The Commanding General directs that you be informed that final consideration has been given to the claim for guerrilla recognition of your organization, Salvador's Combat, an element of the overall commend of Marking's Fil-American Troops (MFAT).

Subsequent to a protracted study of the records of this overall command, it was determined that any favorable consideration, either in full or in part, of claims for recognition of units under the direct control of the MFAT would be accorded in the form of a conposite rester.

On 2 October 1947, Mr. Marking V. Agustin, the overall commander of MFAT, submitted a composite rester to this headquarters for approval. Bith the exception of fifty-five (55) necessary deletions by this headquarters plus the correction by the I Corps Commander of one hundred one (101) officer grades improperly listed on the II Corps and GHQ quota, the roster as submitted by Mr. Agustin has been approved in its entirety. Your unit, as a subordinate element of MFAT under its direct centrol, was given just and adequate Consideration during the preparation of this composite roster. The degree of favorable consideration taken by this headquarters on the request for recognition of your unit may be determined by the number of manes of personnel from your unit appearing on this composite roster. Unfavorable consideration of your unit request for recog-Inition will be evidenced by the exclusion of your personnel from this composite rester.



Dear Mr. Adrianos

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed The Commanding veneral has circuted that you be informed that the Salvador Coubst Unit, let Army Corps, jerking's Fil-American Troops, purporting to be a guerzilia organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full considera-tion of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.

The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.

c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.

Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).

Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.

It is desired to emphasize that each claiment member of the unit is considered to have had just and adequate appraisal for recognition when his services were evaluated concurrently with this study of the unit with which he claims sembership. Individual requests were not necessary nor appropriate then, or now, as their acceptance would in effect constitute unjustified duplication of consideration of one individual by this headquarters.

- b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. The only evidence submitted that is applicable to the unit in question consists of letters of commendation from affiliated guerrilla leaders. Most of this evidence refers to higher guerrilla echelons without directly mentioning the "Salvador's Combat Unit". The subject unit claims attachment to the 11th Airborne Div from 9 Feb 1945 to 22 Mar 1945 and to the 373rd Saerchlight Bar from 23 Mar 1945 to 10 May 1945; however, there has been no evidence produced to substantiate these claims.
- c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. All claims of overt seristance made by the unit were verbal. Absolutely no substatisting evidence was presented. Members of the unit asserted that their combat actions were all of a "nit and run" nature, and that it would be impossible to estimate the damage actually inflicted upon the Japanese.

HISTORICAL DATAS AND ACTIVITIES

This Company was the remnant of the 6th Battlion, Guerilla Forces stationed in South Central Luxon. It came to be inducted to the Narking's Oserillas on the 18th, 1942, under the 1st Estatalion of the Gerrilla Forces under Gol. Terfilo Z. Salvašor, commanding Bizal Unit. Since that time this said battalion had helped much in bringing food and submaiting intelligence report to the G H Q.

On July 1st, 1943, the town of Tagig was zonified. Some were killed in the encounter and many were taken prisoners in the Fort Santiago.

According to intelligence report four were beheaded and the rest were taken as military prisoners serving various military confinements.

Then the rest of these men joined the Saints Combat stationed in South Central Luzon. On the 1st of February, 1945, this company was ordered to go down the hills and to take its former territory of Bagumbayan, Tagig, Rizal. They have the mission then to strike whenever they have the chance to. On February 14th, 1945 we came in contact yeary new was conside to. On sorthary leth, less we came in Contact to the first American Forces in Fort McKinley. Then we began the cutting of ammunition dame. It was thru the effort of this company that led to the saving of meny Acricon lives. Right at that time were flighting a do or die battle. This company led the Americans to the fight in the Signal Hills, Fort Mckinley. The Americans were shown where the mines were planted, various ammunition dams left, and the various hideouts of the Japs. Under the teamate with lat Lt. Francen, lat Lt., 11th Airborne with this company, thousands of lives in the nearby towns were save from the mass murder planned and rendered by the Japs.

Since that time this company has encountered so many actions, repulsing Japs trying to land on the subordination towns coming from the Leguna Lake.

With the effort of this company the Japs struggles in the Fort Mckinley and the various neighboring towns were cut.
