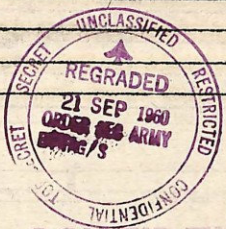

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 26 January 1948, requesting information regarding the status of the request for recognition of the Sarrat Independent Unit, Fil-American Irregular Troops.

The request for recognition of this unit was not favorably considered by this headquarters on 7 February 1947. After extensive investigation and full consideration of all substantiating evidence submitted by this unit and a careful analysis of all other available information of the military activities of the unit from its inception, scrutinized in relation to the overall resistance movement, it was determined that the unit failed to fulfill the requirements of our constant guerrilla recognition criterion used in the consideration of all claimant guerrilla units. A letter to this effect was sent to Mr. Ludovico Rivera, Sarrat, Ilocos Norte.

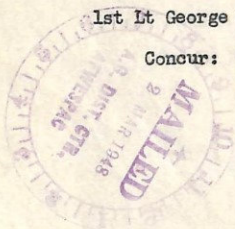

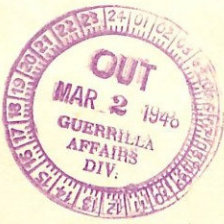

Dear Mr. Rivera:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the "Sarrat Independent Unit", purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. A definite organization was not established.
- e. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
- f. Performance of the units did not indicate adequate control by its leaders, because of desertion of personnel.
- g. Sphere of operations and unit strength claimed by the unit were not commensurate with the nature of the terrain, limitation of communication facilities, and the degree of anti-resistance activities of the Japanese in the area during the period concerned.

h. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.

i. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

j. Many members lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, copy attached.

1. 1st Lt Charles L Homewood, 2nd Lt Howard C De Silva and 2nd Lt William D MacMillan proceeded to Laoag, Ilocos Norte, 30 December 1946, to investigate the Sarrat Independent Unit.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached unit file).

3. FINDINGS:

a. The following persons were interviewed and their statements are reflected in the findings:

The Hon. Pedro G Albano, Congressman, 1st Dist, IN
 The Hon. Damaso Samonte, Congressman, 2nd Dist, IN
 Ludovico Rivera, Colonel, Commanding Officer
 Manuela R Ablan, wife of ex-Gov. Roque B Ablan
 Vicente Erieta, Fiscal of IN
 Julio Segundo y Comache, attorney, Laoag
 Amparo Jamias, resident of Sarrat
 Pedro Valentin, Military Mayor, Piddig, IN
 Col Manuel T Dikit, Member, Phil. Veterans Board

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. This alleged unit, under the command of Ludovico Rivera, shows no evidence of having existed at all during the Japanese occupation. There were no original papers of any kind to substantiate their claims to organization. Engagements with the Japanese, which they admit were in conjunction with the 15th Inf, USAFIP, NL, under Col Arnold, could not be shown to have been the undertaking of any unit except the 15th Inf. Col Manuel T Dikit was interviewed by the contact team but his remarks failed to give weight to the claims of the subject unit. His general knowledge of Northern Luzon Guerrillas was by his own admission extremely slight, and his knowledge of this unit was only through his Adjutant General. He could substantiate no claims made in regard to independent activity or activity in conjunction with the 15th Inf USAFIP, NL.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. There is no evidence that it operated in the field at all, and at the time of its alleged existence, the 15th Inf. dominated the area to the exclusion of any separate guerrilla units.

d. A definite organization was not established by the unit. There was no evidence of its organization during the period claimed, and no person interviewed knew of its existence.

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders. The investigation team could not find that the leaders knew of the location of the men for any length of time.

f. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. No original rosters, attachment papers, communications with other guerrilla units or other evidence, written or verbal, could be found to substantiate any claims.

g. Area of operations claimed coincided with that of other recognized units, and could not be attributed to the subject unit.

h. Col Russell W. Volckmann stated this unit rendered valuable service as a Bolo Unit but should not receive recognition as guerrillas.

1. No useful purpose will be served by further investigation of this unit.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: The unit does not appear to have any political aims or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the Sarrat Independent Unit be not favorably considered for recognition as there are no worthy members and no evidence of casualties.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 3 December 1946, subject: "Recognition of Guerrilla Status," in which you request recognition of the Fil-American Irregular Troops, (Sarrat Independent Unit).

Special press release from Public Relations Office, AFWESPAC, dated 1 February 1946, stated that no applications for recognition of guerrilla units would be accepted by this headquarters after 15 March 1946. This press release received wide circulation in the newspapers and was broadcast over local radio stations.

Your request for recognition of the Fil-American Irregular Troops, (Sarrat Independent Unit) was received at this headquarters 26 December 1946 in a letter dated 3 December 1945 and does not meet the deadline referred to above.

It is considered generally that all concerned have had ample opportunity to prepare applications for recognition. In the opinion of this headquarters, your request for an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not adequately justified and is not, therefore, favorably considered.

As per informed by Reprocessing Team I-1 ND- in our province (Ilocos Norte) that an individual recognition must be made for such an unrecognized unit, I hereby apply for my recognition of my former Unit.

I, formerly from the FIL-AMERICAN IRREGULAR TROOPS, (Sarrat Independent Unit), inducted as 2nd Lieutenant by Col. LUDOVICO R. RIVERA, looking for the due recognition of this unit.

I was inducted into this organization on the 23rd day of October 1944, by my Commanding Officer, Col. LUDOVICO R. RIVERA. And from that date, I was assigned to "B" Co, 1st Bn., of this unit. As called for Guerrilla movement we cut several communication lines, demolished bridges and other military installations of the enemy. Joint operations against the enemy in San Mateo, Laoag, Ilocos Norte, and encountered several Jap resistance of this province. On the 13th of February 1945, the Japs retreated to southern provinces and on 14th of February 1945, Laoag was purely liberated by the combined forces FIL-AMERICAN and the 15th Infantry USAFIP NL. As Laoag, the main stronghold of the enemy was totally wiped out by Guerrilla activities the province was solely liberated. And then after its liberation, said unit FIL-AMERICAN IRREGULAR TROOPS, returned to its former Headquarters, (Sarrat, I.N.) and orderd demobilized right away by the Commanding Officer, on March 3, 1945.

I hope therefore that this guerrilla organization be recognized individually as active movements or full operations has been made as stated above.

I have the honor to request for the recognition of the (Sarrat Independent Unit) FIL-AMERICAN IRREGULAR TROOPS.

The activities of this unit have been actually maintained in the field, and our activities have contributed materially to the eventful defeat of the enemy but particularly and specifically to the complete liberation of our province, Ilocos Norte, from the Japanese and the complete Japanese expulsion from the region without need of any American forces.

This unit has a definite organization and adequate records of our members have been kept: Names, ranks, dates of enlistment and joining, etc.

Our men were under the complete control of the commander and the sphere of operations and strength were commensurate with the nature of the terrain and the degree of anti-resistance activities of the Japs in the area during the period concerned.

Our organization has maintained a continuity of activities since the date of its formation without material change in its geographical location to the date it considered its mission performed - which is the liberation of the Ilocos and was never dissolved at any time during the Japanese occupation in spite of the pressure of the Japanese Military Authorities.

This unit devoted its entire efforts to Military Activities in the Field to the exclusion of normal civilian pursuits and family obligations.

The history and accomplishments of this unit, Roster and other pertinent papers are herewith enclosed.

In view of all the foregoing, it is respectfully requested that this Unit of the FIL-AMERICAN IRREGULAR TROOPS be given official recognition.

HISTORY AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS
OF
THE FIL-AMERICAN IRREGULAR TROOPS
(Sarrat Independent Unit)
ILOCOS NORTE

(ILOCOS NORTE WAS LIBERATED SOLELY BY THE GUERRILLAS UN-LIKE MANILA AND OTHER PLACES WHICH WERE LIBERATED BY THE AMERICAN FORCES. THE CHIEF BURDEN AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROTECTING AND FREEING THE PROVINCE FROM JAPANESE CLUTCHES, THEREFORE, DEVOLVED UPON THE GUERRILLAS. CONSEQUENTLY, THE ROLE OF THE GUERRILLAS IN THIS PROVINCE IS UNIQUE. THE GUERRILLA UNITS THERE ARE IN SOME RESPECTS DIFFERENT FROM OUTFITS OF THE SAME NATURE IN OTHER PLACES, MAINLY IN THE FACT THAT THEY WERE NOT ATTACHED TO AMERICAN FORCES BUT INSTEAD TO ONE ANOTHER FOR PURPOSES OF EFFECTIVE SERVICE.)

On December 12, 1941, when the Japs arrived in Ilocos Norte, Governor Roque B. Ablan took to the mountains and established his refugee provincial government in Barrio Biding, Dingras, and later somewhere in a distant outskirts of Solsona. During the early part of March 1942, Governor Ablan sent for the Commanding Officer of this unit, Col. Ludovico R. Rivera, for a conference. After this conference Col. Rivera brought to Governor Ablan's HQ Majors Petel, Castro, de la Cuesta, R., Payoyo, Sambrano, Andres, and Capts. Zabala and Taganas, Lts. Rios, Racela and others for another conference. In this conference Col. Rivera was designated as the leader of the resistance movement in Central Ilocos Norte with headquarters in Sarrat and the above-named officers and others at once organized themselves as a unit sworn to keep the people of the province loyal to the government thru intelligence work, underground propaganda and resistance wherever possible by means of the activities of ambush squads against the Japanese. This activity enabled Gov. Ablan to keep up his resistance and the public of Northern Luzon to sustain their faith in the United States and in the Commonwealth of the Philippines, despite the occupation of the province by the Japanese. This resistance group carried out in the lowlands and established communities the orders of the refugee government, under the very noses of the Japanese forces of occupation, spying and reporting on Japanese installations and movements and serving in Ablan's

roving guerrilla band, thus making it possible for Ablan's armed force to effectively raid and harrass Japanese positions for a long time.

As a result of their activities, many of the officers of this unit, notably Col. Rivera, Majors de la Cuesta, C., de la Cuesta, R., Capt. Balicanta, and Lt. Malvar, M., not to mention our men in the ranks, were arrested, jailed for months and tortured by the Japs, Col. Rivera, for being the leader of the resistance and underground activities in Sarrat; Major C. de la Cuesta for being the liaison officer between Ablan's Hqs. and the people in the Sarrat area; Major R. de la Cuesta for being the Physician of the officers under Gov. Ablan; Capt. Balicanta and Sgt. Balicanta for the direction of espionage and runner communication service from town to town; and Lt. Malvar for being a loyal partisan of Gov. Ablan. Major Petel was taken by the Japs for questioning because of the propaganda work then being carried on under his direction. As Gov. Ablan had to move from place to place and further and further from the province, our unit cooperated with Major Feliciano Madamba then the most daring USAFFE guerrilla officer operating in Ilocos Norte.

When it was getting extremely difficult to regularly contact Governor Ablan, who was the original inspiration and head of the movement, he commissioned Col. Rivera and the officers already associated with him to undertake on their account the continuation of the resistance movement in their area as an independent unit. This was in the early part of 1943 when the situation had become precarious. We faced dispersal and annihilation with the Jap MP and punitive expeditions hot on our tracks and with many of our leaders already taken by them. The Japs had then consolidated their positions in Ilocos Norte, with garrisons in every town. Left to ourselves we needed guidance and advice as to how to operate as other units did in other areas such as those in Central and Southern Luzon under the most adverse conditions. It was

then that fortunately Lt. Col. Salvador C. Peña, our executive officer, was able to make contacts with Col. Manuel T. Dikit, of the Fil-American Irregular Troops, at the Red Cross and Jai Alai in Manila through Mr. M. Farolan, then secretary of both organizations, and the latter encouraged and urged the former to go back to Ilocos Norte and reorganize the Central Ilocos Norte (Sarrat) guerrillas as a unit of the Fil-American Irregular Troops (FAIT). He afforded the advice badly needed as to manner of organization and methods of operation in the difficult situations created by barbaric Japanese vigilance. He further promised some arms and grenades. Soon after these contacts, Lt. Col. Peña and Major Juan B. Castillo, Commanding Officer of the 1st Bn. of this Unit left for Ilocos and upon their arrival there informed Col. Rivera, Majors de la Cuesta, R., Petel, Payoyo, Castro, Andres, Sambrano, de la Cuesta, C., Capts. Peña, D., Zabala, Taganas, Balicanta and others of their contacts with the late Col. Straughn's field commander and organizer in Manila. After several conferences it was decided to begin the reorganization of the unit under the Fil-American Irregular Troops. (By mistake, however, this unit has styled itself as Fil-American Irregular Forces (Sarrat Independent Unit) instead of Fil-American Irregular Troops, although in fact it is the latter group always referred to.)

Thus came into being the Fil-American Irregular Troops (Sarrat Unit), and thereafter, although operating independently from the Central FAIT organization, we kept close liaison with Col. Dikit and after his capture by the Japanese, we kept contact with Lt. Col. Marcelo Cabautan, his adjutant general, in the city of Manila, for information and advise. Upon its organization, cooperation with the leaders of the resistance and underground movements in the province was enhanced and greatly bolstered up.

The avowed mission of our unit was to help clear our province and the Ilocos region, of Japanese forces and to completely liberate them.

Our strategy was to raid and harrass the Japanese garrisons in the towns within our area and drive them away to free such towns one by one. This achieved, we established a strong line of defense running north and south through the town of Sarrat and anchored in Batac in the south and Vintar in the north to bottle up the Japanese in Laoag and to enable larger and better armed guerrilla forces to come in and establish themselves with us east of our line, for the final push to Laoag, with a view to the final liberation of the capital and consequently of the entire province. In the execution of this strategy, our unit bore the brunt of defense and offense against the Japanese then concentrated in the capital, only seven kilometers away and we sustained almost endless encounters with the enemy forces trying to break through eastward and later defending themselves in the final offensive against them.

Relief to us from stronger guerrilla forces outside of the province could not come from the south because the national road from San Fernando, Ia Union, headquarters of the Northwest Luzon Japanese Army, was until February ¹⁹⁴⁵ still the main Japanese communication line and kept open at any cost. Such guerrilla forces as were needed to tip the balance of power in our favor and achieve decisive supremacy over the Japanese could only come through the east from Abra and the Mt. Province and until they could reach us, we had to carry the burden of battle against the Japs. Thru sheer courage we held our line firmly until relief came.

To the credit of our unit, more than to any other guerrilla unit with which we performed the mission of liberating our province from the Japanese, the enemy never once succeeded in their break-through efforts once our defense line was established, and the guerrilla forces were able to maintain complete peace and order in all the areas occupied by them even when the Japanese were still in Laoag, and throughout the province, after the defeat and expulsion of the Japanese

forces from Laog on February 13, 1945, until the re-establishment of the Commonwealth government in the province in September.

While at the beginning our force was largely armed with bolos, we had a supply of hand grenades that our boys stole little by little from the Japanese garrisons, mostly at the air-port in Laog and in Laog proper, where we had them assigned to work as a means of obtaining such arms and ammunition and intelligence information as were of value to us. On two occasions we successfully smuggled two shipments of grenades from Manila, mixed in sackfuls of unshaked bottle-nuts. These were supplied first by Col. Dikit and later by Lt. Col. Cabautan. With these we were able to make up for the lack of firearms in the effective realization of our missions against the enemy.

As the turning point in the drive against the Japanese came, however, we were armed by Major Simeon Valdes, commanding the First Battalion, 15th Infantry, USAFIP (now recognized), taking our companies in turns in the operations when the arms were insufficient to go around and then when enough arms were available, supplying all our requirements for all operations until the final liberation of the province when we deemed our mission successfully completed.

It was when we received the news about the carrier plane raids on Manila in September and of the landing in Leyte in October, ¹⁹⁴⁴ that we knew the long-awaited zero hour was on hand. In the latter month, our unit was already in force in the field. We had then cleaned all the eastern and central towns of their Japanese garrisons and had successfully prevented, through sabotage of communication systems - destruction of roads and bridges and ambush of punitive expeditions and patrol units of Japanese forces - repeated attempts of the enemy to re-occupy the towns cleared and freed of Japanese garrisons. We established our line of defense cutting across the province east of the capital while the other units did the same in the north, thus virtually bottling up the Jap-

anese in Laoag, which to them was strategically important because of the large air-port in the vicinity which was a large aviation training center under Formosa command and was most essential to their air operations from Formosa and the Japanese mainland beyond.

Throughout November and December, we raided and battled the Japanese in Laoag from our defense line and they raided and attacked our positions, with the aid of aerial bombing. During this period, the battles raged in our sector, the only really large field encounters in the province outside of two or three that took place south of Laoag, after the Japanese had been dislodged from that point because of determined assaults from our sector and were retreating through to Ilocos Sur.

The chronology of the events and activities of this unit after we had taken to the field in full force, follows:

- October 24, 1944 - This unit raised the American Flag, signifying our complete control of Central and East Ilocos Norte.
- October 26, 1944 - Ambuscade of Jap punitive expeditions to Sarrat and other eastern towns, on Laoag-Dingras Road (Sarrat Section).
- Oct. 27 - 30, 1944 - Bridges and communication lines on the south border of our sector were demolished, barricaded and strategic positions occupied, ready to prevent further movement eastward of Japanese troops.
- Nov. 1 - 14, 1944 - Sharp skirmishes with and ambuscades of Jap patrols.

During the period comprised from October 24, 1944 to November 14, this unit also intensified propaganda work, as the public was still very meagerly informed about the landing and operations in Leyte and the people were being terrorized by Jap atrocities and propaganda.

- Nov. 15, 1944 - Bacsil Encounter: Japs and officers and

men of the Japanese-controlled B. C. raided Bacsil within the sector of this unit. A company of this unit under Capt. Bandagoza confronted and engaged them. We lost Baldomero Lorenzo and Otilio Bunoan as casualties on our side. Capt. Bandagoza with other men of our outfit were bayoneted and boloed and left at San Mateo. They were subsequently rescued and taken to our aid station. The Japs burned one of our outposts and one of our guards was killed. Aside from this, several houses were burned by the Japs in the Barrio of Parang within our sector.

December 3, 1944 - Pvt. Catalino Rasay was captured at his post and taken by the Japs but he succeeded in escaping from them on December 4, 1944; Pvts. Felix Dorilag, Toribio Agoto and Teofilo Borromeo were killed in action when the Japs were ambushed by us.

December 22, 1944 - 2nd Bacsil encounter with the Japs: Our outfit headed by Capts. Justito Peña, Quevedo, de la Cuesta, G., Lt. Dancel, fought the Japs and recaptured from them 12 bulcarts loaded with palay. Pvt. Alipio Ganitano was killed in action.

December 25, 1944 - One Japanese officer with the rank of Major whose plane was forced down while raiding and reconnoitering our sector, was captured by Col. Rivera and Lt. Col. Peña with the aid of two companies garrisoned in the poblacion. The Japanese plane was also captured.

December 30 and 31, 1944 - Our HQ was raided by the Japs and we gave them battle. Two Japanese soldiers were killed.

January 18, 1945 - Only Jap communication lines to our sector were destroyed by our unit and bridges blown up. Tank traps and other military obstacles were

constructed at strategic points.

January 19, 1945 - San Mateo Battle: Our unit in collaboration with another outfit (mainly the First Battalion, 15th Infantry, USAFIP, N. L. - now recognized - under the direct command of Major Simeon Valdes and under the over-all command of Cols. Volckman and Arnold, Commanding Officer of the USAFIP, N. L. and Commanding Officer of the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, N.L., respectively) engaged the Japs in a pitched battle from dawn to dusk. Casualty on the enemy's side was great. Over three hundred Japs were killed.

January 30, 1945 - Two companies on mission headed by Major Castillo, Capt. Gregorio Castillo and de la Cuesta, R., encountered a Japanese force at Lagui within our sector and killed 5 Japanese soldiers.

February 11, 1945 - The Major Battle of San Mateo: This unit with another guerrilla outfit under Col. Arnold but mainly with the First Battalion, 15th Infantry, USAFIP, N. L. under the command of Major Valdes, engaged the Japs in a 48-hour battle. Casualty on our side was negligible but very heavy on the enemy's side.

February 13, 1945 - The Japs greatly demoralized and hopeless after the battle of San Mateo retreated from Laoag, their last foothold. This unit in collaboration with the Battalion of Major Simeon Valdes, 15th Infantry, USAFIP, N. L. occupied Laoag and thus was liberated the province of Ilocos Norte. The Japs took a southern retreat and joined the other Jap units in Ilocos Sur.

In all these encounters this unit always operated in cooperation with such guerrilla units principally the battalion of Major Valdes, all the supplies of food, clothing and other prime necessities, transportation and service being provided.





1. In the municipality of Sarrat, Ilocos Norte, there is a move to have a fake guerrilla outfit known as the Fil-American Irregular Force, Sarrat Unit, be recognized by that Headquarters. As a member of a genuine guerrilla unit and as one of the many who have unselfishly sacrificed for the liberation of my native land and for the democratic way of life, I highly protest to the recognition of said Fil-American Force, Sarrat Unit for the following reasons:

(a) That said Fil-American Irregular Forces, Sarrat Unit was non-existent during the period they claim to be in operation. This guerrilla unit as I come to understand is a new organization just formed after the liberation and with the Bolo Regiment established by the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, NL in the Municipality of Sarrat during those days that they claim to be in operation, as the nucleus. This Bolo Regiment was organized by the then Capt. John P. O'Day together with the Women's Auxilliary Service, for Civilian Guarding System and Labor Battalion and was employed in the capacity of a Civilian Employee Unit by the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, NL the genuine guerrilla outfit during the time the Fil-American Irregular Forces, Sarrat Unit, claims its operation. Whatever meritorious services they have performed was accounted for by the administration and control of the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, NL.

(b) The Officers of said guerrilla are not military men and are not capable of leading men in combat. The CO, Atty. Ludovico Rivera was the Military Mayor of Sarrat during the period that they claim to have operated and together with the EO, Mr. Salvador Peña, his then Municipal Secretary, they were 15th Infantry appointee and could have not served in such capacity as they make themselves to be. Other Officers, like Mr. Nemesio Petal, the S-5, Mr. Ceferino de la Cuesta, CO, Hq Bn. and Atty Juan Castillo and all the ranking Officers were all in hiding during those period and could have not led the units they claim to represent. The CO of the Hospital Co is a dentist and its EO a civilian and non-medical men and therefore could not have performed their duties as officers of said unit.

(c) There is continued discontent among the Enlisted personnel due to the fact that the above mentioned Officers used their organization for said purpose and they themselves occupying the post at the detriment of the Enlisted personnel. Since they began organizing they have been collecting funds from among the members for administrative purposes.

2. For the above reasons I protest to the recognition of the Fil-American Irregular Force, Sarrat Unit and that I ask that this case should be referred to the USAFIP NL ARMA COMMAND for verification. I further request for an investigation of the genuiness of said Fil-American Irregular Force, Sarrat Unit.

3. Your favorable consideration to this case will mean your upliftment for the cause of which most of us has fought and your deep appreciation for those who have nobly sacrificed their lives for a free Philippines and a noble America.

4. Similar cases is also true with other guerrilla units claiming recognition and that Headquarters should exert effort to investigate their case before they be given recognition.

1. In the municipality of Sarrat, Ilocos Norte, there is a move to have a fake guerrilla outfit known as the Fil-American Irregular Force, Sarrat Unit, be recognized by that Headquarters. As a member of a genuine guerrilla unit and as one of the many who have unselfishly sacrificed for the liberation of my native land and for the democratic way of life, I highly protest to the recognition of said Fil-American Force, Sarrat Unit for the following reasons:

(a) That said Fil-American Irregular Forces, Sarrat Unit was non-existent during the period they claim to be in operation. This guerrilla unit as I come to understand is a new organization just formed after the liberation and with the Bolo Regiment established by the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, NL in the Municipality of Sarrat during those days that they claim to be in operation, as the nucleus. This Bolo Regiment was organized by the then Capt. John P. O'Day together with the Women's Auxiliary Service, for Civilian Guarding System and Labor Battalion and was employed in the capacity of a Civilian Employee Unit by the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, NL the genuine guerrilla outfit during the time the Fil-American Irregular Forces, Sarrat Unit, claims its operation. Whatever meritorious services they have performed was accounted for by the administration and control of the 15th Infantry, USAFIP, NL.

(b) The Officers of said guerrilla are not military men and are not capable of leading men in combat. The CO, Atty. Ludovico Rivera was the Military Mayor of Sarrat during the period that they claim to have operated and together with the EO, Mr. Salvador Pena, his then Municipal Secretary, they were 15th Infantry appointee and could have not served in such capacity as they make themselves to be. Other officers, like Mr. Nemesio Petel, the S-5, Mr. Ceferino dela Cuasta, CO, Hq Bn, and Atty. Juan Castillo and all the ranking Officers were all in hiding during those period and could have not led the units they claim to represent. The CO of the Hospital Co is a dentist and its EO a civilian and non-medical men and therefore could not have performed their duties as officers of said unit.

(c) There is continued discontent among the Enlisted personnel due to the fact that the above mentioned Officers used their organization for said purpose and they themselves occupying the post at the detriment of the Enlisted personnel. Since they began organizing they have been collecting funds from among the members for administrative purposes.
