Dear Mr. Gabriel:

The Commanding General directs that you be informed that final consideration has been given to the claim for guerrilla recognition of your organization, Navotas Unit, an element of the overall command of Marking's Fil-American Troops (MFAT).

Subsequent to a protracted study of the records of this overall command, it was determined that any favorable consideration, either in full or in part, of claims for recognition of units under the direct control of the MFAT would be accorded in the form of a composite roster.

On 2 October 1947, Mr. Marking V. Agustin, the overall commander of MFAT, submitted a composite roster to this headquarters for approval. With the exception of fifty-five (55) necessary deletions by this headquarters plus the correction by the I Corps Commander of one hundred one (101) officer grades improperly listed on the II Corps and GHQ quota, the roster as submitted by Mr. Agustin has been approved in its entirety. Your unit, as a subordinate element of MFAT under its direct control, was given just and adequate consideration during the preparation of this composite roster. The degree of favorable consideration taken by this headquarters on the request for recognition of your unit may be determined by the number of names of personnel from your unit appearing on this composite roster. Unfavorable consideration of your unit request for recognition will be evidenced by the exclusion of your personnel from this composite roster.

The approval by this headquarters of this composite roster, representing all units under the direct control of MFAT, constitutes the final and conclusive action upon the claim for recognition of all units considered in the recognition study of this composite roster. All queries relative to the above action and/or incident to guerrilla recognition matters concerning your unit should be addressed to your overall commanding officer, Mr. Marking V. Agustin.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated, 15 September 1946, in which you request reconsideration of the unfavorable decision rendered by this headquarters on 4 May 1946 with regards to the recognition of the Navotas Unit, Marking's Fil-American Troops.

"Reason"

It is the desire of this headquarters to avoid all appearance of arbitrary decisions in the case of claimant guerrilla units. Your request for reconsideration is therefore accepted. It must be emphasized, however, that it would be extremely helpful if you were to forward as quickly as possible such additional pertinent documentary evidence as has not been submitted previously and which, you feel, reflects favorably upon your claim. These additional data should be original documents, or photostatic copies of the original documents, or true copies of the original documents certified to by United States Army officers of field grade on duty with the Guerrilla Affairs Branch, G-3 Section of this headquarters.

✓ Your request for reconsideration will be placed on file in this headquarters to await appropriate action at the earliest practicable time. You must appreciate that hundreds of claimant guerrilla units are now being initially investigated, and that review of rejected units must necessarily follow them. It is therefore suggested that you defer further inquiry into the status of your reconsideration for at least four months from the date of receipt of this letter, inasmuch as frequent inquiries are neither necessary nor desirable because of the time consumed in superfluous correspondence.

The "1st Bn, Navotas Unit", Marking's Fil-Americans, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all available substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy, during the occupation.
- b. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- c. Adequate records were not maintained (names, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
- d. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.
- e. Record of service was not established by sufficient acceptable evidence.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, copy attached.

1. The 1st Bn., Nevotas Unit, Marking's Fil-American Guerrillas commanded by Moises I. Gabriel of Calococan, Risal is not favorably considered for recognition as a Guerrilla Unit.
2. The majority of the men of this unit lived in their homes and carried on normal civilian activities during the enemy occupation.
3. The Unit did not maintain sufficient records to show they operated as an organized unit during the enemy occupation.
4. Statements made by Officers of the activities of the unit were conflicting.
5. This unit was never engaged in combat activities against the enemy as an organized military force.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 63

DEMobilIZATION OF REMNENTS OF THE PHILIPPINE ARMY AND
OTHER GUERRILLA UNITS IN THE FIELD

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Government has been advised by the Commander-in-Chief, United States Army Forces, Pacific, of the termination of hostilities and the surrender of Japanese forces;

WHEREAS, the Government has further been advised by the Commander-in-Chief, United States Army Forces, Pacific, that this termination of hostilities and surrender of the Japanese forces has rendered unnecessary the maintenance for further field service of elements of the Army of the Philippines in addition to regularly activated units and of those guerrilla units already recognized;

WHEREAS, continued assembly and maintenance of headquarters is not a prerequisite to recognition of guerrilla units; and

WHEREAS, the demobilization of guerrilla units in the field will not prejudice the continuance of recognition of such guerrilla units as can produce evidence showing that they have maintained organized military forces in the field in effective opposition to the Japanese, which will be the basis for award of such benefits as may be authorized to members of such units;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SERGIO OSMEÑA, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the Philippines, do hereby order:

1. That all unrecognized guerrilla units be disbanded and that all members thereof return to their homes and engage in their normal civilian pursuits.
2. That all arms, ammunitions, and military supplies and equipment in the possession of unrecognized guerrilla units or of individual members of such units be immediately turned in to the Commander of the nearest unit of the United States Army or of the Army of the Philippines.

In compliance with orders from the Chief of Branch, Guerrilla Affairs Branch, this Headquarters, Lt. Paul A. Ferrigue investigated the guerrilla unit known as the 1st Bn., Navotas Unit, Markings Fil-American Guerrillas. This investigation was made to determine whether or not this unit should be recognized as a guerrilla unit.

This unit was organized during the month of October 1942 by Moises I. Gabriel of Navotas, Rizal, Luzon, P. I., upon receiving verbal authority from Col. Marcos V. Agustin, Commanding Officer of Markings Fil-American Guerrillas.

Moises I. Gabriel is at the present time, a patient at the North General Hospital, Manila, and is too ill to be investigated by the contact team. Captain Pedro S. Angeles, former Commanding Officer of "C" Company of the Navotas Unit represented the Commanding Officer during the interview by the contact team.

The strength of this unit taken from the rosters submitted totals 704 Officers and enlisted men. However, throughout the investigation all members questioned stated the strength was approximately 500 men.

It was stated during the interview that this unit operated north of Manila in the area surrounding Navotas, Rizal, under direct control of Markings Fil-American Headquarters. However, the unit could not produce any documentary evidence to confirm this.

Captain Pedro S. Angeles claims their unit was active in their mission of sabotage, procurement of arms and supplies and intelligence work from the date of organization to the date of arrival of United States Armed Forces. It was stated that intelligence reports of this unit were turned in to the Commanding Officer and further disposition was unknown.

This unit was also said to have been employed in the transporting of arms, by sailboat, from Bataan to the city of Navotas, Rizal which were then carried into the hills to Markings Headquarters. No records were kept as to number of arms transported, or number of trips made by sailboats.

Unit claims to have possessed 8 pistols and 73 rifles at the time the unit was organized in 1942. These weapons were said to have been procured from civilians of the city of Navotas, Rizal. This number of weapons was said to have been increased to 2 knee mortars, and 30 Cal. machine guns, 1 bar, 30 pistols and 100 rifles. During the year 1943 through capture of arms from the Japanese. In the year 1944, all but a minimum of arms to maintain the units operations were turned over to Markings Headquarters leaving the unit

with 30 pistols and 50 rifles.

Upon arrival of the U. S. Armed Forces, unit claims they were issued 4 machine guns, 4 Pistols and 170 rifles by the 37th Infantry Division. However, the unit does not possess records showing they were issued arms by the U. S. Army or records showing that these weapons were turned in.

In August 1943, both Moises Gabriel, the Commanding Officer of the unit and Captain Pedro Angeles were captured by the Japanese and were sentenced, by court martial, to 13 Years hard labor in the Davao Concentration Camp on Mindanao, P. I. These two officers were absent from their unit from the date of their capture until June 1945. Captain Miguel Lopez, the S-2 of the unit assumed command at the time the original commanding officer was captured and remained in command during his absence. No definite reason could be given why the Executive Officer of the unit did not assume command.

During an interview with Miguel Lopez, he stated that the unit was unable to maintain any records while he was in command and he could give no definite account of the units activities within the period August 1943 to February 1945, except that they continued their mission of procurement of arms and intelligence reports. In a previous interview, Angeles claimed that he and Gabriel had maintained contact with their unit through persons visiting them while they were held prisoners at the Davao Concentration Camp, Mindanao, while Lopez stated no contact was kept with them, nor did he hear from them during their absence from August 1943 to June 1945.

Moises de Veyra, who is carried as a captain, with duty as S-1, on the roster of this unit is Chief of Police of the City of Navotas, Rizal and has held this position throughout the Japanese occupation to the present time. He stated that he was appointed Lieutenant (1st or 2nd unknown) by Moises Gabriel in August 1942. He did not know of being promoted to Captain and knew very little of the operations of the unit. He claimed he was a platoon leader of approximately 70 men but never was in actual combat against the enemy.

Unit claims to have joined the 145 Regiment, 37th Division, U. S. Army on 10 February 1945 and remained under that division until it had proceeded north from Manila passed Navotas; they were then ordered to return to their homes and await further orders. The total period of time this unit was said to have served with United States Forces at this time was one month, however the unit could not furnish any documentary evidence to confirm this.

All personnel of this unit then remained in their homes until the return of Gabriel and Angeles from the Concentration Camp in June 1945. Upon arrival of these men, Gabriel was hospitalized while Angeles upon reporting to Col Markings Headquarters received orders to muster one company from the Navotas unit for a new assignment. This company was assigned as "J" Company, 3rd Battalion, 2nd Yay Regiment with Angeles as company Commander.

Angeles claims his company was then attached to 149th Regiment, 38th Division and participated in the mop-up of the Kay Ban Ban, Bulakan Area and that the company remained with the 149th Regiment until they were turned over to the 3rd Repl. Bn, Camp Murphy. Angeles further stated that approximately 80% of his company were processed upon recommendation of Major Martin C. Grigg of the 149th Infantry Regiment, 38th Division, United States Army, but were never recognized as guerrillas. However a through check was made by the investigation team at 3rd Repl. Bn, Camp Murphy, Headquarters Philippine Army and 86th Division Guerrilla Affairs Section, U. S. Army, and no records are on file showing that these men were processed. This unit at present has been disbanded and the members have taken up civilian employment.

POLITICAL ASPECTS

This unit has no apparent political affiliations or aspirations as a group.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that this unit be not favorably considered for recognition.

BASIS FOR NON-RECOGNITION

1. The majority of the men of this unit lived in their homes and carried on normal civilian activities during the enemy occupation.

2. The unit did not maintain sufficient records to show they operated as an organized unit during the enemy occupation.

3. Statements, made by officers, of the activities of the unit were conflicting.

4. This unit was never engaged in combat against the enemy as an organized Military Force.

HISTORY AND ORGANIZATION

Somewhere around the later part of May, 1942, news about the organization of Marking's Fil-Americans, a guerrilla unit dedicated to the difficult and perilous job of making things hard for the Japs during their stay in the Philippines, thereby contributing to the early victory of the Allied forces, circulated far and wide, reaching even remotest part of the Philippines.

In June, 1942, Moises D. Gabriel of Navotas, Rizal, fully realizing the necessity of an underground resistance, organized a small party of selected and trusted members and went in search of the base camp of the Marking's Fil-Americans. The party traveled long and weary. They were met with no little amount of inconveniences, not to mention the numerous dangers to which they were subjected, and it was only their strong faith in America and their innate hatred for anything Japanese that made them go on. They had Bataan and Corregidor in their minds --- the thousands of Filipino youth who fought and died in martyrdom that the "four freedoms" might be preserved --- and, of course, Gen. MacArthur and his inspiring promise that "I shall return".

At long last, the tired and weary party were able to locate the HQ of the Marking's Fil-Americans and at once, direct contact was made with its CO.

Gabriel and his party stayed where to stay at the said HQ to undergo certain training and to acquaint themselves with the duties and responsibilities of a guerrilla pending instructions from Marcos Villa Agustin as regards their assignments as members of the Marking's guerrillas.

In September, 1942, by order of Marcos Villa Agustin, Gabriel proceeded with his men to Navotas and recruited more members to be added to the increasing membership of their guerrilla unit. The people knew the peril of joining and taking part with underground resistance. They heard news of the brutalities to which mere suspects were being subjected to, which made the very mention of the word "Fort Santiago" a terror in itself, yet they, with the blood of their brave forefathers flowing thickly within their veins and refusing to admit even with the exaggerated Jap propaganda that the cause for which Bataan stands for was a defeated cause, continued to join the organization in increasing numbers.

In the course of the performance of his activities, Maj. Gabriel met Pedro S. Angeles. He learned that Pedro S. Angeles was a pre-war employee of the Bureau of Public Works who had chosen to leave the ~~province~~ city for the province and live a life of sacrifices rather than served under the Puppet Government. He was very much impressed by such an Anti-Jap attitude of Angeles, that after a very careful deliberation, he convinced him to join the Marking's Fil-Americans. Angeles was inducted as Capt. of the Navotas unit and there after assisted Maj. Gabriel in recruiting as many men as necessary to enable the unit to live up to Col. Agustin's expectations. This unit consisted of Filipinos from different walks of life. It included professionals, employes, farmers, fishermen, car-

penters, mechanics. Through the joint efforts of Lt. Col. @Gabriel, Capt. Angeles, and thier officers and meh, the Navotas Unit of the "Marking's Fil-American" was able to secure the following:

1. automatic ---30-calibre rifle
2. 50 enfield and springfield rifles
3. 10 handgrenades
4. 5,000 armored piercing bullets and 50 calibre tracers
5. 1.32-caliber pistol
6. 1 high power spy glass
7. Pirates, Victory, and Mayblossom cigarettes
8. Dried fish

Besides the above, they also issued guerrilla notes an exchange of food, medical supply, and cash amounting to no less than ₱1,000.00. The civic spirited citizens of Navotas gave aid to the guerrilla unit with no more security than the assurance that they were helping in shortening the war and for the early recovery of the democratic way of ~~the~~ life which was carried away from them by the Japs much against thier will.

On June 1, 1943, Capt. Angeles was promoted to Major by Col. Marcos Villa Agustin because of his ex celleny job in conncrtion with the transferring of arms, amunitions, and supplies that they secured to the base camp via Marikina right under the very noses of Japs sentries without detection.

THE TRIGGER SQUAD-

Acting upon the order of Lt. Col. Gabriel, Pvt. Ricardo Luciano armed himself with a pistol to go and find Charles Strebel, a German mestizo Notoraaas Detective Officer of the Santos Regiment, Oliveros and Sgt. Ruperto Camitan, Pvt. Luciano killed Strebel but was caught and detained by the Japs. However he manages to escape while being hospitalized at the San Lazaro Hospital. *1943 date*

The Japs learned of the activities of the Navotas unit of the "MARKING'S FIL-AMERICAN and the officers were placed in their wanted list. One of the officer who was caught was unable to endure the inhumak tortures which were inflicted on his person and led a squadd of Kemfies to Maj. Angeles' house which was the's outpost. The wife, sons and daughter of Maj. Angeles were arrested. The brutalities (beating, water cure, hanging, and electricution) which were inflicted to them resulted, to the untimely death of Maj. Angeles's 28 years old son Romeo who refused to admit that his father was connected with the activities for which he was being wanted.

When the 37th "Buckeye" Division encountered the Japs at the Dampalit, Malabon, Rizal, the Navotas unit of the "Marking's Fil-Americans" fought side by side with the Yanks. Those who were unarmed hepped as amunition carrier and messengers and furnished the Yanks with first hand informations whatever the Yanks needed during thier offensive. After the offensive many were accounted KIA and WIA.

During the retreat of the Japanese from Intramuros, this unit killed 300 Japs who were trying to escaped on bancas and rafts. This engagement was commanded by the already Capt. Ricardo Luciano.

ACTIVE COMBAT & MOPPING OPERATION-

Although we were not side by side ~~whan~~ our former unit when the American Liberators arrived we, who were inducted into the USFIP 130 Inf. 107 Div. under Col. W. Fertig in Mindanao saw action

in the battle of Esing, Davao. When that part of Davao was already cleared we were given pass to enplane for Luzonto join our former unit. We reported to our HQ at Norzagaray, Bul. which was then attached to the 43rd Div. then to the 38th Div. U.S. Army. I was ordered by Col. Marking to assemble my men. To conform with the re-organization of the "Marking's Fil-American Troop, I was assigned Co of "J" Co. 3rd Bn 2nd Yag Regt. We were engaged in mopping operation in Kay Banban, Bul. In this encounter we lost one EM and one EM wounded with Lt. Rainer of the 38th Div. we were able to clear up the place of Japanese remnants. From there we were turned over to the 3rd Repl. Bn. Camp Murphy APO 75 for disposition by Major Martin C Griggs of the 149th Inf. Regt. 38th Div. U.S. Army on 15 Aug. '45 We were processed and reprocessed at Camp Murphy with the ranks we carry now to conform with the T/O of the PA.


