6. The USAFFE Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces has never printed script of any kind, nor have any members of this unit received any pay from the time of its inception until the initial recognition of those units of the USAFFE Luzon

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Guerrilla Army Forces, at which time they received current pay.



1. Attached roster of 51 men all bonafide members of Sqdn 269, LGAF, who are part of approved strength of 78 men as of 12 Feb 45 per recognition letter, Hq 6th Army, dated 26 Mar 45.

2. Original roster of these 78 men is among those missing in the files of HAP according to Lt. Ysip, GAD, HAP.

3. Remainder of Sqdn 269 was recognized in the 1st Bn, 1st Regt, LGAF.

4. During incorporation of Sqdn 269 into the 1st Regt, these 78 men were not accommodated as the Bn T/O was already filled up. Of these, though, 27 have been accorded recognition either as casualties or subsequent attachments *as replacements*

5. Sqdn 269 accompanied me when I reported to the American Forces at Manaoag, Pangasinan, and was attached to the 27th Inf, 25th Div in the fight for San Leon and Umingan, Pangasinan, *for which recognition was not accorded. Recognition and submission of roster, was made to the GAD but it was not yet started.*

6. Request the roster of 51 men be authenticated and those otherwise recognized deleted from original roster of 78 men.

7. A careful check of records revealed that these 51 men are of the original roster.

Report of Investigation on Squadrons 1, 111, 206,
221, 265, 269, 267, 300, 311 Luzon Guerrilla
Army Forces (LGAF)

1. On 10 June 1946, Capt John O. Keider reviewed the records and pertinent documents of Squadrons 1, 111, 206, 221, 265, 269, 267, 300, 311 Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces (LGAF) to determine whether or not the supplementary rosters of these units were worthy of recognition. The units were previously recognized for liberation service with the exception of Squadron 300, 96, of whose members were recognized as members of 1st Regt, LGAF and 34 of whose members received current Army pay but were not included in the recognized roster of any LGAF unit.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY:

No useful purpose will be served in discussing the history of units which have been recognized. However, it may be stated that LGAF was composed of numerous squadrons during the occupation period. When a squadron had been recruited to a strength which made it difficult to employ satisfactorily it was divided by order of the CO, LGAF to become two squadrons, each being given numerical designations. These squadrons were attached piecemeal to US Army Forces during the early days of the liberation, when and where needed. In the latter part of February 1945 many of the squadrons were consolidated to become the 1st Regt, LGAF, companies of which were composed of 115 men under the pre-war Philippine Army T/O. At this time those squadron members who were in excess to the requirements of the regiment were discharged and returned to their homes, though they performed service in attachment to US Army units prior to their discharge. This action resulted in non-recognition for the discharged members inasmuch as their names could not be included in rosters submitted for recognition purposes because they were no longer with the unit with which they had been previously attached to US Army units. Reasons why those listed on the attached supplementary rosters should be awarded recognition for service as well as reasons why they were not included in strength rosters submitted for recognition during the liberation period will be treated in this report.

3. FINDINGS:

a. No field investigation was deemed necessary after a careful review of available evidence. Statements of the following former LGAF officers are reflected in the findings:

Major Robert B. Lapham - Former CO, LGAF
Lt Dionisio V Lucas - (PA), Former Asst Adj, 1st Regt,
LGAF

Lt Antonio Estrada - Former Asst Adj, LCAF
 Maj Antonio Hernandez - Former Sector Comdr Eastern
 Pang. & Former En CO, 1st Bn,
 1st Regt, LCAF.

b. The record of service for those listed on the attached supplementary rosters was substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. Though documentary evidence is lacking excepting dates of service shown on rosters dated 1944 and 1945, it is believed from verbal testimony of LCAF officers and the inclosed certificate of Maj Lapham that the following is true:

(1) Squadron 1, LCAF 23 additional men have been presented for recognition. This squadron came under overall LCAF command on 1 May 1944 and was active through out the occupation and liberation, periods. 23 members of the squadron were not recognized because they were not present with the squadron during liberation attachment. Several had been wounded during fighting immediately prior to the liberation when an attack order was published by Hq LCAF. (Incl 1) (FO No. 4, Hq LCAF dtd 4 January 1945). Others were ill and could not take part in liberation fighting as a result of field activity prior to the landing at Lingayen Gulf of US Army Forces.

(2) Squadron 111 was formed by Maj Lapham in May 1942 and remained active through the occupation and liberation. 59 members were not recognized during the liberation having been released at their own request when Squadron 111 was absorbed into the 1st Regt LCAF in February 1945. All of those members released at their own request had been attached to US Army units prior to release but were no longer present when the Squadron was recognized as part of the 1st Regt, LCAF. The attachment was to the 6th Division from 28 January 1945 to 7 February 1945.

(3) Squadron 206 was formed by Germiniano de Leon, private, Philippine Scouts in July 1942 by authority of Major (then 1st Lt) Robert B. Lapham. Late in 1944 it became squadron 206 and 206-A having been divided when it was too large to be handled as a single squadron. Squadron 206 was attached to the 112th Cav Regt, 1st Cavalry Division from 31 January to 15 Feb. 1945 during which time they took part in the battle for Manila. When released from attachment, Squadron 206 reported back to Hq LCAF at Guimba Nueva Ecija and was made a part of the 1st Regt LCAF then undergoing training. Part of the Squadron was attached to the 6th, 25th and 32nd Inf Div. 26 January 1945 to 15 February 1945, 22 of these men were never recognized nor paid for their services to the US Divisions operating in Nueva Ecija. 16 of these 22 men were discharged as excess to needs when Squadron 206 incorporated into 1st Regt LCAF while 6 others reported back to duty with the Philippine Army, having previously been USAFFE or Philippine Scouts.

(4) Squadron 221 was formed as a squadron in October 1944, having been previously a detachment directly under command of Capt Harry Mackenzie, Ex O, LCAF. 25 members were not recognized for liberation services though they had been attached to the first Cavalry Brigade from 31 January to 3 March 1945 and took part in the brigades' advance from Guimba, N.E. to Manila. These 25 were disbanded when squadron 221 was absorbed into the 1st Regt as excess to the needs of the regiment and consequently their names were not included on the original roster submitted for recognition although they had performed service during the liberation. Some were Ex-USAFFE and reported to military control before a recognition roster was submitted by Hq LCAF.

(5) Squadron 265 was formed in 1944 from elements of squadron 269 and men who had formerly been under Capt Charles Cushing in Eastern Pangasinan as Squadron 108. Two (2) men of the unit were not present when the unit was recognized with the 25th Division having been discharged at their own request. They had served with the unit when it was attached to the 1st Infantry Regiment, 6th Division from 21 January 1945 to 4 February 1945.

(6) Squadron 269 was formed late in 1942 from elements of Squadron 111 which had at that time grown too large to handle administratively and tactically under conditions then obtaining. Squadron 269 was a mounted squadron during a part of the occupation and was made up of members from the same town, Umingan, Pangasinan. 5 men were not recognized with the squadron for service during the liberation of Pangasinan though they had been attached to the 25th Div. US Army. This attachment was from 19 January 1945 to 8 February 1945. The unrecognized members were discharged at their own request when Squadron 269 was absorbed into 1st Bn, 1st Regt, LCAF in the latter part of February 1945 and were not present when the roster was submitted for recognition.

(7) Squadron 267 was formed in October 1944 from elements of Squadron 207 which at that time was divided into two squadrons and available arms distributed equally between the squadrons. Squadron 267 was attached to the 63rd Inf. 6th Div. US Army from 4 February 1945 to 14 February 1945 and to the 622d Ordnance Ammunition Company, 6th Div. from 15 February 1945 to 14 March 1945. Squadron 267 was absorbed into the 2nd Bn, 1st Regt, LCAF in late February 1945 and its roster submitted for recognition. 5 men of the squadron who were attached during the 4-14 February 1945 period and 16 men who were attached during the 15 Feb-March 1945 period were not listed on the roster submitted for recognition in April 1945. The two groups, after release from attachment were excess to the needs of the 2nd Bn, 1st Regt, LCAF and were discharged. They were not present with the unit when its roster was submitted for recognition and therefore were not included on the roster.

(8) Squadron 300 was formed in July 1942 by Alfonso Echevare, former private 26th Cav (PS) by authority of Major (then Lt) Lapham. The squadron was active throughout the occupation and liberation periods. Squadron 300 was attached to the 20th Inf, 6th Div, US Army during the Lupao San Jose-Munoz, N.E., fighting from 28 January to 7 February 1945. 9 men of squadron 300 who were attached during this period were not recognized for their services. Squadron 300 was absorbed into the 1st Regt LGAF late in February 1945. The 9 men not recognized were discharged as surplus at that time and were not included on the roster submitted for recognition.

(9) Squadron 311 was formed as an independent unit in Sept 1942. The CO contacted Lt Albert A Short, Dist CO, N.E., in Feb 1943 and his squadron was made a part of LGAF operating during the occupation and liberation periods. The squadron was attached at various times to a number of American Units. During the operations of the 6th Div, US Army in the Lupao - San Jose Talavera Munoz, N.E. area the squadron was attached to 1st Regt of the division from 30 January 1945 to 9 February 1945. 10 men of the squadron who were attached during this period were not recognized for their services. Squadron 311, after being released by the 6th Div became a part of the 128th Prov Bn, 32nd Division and took part in the fighting on the Villa Verde trail from San Manuel, Pangasinan to Santa Fe, Nueva Viscaya. The 10 men previously unrecognized had been discharged at their own request prior to the Villa Verde campaign and were not included on the roster submitted for recognition because they were not present at that time.

c. The requirements of the five basic points for guerrilla recognition have been met by the LGAF squadrons with which this report is concerned. The previous recognition of the squadrons during the liberation, while actually in the field is adequate proof of service.

d. During the period of liberation all recognitions were for actual attachment to US Army Forces then active in campaigns on Luzon. Guerrillas receiving recognition must have been present with their units at the time that the unit roster was submitted for recognition. Those bona fide guerrillas who had rendered service to US Army Forces prior to the submission of rosters for recognition for services rendered but who were not present with their guerrilla unit when the roster was compiled could not be included. Therefore they were neither paid nor recognized for service which had been rendered prior to the recognition of the unit if they were not actually present with the unit when rosters were submitted. It is believed that the 178 men with whom this report is concerned were in this category and that they should be recognized for services actually rendered to US Army units or for services occurring immediately prior to the

landing when LCAF squadrons actively took the field against Japanese. Injuries or sickness occurring as a result of the latter action had precluded their attachment to US Army units.

e. Major Lapham and LCAF staff officers carefully scrutinized and screened the attached rosters and verified the services and ranks of the members listed thereon, as the ranks held by them immediately prior to discharge or separation due to sickness or wounds. Major Lapham has recommended that members on the attached rosters be favorably considered for recognition (Incl 2).

f. All worthy members of squadrons concerned have been included on the roster. A separate casualty roster screened by Major Lapham will be submitted to Casualty Section, GAD, with a recommendation that bona fide casualties be recognized.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

There are no political affiliations or aspirations evidenced by these unit members.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the supplementary rosters of Squadrons listed below in an aggregate strength of 175 be favorably considered for recognition for the periods set opposite the squadron designations, both dates inclusive.

3. Record show that this Squadron has 334 OFF and EM previously recognized with the 1st Regiment, Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces and 5 on the supplementary roster.

4. It is recommended that these rosters as in Par 1 be accepted as the only official rosters of casualties of Squadron 269, Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces, all individuals named therein, having entered a casualty status in line of duty.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF SQUADRON 269 AND OTHER ALLIED
UNITS

Way back in the darkest days of the occupation when the USAFFE units in Luzon had become disintegrated and scattered as a result of the sudden decision to retreat to the mountain fastnesses of Bataan, a young American officer of the 803rd M.P. Co. (USAFFE), accompanied by a certain Sgt. Esteban Lumyeo, appeared on the vicinity of Calitlitan, Umingan, Pangasinan, during the early part of May, 1942. This man is Major Robert B. Lapham, whose unstinted loyalty to the cause of the war and foresight has led to the organization of one of the strongest and best organized guerrilla units during the occupation, the Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces.

The beginnings of the 269th Squadron, LGAF has centered mostly on the early activities of the founder and organizer of the LGAF, immediately upon his arrival in Umingan, men from all sorts of life flocked to him and offered their services for the cause of the resistance movement. He had inducted them into the service of the United States Army and organized them into a solidified fighting unit affiliated to his original organization, the 803rd M.P., with himself as its commanding officer. To give it full color as a resistance organization under the LGAF, he had designated this original organization as Squadron 207, LGAF. Later, however when it turned out that there is another organization of the same designation under Capt. Serafica, he changed the name of the organization to Squadron 111.

The news of the existence of a resistance unit under Major Lapham had travelled fast in the underground that the original Squadron 111 had increased in proportions by continuous additional enlistments of volunteers. Major Lapham had therefore decided to authorize one of its ablest detachment commanders, Federico Ma. Doliente, to muster enough men to compose another Squadron independent of Squadron 111. It did not take long for Capt. Doliente to organize the most sturdy men in the unit into one complete Squadron, supplemented by new volunteers, and on October 19, 1942, what is now known as Squadron 269 (Fighting '69) was officially born. Major Lapham had retained command of the original organization (Squadron 111) but in view of the increasing number of enlistments and volunteers, he decided on the early part of December, 1942 to relinquish command of Squadron 111 in favor of Capt. Filadelfo Macaranas.

Capt. Doliente was captured by the Japanese on February, 1943, and Lt. Federico Estipona, his Executive Officer assumed command of Squadron 269. Likewise, in a bloody encounter with the Japanese and constabulary forces in the following month, Capt. Macaranas was wounded and captured. Immediately, Lt. Juan B. Marcos, his Executive Officer assumed command of Squadron 111.

Capt. Doliente was later released by the Japanese upon promised of good behaviour and was designated as the Chief of Police of Umingan. This was an opportunity which the resistance units had been waiting for inasmuch as his being a peace officer of the enemy will give the guerrilleros greater freedom of action. With due authority from Major Lapham, Capt. Doliente recalled whatever men in the 269th Squadron as were willing to sacrifice with him to serve as the watchdog for the Japanese and constabulary forces. His new unit was designated officially as the Headquarters Detachment of Squadron 269, and served as the message center of all guerrilla units under Major Lapham. This task was perilous but the men and their leader carried on their mission without regrets.

In order to avoid any lawlessness among the civilian volunteers of the different units in their treatment of the civilian population, and in order to insure the safe conduct of the different units, Major Lapham decided to create an M.P. Detachment in April, 1943. He ordered the split of Squadron 111, the greater bulk of which was designated as Squadron 111 M.P. with Lt. Velasquez as commanding officer. Lt. Marcos retained command over the rest of the unit. But on September, 1943, he was ordered to fuse all his men in the 111th Squadron as a detachment of the 269th Squadron. This was done in order to avoid any confusion with the 111th M.P. Squadron in matters of duties, responsibilities and jurisdiction.

On the latter part of 1943, Lt. Marcos was sent to Urdaneta, Pan asinan, to effect the surrender or confiscate the arms of astray guerrilla units whose leaders had either been captured or killed during the intensified campaigns of the Japanese and constabulary forces. In the Cataruan Hills near the vicinity of Urdaneta and Malasiqui, he found plenty of arms including a machine gun but in the possession of an organized guerrilla unit. This was a detachment of Squadron 108 (under Capt. Beltran) under the over-all command of Major C. J. Cushing.

Lt. Marcos was not able to effect any surrender or confiscate any of the arms of the Urdaneta Detachment in view of the stern refusal of the officers, but he had obtained the assurance of said officers of their willingness to subjugate themselves to the authority of Major Lapham. He therefore returned to Umingan and obtained authority from 269th Squadron commander to incorporate the Urdaneta Detachment as a unit of the 269th Squadron. Later Major Lapham had granted full authority to Lt. Marcos to organize a new squadron to include all his detachments in the 269th Squadron including the Urdaneta Detachment in view of the increasing number of volunteers in order to streamline as much as possible the administration of all guerrilla units in the LGAF. This new squadron was designated as Squadron 265, LGAF.

In view of intensive raids of the Japanese and constabulary forces on one hand and the traitorous works of Makapilis (Ganaps) on the other, Capt. Estipona was captured during a bloody skirmish at Mugoz, Nueva Ecija on March, 1944. Capt. Doliente immediately assumed full control over all units of Squadron 269, but when he was designated later as the Sector Commander for Eastern Pangasinan by Major Lapham, the buck fell on Lt. Antonio M. Hernandez, a young but courageous officer that match his gifted wit, to become the titular head of Squadron 269, with the exception of the Headquarters Detachment which remained under the full control of Capt. Doliente.

On October, 1944, Capt. Macaranas was released from the hospital. He immediately reported to LGAF Headquarters and with his former men (now in the 269th and in the 111 M.P. Squadrons) he organized another Squadron (109) by authority of Major Lapham.

Capt. Doliente was relieved from his duties as sector commander for Eastern Pangasinan on December, 1944, and was designated as the Provost Marshall of all LGAF units under the over-all command of Major Lapham. Capt. Antonio Hernandez was designated in his stead in addition to being the Commanding Officer of Squadron 269. That portion of Southern Pangasinan Sector under the territory of Capt. Juan B. Marcos was also placed later under his jurisdiction by Capt. Roy C. Hunt, Pangasinan Area Commander, in addition to the Eastern Pangasinan Sector. This was found expedient in order to consolidate the active area of operations preparatory to the big scale offensive made a few days later.

On 4 January 1945, five days before the first wave of American Liberation Forces landed in Luzon, the LGAF High Command issued orders to "START OPERATIONS IMMEDIATELY". Squadron 289 under Capt. Hernandez started widespread hostilities against the enemy (harassing enemy concentrations, demolition of ammo dumps and bridges and destruction of communications by destroying telegraph wires and ambushing enemy patrols) in the Southeastern Pangasinan area (San Quintin, Umingan, Balungao). Squadron 111 M.P. and the Headquarters Detachment under Capt. Doliente were ordered to proceed anywhere their duties and services were needed most, as they served as the "mobile unit" of the entire LGAF Command. Squadron 109 under Capt. Macaranas was ordered to Hq LGAF, then at Baloy as security and with responsibility to protect the Headquarters Area. Other men of this unit were sent out to the field as demolition squads. The 265th Squadron under Capt. Marcos which had established its headquarters at Labit, Urdaneta, Pangasinan, proceeded demolition work around the vicinity of Urdaneta and Sta. Barbara, and proceeded to the beach area to meet the landing forces at San Fabian.

It was thus that the 269th Squadron and its allied units (the 111th M.P., Hq Detachment, 109th and the 265th Squadrons) faced the realities of the occupation until the landing of the American Forces. On 11 January 1945, contact was made with the American Forces by the men of 265th Squadron, and on the following day all the men of the said unit were attached for operational purposes to the 201st CIC Detachment, I Corps, at San Fabian; subsequently, the 269th Squadron carrying the entire body of the LGA F HEADQUARTERS (including the person of Major Lapham) reached Manaoag and immediately all men of the various units were all attached to U.S. Army forces for operational purposes. The men had been furnished all the equipments they so desired and they were no doubt mainly responsible for the fast liberation of Pangasinan.

As the campaign had thinned out, however, towards Nueva Ecija and eastern Pangasinan, the U.S. Army units had deemed wise to organize the guerrilla units attached to them into well-organized fighting forces in accordance with their needs. It was therefore expedient that some of the men who had previously taken active participation in the operations during the early part of the liberation and who had served well for the cause of the resistance movement during the occupation, had to be dispersed and sent

home until such time "as the needs of the service will require". Some of these men who were forced to go home with a heavy heart found their way individually into other U.S. Army units, others had been forced to stay at home for good. Some of them had been recalled for active service, but others were never contacted due to the difficulty of communication and to the confusion wrought by the various operations of the war.

The 269th Squadron and all its allied units had been duly recognized as bona fide guerrilla organizations as a testimony of their valor in furtherance of peace and justice.

Sir:

1. We worked for pop trucks last night in Lerayungo, but were passed. We proceeded to Umagan at dawn and attack pop camp in Seb. house & a private house. We killed eight Japs and several wounded, but we ^{were not able} ~~were~~ to get into their camps. No casualties on our side.
 2. Took 23 prisoners, 2 used for demolition. Bridges in Lerayungo, Umagan and Gonzato, San Geronimo burned. Telephone wires cut.
 3. Jap are reinforced in Umagan, we will strike there again this afternoon and proceed to Tayug, passing thru San Guindin (Jap reinforcements in Umagan, coming from Lupao - is there no action there yet?)
 4. Phase give us immunities for carbines, Tommies and col. 30 M L Tommies especially.

1. In accordance with your secret orders dated Dec. 13 & 14, 1944 this Squadron has successfully carried into effect the same (ambushing enemy moving trucks and doing sabotage activities in the vicinities of Villasis and Urdaneta);

2. This Squadron on Jan. 13, 1945 thru Int. Officer (Lt. C. A. Ten) with other officers was able to contact the American Forces of Liberation. The first to be contacted was the C. O. of the Advance Reconnaissance Troops under Capt. Hall on the road between Manaoag and Urdaneta.

3. Thru direct orders of Capt. Hall, my Int. Officer was conducted to the HQ of the CIC at San Fabian, bringing with him the general roster of two squadrons under Sq. 269 as per instructions from Area Commander. (For your immediate information, I beg your pardon for having adopted your signature and Capt. Hunt in the General Roster I have submitted as the time is too late for me to forward same to you.)

4. This unit is now actively extending every possible assistance to the American Forces under Capt. Hall of the Advanced Reconnaissance Troops and under Major Kenerly of the Armored Troops and covering the field for any pertinent information for the CIC Hqs. several of my men have been sent for this purpose.

5. Our Int. Off., Lt. Ten, has been designated for the present by Lt. Cook, Jr. C. O. of the CIC to act as the liaison officer between the CIC American Forces and your General Headquarters.

6. I am recording all activities of my Squadron and shall submit to you later when the same shall have been properly prepared.

Major ANTONIO HERNANDEZ, O-29417, joined the LGAF 22 July '42 with the rank of Sgt. assigned to the 1st Detachment, Sqdn 111, then under 1st Sgt. JUAN B. MARGOS, now Capt. J. B. MARGOS. Designation under Capt. Marcos was Patrol Leader in the territory of Umangan, San Quintin, Natividad, Pangasinan.

At the organization of Sqdn. 269, Major Hernandez was transferred from Sqdn 111 to Sqdn 269, then under Lt. F. M. DOLIENTE, now Capt. Doliente, Oct. 1942 with the same grade and designation.

On 1 May 1943 he was appointed 2nd Lieutenant and assigned to Detachment Commander, 2nd Detachment, Sqdn 269 by Major ROBERT B LAPHAM, and on 15 Sept '43 was promoted 1st Lt. and assigned Executive Officer, Sqdn 269 in addition to his duties of Detachment Commander.
