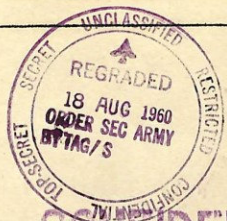



To: : C. O., LGAF 5th Military District
In the Field.

1. That in the 8th of April 1945, 424th Medical Collecting Company moved outside of the town near the cemetery of San Jose, Nueva Ecija. Our detachment helped in building the area and established our new guard posts.

2. That at about 11:00 O'clock P.M., 22nd April 1945 we received news that there are Twenty Japs in the vicinity of Barrio Linamayac, three kilometers from our area. We reinforced the guard posts during the night. We also notified the Military Police Detachment in San Jose and they went to the said vicinity but they were not able to contact the Japs. The following morning our detachment went on patrol in the surrounding hills and barrios. We were not able to encounter any Japs and we went back to the camp in the afternoon.
