Dear Colonel Adevos:

This will acknowledge receipt of the request for recognition of the Nasugbu Women Civilian Volunteers, attached to the 1st Battalion, 49th Regiment, Hunters-ROTC, forwarded by your headquarters, 6 March 1947.

A special press release from Public Relations Office, AFWESPAC, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla units will be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946.

The request for recognition of the Nasugbu Women Civilian Volunteers, attached to the 1st Battalion, 49th Regiment, Hunters-ROTC Guerrillas, was received at this headquarters 14 March 1947 and does not meet the deadline referred to in paragraph 2, above.

It is considered generally that all concerned have had ample opportunity to prepare applications for recognition. In the opinion of this headquarters, the request for an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not adequately justified and therefore is not favorably considered.

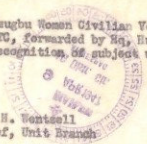
