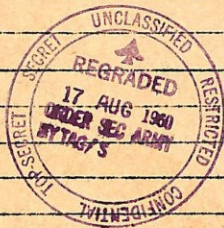

1. The unit listed below is recognized by the Commanding General, Philippines-Ryukyus Command, as having been an authorized element of the Philippine Army serving with the Armed Forces of the United States on the date appearing in the column headed "Revised Recognition Date".

## There is no relationship between Squadron 206-A mentioned in paragraph 2c and Squadron 206-A mentioned in paragraph 2e.

## Elements of Squadron 320 were transferred to Provisional Regiment, Philippine Scouts, commanded by Lt Col Edgar Wright, Jr. Provisional Regiment, Philippine Scouts was not an LGAF unit but was a Luzon Guerrilla Force unit under the overall command of Col Gyles Merrill, USA..

## Although these units did not join LGAF until dates indicated, they are considered revised with LGAF to the indicated dates of organization for administrative purposes.

3. No commissioned ranks above that of Captain were authorized prior to 30 September 1943 with the exception of those USAFFE officers in the rank of captain and above. Subsequent to 30 September 1943, ranks of officers commensurate with their command or staff functions and based on the table of organization of the U. S. Army Infantry Division, less one grade, were authorized.

b. Casualties included and recognized in a separate casualty roster will be entitled to pay whether or not their names appear on the original rosters of the USAFFE Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces.

5. All civilians recruited by or inducted into the USAFFE Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces (LGAF) subsequent to 20 May 42 are considered to have become members of the Philippine Army, serving with the Armed Forces of the United States with entitlement to pay subsequent to that date.

6. The USAFFE Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces has never printed script of any kind, nor have any members of this unit received any pay from the time of its inception until the initial recognition of those units of the USAFFE Luzon.

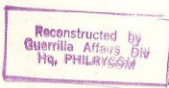

1. a. The guerrilla units listed on attached list have been recognized by the Commander-in-Chief as authorized elements of USAFFE. Under the Provisions of Executive Order No. 21, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 28 October 1944, the status of members of these units, who have served while the unit was in direct support of Sixth Army combat operations, is that of officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Army.

b. At such times as additional units are recognized, you will be forwarded supplementary lists.

2. It is desired that you notify those units on the attached list that are operating under your control that they have been recognized. 

HISTORY OF THE 111 SQDN-LGAF ALCALA UNIT  
(160th SQDN- LGAF, PMA )

As early as the first week of October 1942, a few confidential friends consisting of seven young men, and I, organized the nucleus of the ALCALA GUERRILLA UNIT. This was necessary to keep faith with those who have borne the brunt of battle in the now historic fields of Bataan and Corregidor.

As of November 1, 1942, we had forty men. From then on our strength steadily increased. By the end of December 1943 our number increased to seven (7) officers and one hundred forty-two (142) EM or a total of 149 soldiers. By 1944 when the period was more critical we were more careful and discriminating in our acceptance of members. As in previous selections only men of proven loyalty, honesty, bravery and fidelity to trust were admitted, but with more rigorous scrutiny. During the year one officer and twenty-eight (28) EM were inducted into our unit, making a total of 178 members. This last number represented our maximum strength at the landing of the American Liberators. However, I wish to state that a platoon of my unit was routed while in the act of attacking the Japanese Garrison at Bayambang in December 1944, and the members thereof were forced to stay in hiding in different places for a long time in order to avoid capture by the common enemy. Some of the members failed to return, and the component being very much short of the number of men for the said platoon, I had to declare them unattached reservists as of January 25, 1945, when we were ordered to report men only actually connected or attached with our Unit who could report for duty at Manaoag, Pangasinan. The men declared unattached reservists consisted of three (3) officers and thirty-nine (39) EM, including seven (7) First Aid Members, who were women. As a result of this incident, by 1945 the total strength of the unit attached was five (5) officers and one hundred thirty-one (131) EM.

One of the ranking members of the nucleus of the 111 Sqdn-LGAF ALCALA UNIT became a liaison officer of our unit with the Nakar Division, Manila Unit and acted as intelligence officer at large making reports on the strength, movements, emplacements and positions of the Japanese Army from Manila to the Ilocos provinces.

Our men acted as saboteurs, propagandists and intelligence agents as to the movement, emplacement and strength of the enemy.

15 January 1943, with Twenty (20) EM I contacted Captain Antonio C. Garcia, organizer and commanding officer of the 100th Inf. of Western Pangasinan for coordination of activities. We planned our course of operation furnishing each other with the necessary assistance and coordinating our attacks against the Japanese Garrisons and outposts. At Bayambang, which we attacked 10 February 1943, we were successful. We captured six (6) Springfield Rifles. Later the Kempeitai at Dagupan stationed an additional Filipino P. C. Detachment at Bautista, a nearby town of Bayambang, for re-enforcement in case of another attack. The placing of the Filipino P. C. detachment at Bautista did not at all dampen our spirits in deprecating Japanese or Japanese-controlled garrisons or outposts. Instead in April 1943, we at-

tacked the Filipino P. C. Garrison. We wounded two of the men but failed to capture any arms. This last encounter with soldiers made the Japanese very angry and they labelled Alcala a hot bed of guerrillas. As an offshoot of the Bautista attack, a platoon of Filipino P. C. soldiers was stationed at Alcala under Lt. Rizal Romero in September 1943. We attacked this platoon stationed at Alcala on November 15, 1943, and we captured one revolver, a rifle and some ammunitions. This attack caused reprisals by the Philippine Constabulary to the male elements of the town especially in the barrios. The constabulary soldiers became more stern and "zona" system was instituted and practised every market day at Alcala, Pangasinan, to the discomfort and great annoyance of the inhabitants.

In one of our missions to raid the Japanese Garrison at Carmen, Pangasinan, our men were chased and pursued. We fled and sought cover in Eastern Pangasinan. We found ourselves on August 10, 1943, in the town of Umingah, Pangasinan. We were apprehended by some of the men under Major Robert B. Lapham and were suspected as Japanese Spies. We were brought before Lt. Ulpiano Velasquez of the Lapham's outfit for questioning and investigation. Upon identifying ourselves, we then and there agreed to incorporate our unit to the Lapham's Unit, of which Lt. Ulpiano Velasquez is an officer. According to him he had authority to recognize and incorporate underground resistance organization to the Lapham Unit. Our unit was designated 111th Sqdn-LGAF ALCALA UNIT in place of the old name "ALCALA GUERRILLA UNIT". The 111th Sqdn-LGAF ALCALA UNIT worked independently and in collaboration with the 111th Sqdn-LGAF UMINGAH UNIT.

In February 1944 we attacked and killed three Japanese soldiers stationed to guard the railroad station at Poponto, Bautista, Pangasinan, and we got away with two rifles, two belts of ammunitions, and a machine gun.

We destroyed railroad tracks whenever our intelligence men have definitely ascertained that the Japanese were shipping war materials, such as gasoline and other supplies to Dagupan or to San Quintin. One very successful derailment of freight cargo was done between Poponto and Moncada in March 1944.

On March 10, 1944, in our patrol operations, we met Capt. Ray C. Hunt Jr. in his Headquarters in Mount Depalu, San Quintin, Pangasinan. When Captain Ray C. Hunt Jr. informed us that he was the Area Commander of LGAF for Pangasinan, we identified our unit as part of the LGAF by virtue of the act of incorporation of Lt. Ulpiano Velasquez by authority of Major Robert B. Lapham. Then and there Captain Ray C. Hunt Jr. told us to take orders from him. He then detailed our unit as MP of the guerrillas under Major Robert B. Lapham covering the central sector of Pangasinan.

During the latter part of June 1944 and the early part of July 1944, a party of Japanese soldiers surveyed the municipalities of Malasiqui, Bautista and Alcala for a possible quick get away in case of retreat. When they started the survey at Alcala, two of the Japanese soldiers were mysteriously killed so the work was halted for some time, and in its place severe reprisals from the Japanese took place. The survey was continued in September and again one Japanese soldier was killed.

On November 15, 1944, Lt. Mariano Quirino, the Adjutant Squadron 111 Umingan Unit led a platoon to our sector. We talked of our past activities and exchanged information. Upon his return to Umingan, I sent a platoon with him to deliver the machine gun which we have captured to the Headquarters of Major Robert B. Lapham, through the kindness of Lt. Ulpiano Velasquez of the 111 Sqn Umingan Unit. Our men upon reaching Umingan were told to return to Alcala by Lt. Ulpiano Velasquez after receiving the assurance that the said machine gun would be delivered to Major Lapham.

The news of the landing of the Americans in Leyte was a boon to the weary and almost dampening spirits of some of our men. With re-enforced courage and a firmer determination to win the fight in the open, we inaugurated a more systematic way of disposing the enemy. In every isolated barrio along the roads we stationed not less than twelve men to kill the enemy at the best opportunity. Trucks collecting rice, vegetables, fish and other food supplies for Japanese Garrisons were attacked. From September to the early part of November weekly attack on Japanese trucks along highways was a common occurrence, especially at San Antonio, Sto. Tomas; Lawac, Alcala; near San Agustin, San Manuel, Tarlac. Japanese patrols going in groups of twos were seen no more; instead groups of fours or more replaced them.

We have been itching for more arms and ammunitions. Knowing that the garrison at Bayambang, within our sector, was well supplied with arms we decided to attack it. A well planned strategy of attack was laid out. Two platoons of about forty (40) men each were to attack it on two fronts - one from the Southeast and another from the southwest. It took place during the early part of December just a few days before the landing at Lingayen, Pangasinan. The platoon attacking it on the Southwest were repulsed, routed and pursued in their retreats to the barrios towards west. The components of this platoon who were cut off from our headquarters at Alcala, Pangasinan, by good lines of alert Japanese, had to remain in hiding for a long time as some of their identities have been revealed to the enemy by false countrymen. Most of them failed to report on time at the reunion at Manaoag and they had to be declared reservists.

From March 27, 1944 to the 27th January 1945, our Unit continued to discharge the duties we were wont to perform from November 1, 1942 up to March 27, 1944. Effective March 27, 1944 to 27th January 1945, we had the following additional duties:

1. We saw to it, per instruction of Capt. Ray C. Hunt Jr. that the Lapham Guerrilla units of Pangasinan did not abuse and maltreat the civilians.

2. In this connection we were able to curb the activities of some unscrupulous members who were wont to extort money and property from civilians and put a stop to the bad practice of some of the populace who reported innocent men to the Kempeitai out of sheer delight for revenge.

3. We were able to apprehend men who would go as far as killing their fellow guerrillas out of sheer delight and rivalry and the desires to show off to the prejudice of the Esprit de Corps of the resistance movement.

On the 25th of January 1945, the 111th Sqn ICAF ALCALA UNIT known as the 160th Sqn ICAF assembled at Manaoag, Pangasinan

by order of Capt. Ray C. Hunt Jr. CO of PMA preparatory to joining the Liberation Forces.

From 28th January 1945 to 15 February 1945 the 111 Sgdn-LGAF ALCALA UNIT (160th Sgdn-LGAF) was attached to 147 FA Bn and 192nd FA Bn 43rd Div. as perimeter guards and patrols stationed at Alakan and Damortis, La Union.

From 15th February 1945 to 30 June 1945, the Unit under this command was attached to the 122nd FA Bn; 124 FABn and Div. Hq. Artillery, 33rd Div. U. S.A. stationed at Bennekeg, Rosario, La Union to Baguio, Mt. Province and Cervantes, Ilocos Sur.


From 1st July 1945 to 30 September 1945, our unit was attached to 127th Anti-Tank Co. 32nd Inf. Div. U. S. A., stationed at Sison, Pangasinan and engaged in mopping up operations for the towns of Agoo, Sto. Tomas, Damortis, Rosario, La Union; Sison, Pozorrobio, San Fabian, Binalonan, Pangasinan.

From 1st October 1945 to 31 March '46, this Unit was attached to USAFIP-ML, stationed at Naguilian, La Union.

Lest I forget and in fairness to the members of the fair sex who have so valorously cast their lot during those dark days of the underground movement, I should say that whatever service and honor that was rendered and reaped by our Unit must be equally shared by our First Aid Members. The beginning of 1943 should be considered a year of blessing to the organization for in that year seven brave feminine hearts decided to join us under the leadership of a registered nurse, 2nd Lt. Francisca Guntang. These seven big hearts greatly aided us by ministering to our men who have been attacked with sickness, like malaria, fever and dysentery. They bandaged wounds received by our men in the several attacks we made against the Japanese. Not only did they serve us in this way, but more important was their presence in our unit for they were always the inspirers of men who were on the verge of losing their hopes for eventual liberation from the truly unbearable and exceedingly cruel Japanese bondage.

This Unit was honorably discharged 31 March 1946.

To prove how invaluable was the 111th Sgdn-LGAF ALCALA UNIT (160th Sgdn-LGAF) to the resistance movement, I am enclosing the commendations of Major Gen. P. W. Clarkson CG 33rd Inf. Div. U. S.A., Brig. Gen. A. G. Paxton, CG 33rd Div. Artillery, U. S. A., Lt. Col Roland P. Carlson, CO 122 FA Bn, 33rd Div. U. S. A. and Lt. Col. Harold O. Carlson, CO 124 FA Bn 33rd Div. U. S. A. for whatever they are worth.

The people in general are aware of the fact that your office is

very careful and intensive in the examination of papers submitted for the setting back the recognition of so many Guerrilla Units in the Philippines.

This is reminding you of the case of one guerrilla Unit in ALCALA,

PANGASINAN, PHILIPPINES, under the Overall Command of Major Lapham. Here is the story of the ALCALA UNIT under the Command of Capt. Victor Esteban.

Col. Ramsey came to Bayambang on March, 1943. He organized Guerrilla Units over there. Alcala a nearby town to Bayambang where Col Ramsey stayed organized a guerrilla unit with the strength of around Five hundred men. It was really a genuine resistance movement under the overall Command of Col.

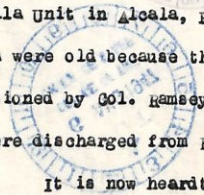
② Ramsey. In 1944 we heard that Major Lapham was with Col Ramsey. About August 1944 it was heard that Ramsey and Lapham were separated for their protection.

It was then heard that Major Lapham was in Nueva Ecija organizing his own unit of guerrillas.

③ on November 1944, a certain man named Victor Esteban aware of the fact that the American forces were coming tried to contact some guerrilla Leaders. He cannot join those of Ramsey's unit in Alcala, pangasinan because he was already late for it was 1944, November. He tried to go Umingan, pangasinan, and was able to contact the then Captain Ray Hunt, Jr. who gave him Commission to organize Guerrilla Unit in Alcala, pangasinan. He did so taking around a hundred men many of whom were old because they were those left by the Ramsey Unit. Undesirable men commissioned by Col. Ramsey to be officers like Lt. Joaquin Loria and Lt Tadeo, who were discharged from Ramsey Unit were taken in. This was November 1944.

④ It is now heard that Captain Victor Esteban is with papers submitted for recognition dating back from 1942 or 1943 which will surely defraud the

United States money even with the backing of Major Lapham, this case of Guerrilla Unit is very unfair to happen .

The Alcala Squadron or Alcala unit under the Command of Captain Victor Esteban under the overall command of Major Lapham suffered no torture or casualty during the occupation unlike the unit of Col. Ramsey in Alcala, pangasinan cause it was November 1944 guerrilla unit.

So that fairness and justice will rule, it is requested that the case of the Alcala unit, LGAF, under the command of Capt. Victor Esteban, overall Command of Major Lapham be studied carefully.

be were also of the new substitute guerrilla unit organized by the Esteban group where they recruited so many men asking them to pay for the expenses of having the unit be recognized.
