

I, Sancho s. Franco, lst. Lt. of this cut fit and Company Commander of nagunoy unit. I and my mens are all bonafide guerrillas or the ril-American that were first organized in october 1942 as per ascord of the ouganization.

I received my commission paper that was dury signed by col. Hugh straughn and James Atwell dated reb. 1. 1943.

i have (72) mens under my command and (30) or them were active and dessaving gueraillas.

puring liberation we were attached to different units of the U. S. Army. we had rendered our services to them by different days. we served as guide of the reconstance troops, carrying parties, patrol and ratine guard duties in mapping up

we also helped J/sgt. 2. B. zalter of the Hq. Btry. 0. 373 rd. A.A.A. in thier works. we installed telephone wire from Michals Field to our place where the searched light unit was stationed. I assigned some of my meas in guarging this rear installation.

We caught one Japanese Officer alive by the name or osawa. We surremaseed him first to Lt. raul L. Cook and then we were accompanied by it. cook to the c.P. or major Elmer c. Haward. Here we left the said Japanese officer for costudy.

6. Capt. Bullard and Sgt. E. Gilpin of the 672 Amphibious Tank Division, B. Co.

We began our tour of daties last represent 1945 to
June 1945 respectively. We were not able to get certification
from them because we don't know that it will be needed in the
future for our recognition. Beside this we don't know that we
will rewarded for our services if we have certification.

We were also a part of the fil-American(straugh's) Troops out rit that was attached with the ofth. Division U.S.A. under Lt. Anthony Cancelosi, Guerrilla and Civil Affairs Orricers of the Soth. Division at Markina, Rizal.

We were used by the different units of the both. piv. as carrying parties to the front line.

As carrying Parties we risked our life in climbing up the mountains with packed board of food stuff, water, coffee and other kind of sea ration on our back. We passed along the dangerous trail were enimies were hiding and we have no fire arms except for our guides, one on the front and one at the rear.

in this line duty we never retreat because we know that soldiers in the front line will die of hunger and thirsty if they have nothing to eat and to drink. We considered our self as soldiers also in the front line because we did the duties of soldiers.

As carrying parties we were in grave situation rather than those soldiers who fights the enimies in the front line, because they have chance to kill and to be killed for they have fire arms.

Although we know that we were liable to be killed, we were not discourage and instead we double our errorts to continue until to the end.

This was not a mere story of my self, but this was real facts, bounded with truth for I can not manufactured these evidences from my mind if it does not realy happened.

If due to the absence of certification, these will be disregarded and will not be acted upon, I will not have any bad impression against anymody, but I thanked GOD, for we had survive our life from the past era, and we had done our duty as a true Filipino, in thought, in words and in deeds.

I am sending this plea not so much for my/account, but for my mens who stand to be deprived of due recognition and compensation.


