Dear Mr. Jardiniano:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 7 August 1947, requesting the inclusion of additional personnel in the roster of the Alvarez Battalion, Sector 43, Salt Military Area, Anderson's Guerrillas.

The request for recognition of the Alvarez Battalion, Sector 43, SMA, Anderson's Guerrillas, was not favorably considered by this headquarters on 10 July 1947. A letter to this effect was mailed to Mr. Fernando Alvarez at Pagbilao, Queen, Philippines.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, was used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit was not deemed to be warranted.

It is considered that the recognition by this headquarters of 1786 members of the 1st and 2nd Battalions of Sector 43, SMA, Anderson's Guerrillas, constitutes just and adequate acknowledgement of the military service performed by members of Sector 43, SMA, and as such your request cannot be accepted for consideration.

Returned herewith is the supplementary roster forwarded in your letter of 7 August 1947.

That some were assigned in combat unit under an able commander Lt. Hobart Dator.

And that they guided the liberation forces and were attached for combat intelligence.

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Alvarez Battalion, SMA, Sector 43, Colonel Anderson's Guerrillas, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. Careful investigation of your unit revealed that:

CONCERN Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.

b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.

No evidence has been received by this headquarters to warrant modification of the original decision of non-recognition of the SMA, Sector 43, Colonel Anderson's Guerrillas.

This constitutes final action by this headquarters upon your organization.

1. On 5 July 1947, Lt Pete C Breaz investigated the unit file of the Alvarez Battalion, S.M.A., Sector #43, Anderson's Guerrillas.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached unit file)

3. FINDINGS:

A. A field investigation was deemed unnecessary.

B. This unit's request for recognition was submitted on 1 July 1946, 3-1/2 months after the March 1946 deadline for the filing of such claims. In addition, the following points were noted:

a. This unit was originally NFC'd as part of the supplementary roster of the 43rd Sector, S.M.A., Anderson's Guerrillas. Prior to the NFC, this unit did not have a separate unit claim filed in this office.

b. This unit never existed as such, and the CO (Fernando R. Alvarez) was never in command of a unit larger than 100 men (Incl #1). The present roster is an attempt by Alvarez to defraud the U.S. Army. At one time Alvarez was to be included by Col Anderson on the recognized roster of the Anderson Guerrillas; however, Alvarez refused to accept a lieutenancy and consequently remained unrecognized.

c. Approximately 1800 men have already been recognized from the S.M.A. According to Col Anderson, no more men from that area will be recognized in the final proposed roster for recognition of his organization.

d. There is insufficient acceptable evidence to warrant the recognition of the subject group of men. The unit file contains no documentary evidence in support of recognition and the unit history in general is merely an account of the growth of the organization. Liberation activities claimed are those for which 1800 members from the S.M.A. have previously been recognized. According to Col Manzano (E O, Anderson's Grlas), the area in which the subject unit claims to have operated never contained more than 50 Japanese, at any one time. This alone indicates that the unit could not have been very active, since the subject unit did not exterminate the enemy.

In compliance with verbal orders from the Chief, Guerrilla Affairs Section, this headquarters, Contact Team "J" investigated the guerrilla unit known as the 43rd Sector, Salt Military Area, Anderson's guerrillas.

The 43rd Sector, SMA was organized in Oct 43 by Ninito Alonso, acting on orders issued by Lt. Col. B. Anderson. The unit was located in the municipality of Tayabas, Tayabas. The unit seemed to have functioned smoothly until the death of Alonso, at which time, quite a bit of confusion arose as to who would succeed Alonso. Eriberto Eleazar was appointed Commanding Officer by Headquarters, SMA, and was unable to assume command due to illness.

Mamerto Ricafort claimed he was chosen by a number of staff officers to act as Commanding Officer. But only a few men knew of Ricafort's appointment and it was never made official. Ricafort has already been recognized as a Lt. Colonel and has had 758 men recognized. Col. Anderson, the over-all commander of SMA states that he had never heard of Ricafort and that Ricafort never was in command. Anderson also states that the men recognized on Ricafort's rosters were not active and that it was an injustice to Eleazar's men. He recommended a battalion for recognition under Eleazar which would bring the total number of guerrillas in the 43rd Sector to 1,648, and Anderson says that no more than that were active. Records on file at 1st Anderson Battalion substantiates this statement.

It is recommended that this unit be not favorably considered for recognition and that no further investigation be made by the Guerrilla Affairs Office.

1. Ricafort was never appointed Commanding Officer as is shown by an investigation made by the SMA Commanding Officer.
2. Many key officers that Ricafort has in his roster deny they served under him and are being recognized at present under Eleazar.

Ricafort was assuming command from 28 Nov 44 to 6 April 45.
Eleazar claims to have been ill during the months of Nov 44,
Dec 44, Jan 45. Feb 45 - Returned to his command on 25 Feb 45.

Antonio Celmo Bello, Capt (PA) alias Monserrat A. De Gallego
C.O. SMA stated that he aptd Eleazar as CO of the 43rd Sector
after the death of Alonzo in Nov 44. And that his headquarters
received reports from both Eleazar and Ricafort. Both officers
signed their reports as CO. And during the same period that
Eleazar claimed to have been sick, that he received reports
signed by R. as C.O. But that no orders were ever issued from
his headquarters appointing R. as C.O.

Major Alonzo was killed 11 Nov 44 by Huks in an ambushed.
Alonzo was returning to his unit with arms and ammunition.
These weapons were all captured by the Huks.

The first intelligence reports were sent in Oct 1943.
They were transmitted to Col. Andersons Headquarters.

On the 7th of Feb 45 a report was submitted to MIS, as to
the location of Jap troops and equipment in Tayabas. Maps
and sketches were reportedly submitted in conjunction with this
report. The units last report was submitted on the 23 March.
It contained information about the bombing of Tayabas by
USAAF planes.

One of the squadron commanders stated that Ricafort was in
command of the unit while Eleazar was sick. Other officers and
men denied ever having served under Ricafort.

In compliance with verbal orders from the Chief, Guerrilla Affairs Section, this headquarters, Contact team "J" investigated the guerrilla unit known as the 43rd Sector, Salt Military Area, Anderson's Guerrillas.

This unit was organized in Oct 1943 in the Province of Tayabas, Luzon by order of Capt Bernard L. Anderson. The organizer of the unit Bernardino N. R. Alonzo alias Tere was killed by the Japanese on 11 Nov 44. He was directly under the control of Capt Antonio Celso Bello alias Monserrat A. Del Gallego, Commanding Officer of the Salt Military Area which was part of Anderson's forces. After Alonzo's death Monserrat A. Del Gallego appointed Eriberto G. Eleazar as Commanding Officer of Sector 43, SMA on 25 Nov 1944. However, Eleazar was sick in the mountains from Nov 1944 through Feb 1945 and in his absence a Mamerto Ricafort assumed command from 28 Nov 44 to 6 Apr 1945 without any direct order to do so. Anderson had no knowledge of this fact. A situation developed where the unit had two men claiming command. Ricafort has had 758 men recognized by this headquarters with recognition dates of 23 May 1945 through 15 Aug 1945. Lt. Col. Anderson claims that this is an injustice to the men who actually participated in the guerrilla movement in the province of Tayabas, Luzon.

This unit was chiefly concerned with intelligence work and in the movement of supplies from the vicinity of Lucena, Tayabas to the Iamon Bay Area. In its intelligence work this unit had one (1) walkie-talkie radio for communication to Col Anderson's Headquarters. It reached its peak of armed strength in Feb 1944 with 86 rifles (mostly Japanese weapons). The reports sent to Col Anderson dealt mainly with troop movements, location of supply and ammunition dumps and general disposition of troops. Some of the men worked under the Japanese so that they could seek out additional information about the enemy and were compensated for their labor with food and some money by the Japs. When the American units arrived some of the men were used as laborers and were rationed and paid one peso and fifty centavos a day.

This unit claims to have had men working with the 11th Airborne and 1st Cavalry Division action as guides, scouts, laborers and couriers and some combat men. It also established a CP adjacent to the 11th Airborne CP in the high school building in Tayabas, Tayabas.

Upon investigation of records kept in the 1st Battalion Headquarters, Anderson's Guerrillas, it is shown that 865 men were inducted during the period from Oct 1943 through late 1944. According to the commanding officer many records since late 1944 were destroyed by the bombing of T'abas (the headquarters) and by insects. At the present time all personnel are engaged in civilian occupations.

Sector 43 originally claimed approximately 3000 men but Col. Anderson screened the unit down to a battalion of 1090 personnel.

This unit has no apparent political ambitions.

As a result of the findings of Contact Team "J", and conference with Eriberto Eleazar and a number of his officers and Enlisted Men and a careful study of the history of this unit the following recommendations are submitted:

1. That the 43rd Sector, Salt Military Area, Anderson's Guerrilla Forces, under the command of Eriberto Eleazar, totaling 1090 Officers and Enlisted Personnel be favorably recognized with recognition dates 6 April 1945 to 31 July 1945.
2. The initial recognition date was decided upon due to the fact that Ricafort had assumed command from 28 Nov 1944 to 6 April 1945 and has had some men recognized.
3. The terminal date of 31 July 1945 was determined by a statement made by Eriberto Eleazar, C. O. that guerrilla activities ceased the end of July 1945 and the unit disbanded in Aug 1945 and turned over their arms and ammunition to the 5th Cavalry and units they were borrowed from.



SUBJECT : HISTORY OF ORGANIZATION

TO : The Commanding General, AFWESPAC
(Attn: Guerrilla Affairs Section)

I - ORGANIZERS:- With the unexpected fall of Bataan and realizing that the regular armed forces of the United States and the Philippines needs the physical and material support of the civilian when these forces could no longer stand the sufferings they have in the fields of battle, Mr. FERNANDO R. ALVAREZ with the support of his tenants and some USAFFE Personnel who were left behind by the withdrawing USAFFE and who have escaped from the "Death March" organized a guerrilla force with an initial strength of 105 and operated at the Pagbilao Sector including a part of the Tayabas Bay commencing the 24th of November 1942, town fiesta of Pagbilao when we pledged to continue on the unfinished task of the USAFFE. A "Pledge to the Cause" was subscribed and sworn to by the leaders each representing their members on the night of the 25th of November 1942 right in the residence of Mr. FERNANDO R. ALVAREZ. The town fiesta was a camouflage in assembling the group. (See APPENDIX I).

II - AUTHORITY:- After the group have been organized to a guerrilla force with Mr. FERNANDO R. ALVAREZ as the Commanding Officer with a guerrilla rank of Captain, authority to maintain and operate the unit as a guerrilla unit was solicited from other authentic guerrilla unit. On 1 August 1943 Commander Primo B. Almaza of the USAFFE LUZON GUERRILLA ARMY FORCES - South Central Tayabas Sector was contacted by Mr. FERNANDO R. ALVAREZ and requested affiliation of this unit to the South Central Tayabas Sector, USAFFE LUZON GUERRILLA ARMY FORCES. Commander Primo B. Almaza assigned USAFFE SQUADRON NO. 305 to Mr. FERNANDO R. ALVAREZ and appointed him at the same time as Captain effective 1 August 1943. (See APPENDIX II). But the South Central Tayabas Sector under Commander Primo B. Almaza relinquished its command in the Pagbilao Sector last February 1944 thus leaving this unit independent from its command. On 10 January 1945, Commander Manserto A. Ricafort of S. M. A., Sector 43 was contacted and this unit was then affiliated to his command until the American Liberation Forces arrived in this sector. (See APPENDIX III).

III - ACTIVITIES:-

(1) SABOTAGE:- Communication lines along the railroad tracks

from Pagbilao - Siahan have been continually destroyed by our men by either destroying the posts or cutting the lines. Japanese trucks once parked are selected by blowing up the tires and stealing parts and tools. Rivoulces of the Japs are infiltrated by our men in pretense of labor and once inside, they start destroying anything of military importance.

(2) MESSAGE CENTER AND COURIER SERVICES:- This unit unit have organized posts along the routes. Sentries are posted who act as guides or couriers from their posts to another place within the vicinity. These sentries act also as guards for the vicinity.

(3) FURNISHING SUPPLY:- Food supplies are procured by asking voluntary contributions. Any excess of same are sent to the Sector Headquarters or given to other Allied Units. Medicine and office supplies are extended to Sector Headquarters. Arms and ammunition in excess of ours are disposed same. Around two (2) tons of ammunition of different caliber were given to Col. Anderson's Headquarters last 1943.

(4) ACTIVE RESISTANCE AGAIN THE ENEMY:- In our Sector, an organized Hukpili have been constantly bothering the guerrillas so that we have to pick them one by one. Before the coming of the American Forces our unit have been engaged in some unavoidable encounters resulting to minor casualties on the enemy.

(5) INTELLIGENCE SERVICES:- Intelligence reports of this unit are sent either verbally or written to Sector Headquarters who consolidate same. Lately, a copy of same is furnished the Military Intelligence Service, Nelson Group, when the American Forces were coming near. Task Forces have been contacted and reports have been rendered. 

2. Fernando Alvarez did receive assignment orders as a battalion commander, without any rank, from the Commander of SMA Sector 43 to which Alvarez claims affiliation with. This appointment was not authorized by Lt Col Bernard L Anderson and therefore cannot be considered official.
3. To the best of the knowledge of the undersigned, Alvarez was never in command of a group larger than a company of approximately 100 men.
4. At one time Alvarez was to be placed on the recognized roster of SMA Sector 43, Anderson's Guerrillas as a 2nd Lieutenant. Alvarez refused the lieutenancy and therefore remained unrecognized.
5. There are no members from the area of the "Alvarez Bn" being included on the proposed rosters for recognition of Col Anderson's Guerrillas.

REPORT OF MISSION TO MARINDUQUE & MINDORO

In Bone, Marinduque, I reported myself to the CIC under Sergeant Piper and one Lieutenant, I told them about the Japanese movements in Tayabas; I sketched a map in front of them showing the distance of towns, barrios, and places where the Japanese are concentrated by kilometers. I presented myself too, to the Commander of the 21st Infantry.

After a week's stay in Bone, Marinduque, I was sent to San Jose, Mindoro by LST and reported to G-3 of the 24th Victory Division under Gen. Woodrow. To them I also reported the Japanese movements in Tayabas, after which I returned to Luzon.

Report of Mission to Laiya, Batangas

After my return from Marinduque and Mindoro, I proceeded to Laiya, Batangas, upon Orders from the Sector Headquarters. In Laiya, I contacted with the 6th Army. I sent a message to Col. Anderson asking for arms, ammunitions and medicine. Col. Anderson answered by Army radio code to report to Capt. Oreta at Kalabintian, Mauban, Tayabas.







Sir:

The situation of many genuine guerrillas is pitiful. Their comrades - many of them - have died in the hands of the Japs. Some died of hunger and sickness. But now nobody is paying attention to the survivors and worse to the dead. Take for example Sector 43 of Anderson's Bn. here. There are no less than 7,000 members. But how many were recognized? Only few. How about the dead? How about those who were not recognized? So many genuine guerrillas are left alone. They became laborers again in the farms and some are working in Concor. There are many guerrilla organizations. But, although many are ignorant with regard to guerrilla recognition, yet they are real patriots. They suffered, sacrificed and many have died, and until now they receive no compensation or even words of thanks. Compensation is secondary. If the U. S. did not give to any guerrilla organization, it will be just the same. They are satisfied because they served their own country. But when the U. S. government announced that guerrillas will be given compensation or backpay, organizations spring up more than mushrooms. They are the guerrillas of 1945 and 1946. And it is surprising that some guerrilla leaders, in order to maintain high ranks, they allowed to enlist new members in their organization. It is because they want to be colonels and generals. For instance, Folsom has allowed here in Tayabas province to enlist as many members as could be listed. In one day Mr. Folsom could make thousand officers and soldiers. He has many agents here. And there is racket, the new officers will have to advance money in order to get the rank. The agents of the new officers promised that the new members will receive thousands and thousands of pesos as backpay. They even promised that the fees will go to Mr. Folsom's corporation in Manila. This racket business is very rampant from Lucena down to Mauban. The same case is now going on to Col. Villalon's guerrilla (Hukbalahap). There are many new enlisted men. Some of them collaborated with the Japs. Relatives of those killed or tortured are listed as officers. Those tortured without guerrilla connection are given high ranks. This is being done here in Tayabas, Lucban, Sampaloc and particularly in Mauban. Many are smart guys; they outwitted real guerrillas who are ignorant and not interested. So many people here do not want to work or make copra because many are expecting to receive guerrilla backpay from the U. S. government. Kindly make silent and systematic investigation of this guerrilla racket in this part of the province.
