Dear Captain Villon:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 27 February 1947, in which you request recognition of the Cagayan North Eastern Guerrilla and forward a roster with supporting papers.

It is not considered desirable to extend beyond 15 March 1946 the date for acceptance of applications for recognition of claimant guerrilla units.

It is further believed that any deserving members of your unit had ample opportunity to file individual non-casualty claims for recognition from the time of your receipt of the letter, AFWESPAC, dated 11 June 1946, until the recent closing date of 15 March 1947 for the acceptance by this headquarters of individual non-casualty applications for recognition.

In view of the above decision, this headquarters must necessarily reject your request to accord individual recognition to the members listed on the unit roster.

This decision does not preclude individual request for casualty recognition by injured personnel or their heirs. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.

Returned herewith is the roster of troops with the accompanying papers.

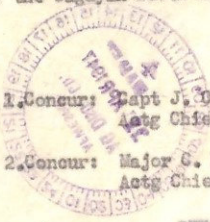

RECORDS

1. Request that the CAGAYAN NORTH EASTERN GUERRILLA be recognized. All important papers concerning said Organization are herein attached.

2. Request for recognition has been filed last April (1946) but the Public Relation Officer, AFWESPAC, turned it down on the ground that submission has not met the dead-line of doing so. While it may be true that there was a circularized information about said dead-line, it should be remembered that news papers were confined in the city of Manila and important places in the Islands. Radios were as rare as the proverbial tooth of a hen during those days too, and only a few may have been able to hear said announcement aside from the announcer.

3. During the period the said announcement may have been published, the "K" Company, 22nd. Infantry, P A, which the undersigned was an Executive Officer was still gambling with death in mopping up operation against the enemy in the heart of the Sierra Madre Mountains in the Cagayan Valley, where news papers were but fancy dreams. How could I then have known of any such limitation? While I do not ignore the validity of the action taken by AFWESPAC concerning my application, I still believe that justice will eventually be accorded to the members and loved ones of our comrades in arms who have

willingly sacrificed their lives in the sacred altar of Freedom and Democracy. Other Organizations in the Philippines have their patriotic services been recognized and I also honestly believe that the sacrifices made by the CAGAYAN NORTH EASTERN GUERRILLA which was a tale of valour and heroic sacrifices without parallel will be accorded the same privilege. The history of this Organization is nothing but plain fact. Knowing that there is always a possibility of having some Allied planes crashed or forced down amidst enemy fortifications in the northern part of Cagayan, we have organized the CAGAYAN NORTH EASTERN GUERRILLA in order to be ready to render help to our American Airman. The personal reports of Lts. John W. Henry and Paul L. Foster of the "Pacific Air Command of the United States Army" could bear witness of these facts. In the rescue of these two American Officers, we have lost a number of men. We have not entertained during those darkest days of enemy occupation any dream for future material compensation for our services, but inasmuch as the United States Army has started compensating others who have willingly worked for them, then it is our legitimate aim to claim for equality and justice. Granting that the dead line was not met by this request, does it nullify the fact that the UNITED STATES ARMY has been the lucky recipient of an unselfish and patriotic service in the rescue of some of its Air Corps personnel? Reference may be made with Lts. John W. Henry and Paul L. Foster, who will certify of the existence and faithful services of our Organization. Contact Teams may also be sent to verify our claims. We are ready to entertain any party the PHILRYCOM may send over to ascertain these facts, for the purpose of giving justice

to whom it is due. I could not believe that the altruism of American ended at the dead line referred to by the Public Relation Officer, AFWESPAC.
