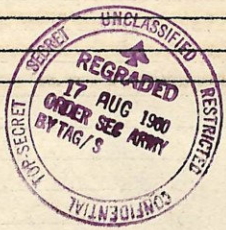

Dear Mr. Esguerra:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Squadron 200, Central Nueva Ecija Military Area, LGAF, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. A definite organization was not established.
- e. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
- f. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.
- g. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

h. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.

It is desired to emphasize that each claimant member of the unit is considered to have had just and adequate appraisal for recognition when his services were evaluated concurrently with this study of the unit with which he claims membership. Individual requests were not necessary nor appropriate then, or now, as their acceptance would in effect constitute unjustified duplication of consideration of one individual by this headquarters. However, this does not preclude submission for casualty recognition by those individuals who are qualified and feel justified in entering such claims. Upon request by interested individuals, appropriate forms will be forwarded.

Your attention is invited to Presidential Executive Order No. 68, Commonwealth of the Philippines, copy of which is attached, for any necessary action in connection therewith.

Report on "Squadron 200, Central Nueva Ecija
Military Area (CNEMA,) LGAF"

1. Lt Leon J Sonders and Lt William D MacMillan proceeded to Cabanatuan, Nueva Ecija, on 17 February 1947, to investigate "Squadron 200, Central Nueva Ecija Military Area (CNEMA), LGAF." It was found that 1st Lt Juanito T Quitives, Commanding Officer, Squadron 200, was deceased, and the investigation was conducted through Capt Juan Pajota, CO, CNEMA.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached unit file.)

3. FINDINGS:

a. The following persons were interviewed and their remarks are reflected in the findings:

Meliton G Rigor, Mayor, Cabanatuan, N E
Gabriel Belmonte, Governor, Nueva Ecija
Dr Melquaides Ronquillo, resident, Cabanatuan, N E
M G Yogore, manager, Philippines National Bank,
Cabanatuan, N E

It was requested that any officer of Squadron 200 in Cabanatuan be notified that the Contact Team was present to investigate the unit. None of the officers were available, and their present localities were unknown.

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. The unit file contains documents supporting the claim of the CO as a guerrilla, but they are not pertinent to the subject unit. Quitives, according to Pajota, has been recognized. A note in the unit file designates his recognition with "E" Co, 121st Inf, and copies of orders from that organization of USAFIP, NL, bear this out. Also, 2nd Lt Olimpio Isidro was recognized by Headquarters, USAFFE, per General Order #42, 27 February 1945, awarding the Bronze Star Medal to those who assisted the 6th Ranger Bn, Sixth Army, in the liberation of the American POW's in the prison camp at Cabanatuan, N E, 28-31 January 1945. The contents of the unit file, presumably intended to support the claim of this squadron, fail to do so. The copy of the note signed by one 1st Lt Jack Lueddike of the 6th Rangers has been used by at least two other organizations as supporting evidence. The utter lack of evidence pertaining to the subject unit and the fact that he has been a member of an entirely different command in which he was recognized, refute the claims of the CO. Even the recognition of the other officer, Isidro, was not as a member of this squadron, but as an "Area Staff Officer." It would appear that the subject unit was not present at the liberation of the Cabanatuan Camp in the alleged status. Capt Pajota made no statements which would sup-

port this unit's claim, nor did any other person in the area.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. There is no evidence available to show that the unit was ever maintained in the field. Capt Pajota, as CO of CNEMA, of which this squadron was a part, would certainly be able to relate the actions and whereabouts of the subject unit if it had been actively engaging the enemy. He could not furnish the investigators any information of this nature. Furthermore, in the request for recognition which states the unit's activities, Quitives says they were attached for the major part of 1945 to American units, but encloses copies of orders from Hq 121st Inf, USAFIP, NL, dated July 1945, pertaining to his own activities and movements. This is highly irregular.

d. A definite organization was not established by the unit. No original papers of any kind are in the unit file, and nothing, with the exception of the appointment of Quitives as a 1st Lt by Pajota, indicates that the unit ever existed.

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by the commanding officer. If the copies of orders from Hq 121st Inf, USAFIP, NL, are true, Quitives could not possibly have commanded this squadron while a member of the 121st Inf. The recognition of Lt Isidro in a capacity other than as a member of Squadron 200 belies control of the unit by its subordinate officers.

f. The unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. Notwithstanding the appointment of Quitives by Pajota, it cannot be determined whether this squadron was organized at all, although, admittedly, certain individuals, now represented as its members, may have made some worthwhile contribution in other organizations. No evidence leads the undersigned to believe that ~~any~~ organization was established. Activity, in this case, would be impossible.

g. No useful purpose will be served by further investigation of the unit. All worthy members have been recognized with other commands and casualties are carried on a higher commanders' roster. Unit suffered no casualties.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: The unit has no apparent political affiliations or aspiration.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that "Squadron 200, CNEMA, LGAF," be not favorably considered for recognition.


b. That most of the members of this roster also rendered valuable assistance and information to the U. S. Army Forces in following combats:

2. Participated with the American Offensive at Balite Pass (now Dalton Pass) in pushing the Japanese to the North of Luzon, from April 12 to May 20, 1945.

3. Participated with the U. S. 6th Army in wiping out the Japanese at Bis-sang, Cervantes, Tue, Banco, Sabangan, Mount Data, Loo Valley, Alab, Bontoc, Banawe, and Badayan, all in the Mountain Province, from June 15 to September 15, 1945.

Whereas, after the surrender of Lt. Gen. Jonathan Wainwright, USA, in Bataan last May, 1942, several USAFFE officers and soldiers successfully evaded capture by the Japanese Expeditionary Forces in the Islands and had gone to places of their own choice in the Philippines and organized Guerilla Forces against the Japanese Army and spread propaganda or engaged in actual fighting against them, and against these Filipinos and other nationals who cooperate and joined in the propaganda with respect to the Greater East Asia War and expect to join in ranks and files of the Filipino Volunteer Corps in California as soon as they arrive here from the United States; and

Whereas, it is deemed proper, wise and conducive to an effective method of fighting, propaganda as well as military warfare and will inspire loyalty to, and confidence in by all Filipinos for the Guerilla cause, to organize military organization as prescribed by the U. S. Infantry Drill Regulations and working with the same purpose and for the same cause and in order to have a unified command and leadership shall officers to take command;

Now, therefore, be it known that I, Officer, inducted to the USAFFE, December, 1941, at Camp Murphy, now Commanding Officer of Central Nueva Ecija Area, Philippine Guerilla Warfare, do hereby appoint JUANITO T. QUIRIVES, 1st Lieutenant, Infantry, USAFFE-LGAF, and be assigned for duty to 200th Squadron, LGAF, Central Nueva Ecija Area, as Squadron Commander, operating from Bangad, Cabanatuan, to Sapang-buho, Bongabon, Nueva Ecija Province, until your services is dispensed by the U. S. Army Government as Commander of said squadron (and or) Battalion effective as seen as you take your oath of office.
