadline referred to above.

It is considered generally that all concerned have had ample
opportunity to prepare applications for recognition. In the opinion
of this headquarters, your request for an extension of the time limit
mentioned above is not adequately justified and is not, therefore,
favorably considered.

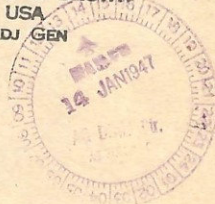

1. The undersigned request information as to the present standing and status of the unit that was organized under his command on February 1945 until the date when the Australian Forces were withdrawn from this area.

2. Our resistance force at Jambangan Borneo was organized immediately after a conference with the Commanding Officer, Sulu area Command who then inducted me into his outfit and assigned me in charge of the intelligence work at Borneo areas. This was organized upon initiative when I saw danger against my life, family, people, properties, and above all to defend the cause for which America was fighting this war. But after the war was over we received no benefit from any Government for our services rendered. We believe the Generous American Government will reward us for our services rendered for the good cause I then endorse this matter to the champion Of Democracy to settle our troubles as advised by Governor of the British North Borneo Colonial Government for final action and disposition because this government is washing her hands regarding our cause leaving it to the American Government for consideration.

3. It is also requested that the Army representatives be sent to this area to investigate out situation for the following reasons:

(a) All orders of the Commanding Officer, Sulu Area Command were carried to the latter and executed promptly resulting to one of the orders were killing of Jap spies and Cola abreactionists which relatives are now filing complain in court.

(b) Officers and men of this outfit are claiming for their salaries.

(c) Expenditures used during the operation of this organization are to be paid as it is a loan from the people.

(d) Officers and men are waiting for final disposition of the government concern with their services.

4. With all these reasons we are vexed to what government or people we appeal for our services. To The British government it remains valueless to them. To the people who were loyal during the war is a mockery as propagated by former notorious spies and Collaborators who are now holding responsible positions in the government and prosecuting guerrillas in return. And we appeal for justice for ours is not justified for justice delayed is justice denied.
