Report on "Intelligence Unit, Manila"

1. 1st Lt Charles L. Homewood on 9 March 1947 examined the unit file of the Intelligence Unit, Manila, under the command of Col. Francisco Santiago, Sr.

2. FINDINGS:

a. Information contained in this report was received from Major Vincent K Coates, Chief, Southern Luzon, who made the field investigation.

b. This unit has never requested recognition. It was an independent intelligence unit made up of wealthy patriotic citizens of Manila who contributed money and information but never operated on a full-time basis.

c. Santiago said he did not intend to submit for recognition to Guerrilla Affairs Division.

d. Lt. Col. Francisco Santiago, Sr., also intimated that some of his unit were receiving recognition thru the Navy intelligence fund which handles groups such as this.

e. It is obvious that a clerical error was committed when this letter was filed under pending units.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended, that the information letter in the unit file be filed with the 201 file of Lt. Col Francisco Santiago, Sr., and that the unit be dropped from pending investigation.
