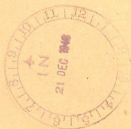

Records of the unit do not show evidence of those prerequisites necessary to recognition of a guerrilla unit by the U. S. Army. There is not sufficient evidence to prove the existence of a continuous command, continuous effective resistance or cohesive organization.

The Straghn Regiment (formerly the Claudio Regiment, W. P.) is composed of three Bns. that have previously been refused recognition under the overall command of the Tanggulan Ng Bayan Hqs. which is officially known as the TMO or Tanggulan Military Organization. The same fundamental facts remain as in the previous investigation. It is a regiment composed of screened men from other commands.

The 1st Bn. is the former Jones Guerrilla Bn of Isabela Province. The 37th Div. attached and recognized guerrillas in that area. The men may have served sporadically as guards and guides but those men on this roster were not officially attached as were others in the area.

The other two battalions consist of the men who have been twice refused under different circumstances. First, they called themselves the Army of the Agos and were refused. Second, they were refused under the overall command of TMO. These men were active in 1942 under a leader that was killed. Then a large number surrendered with the understanding that no further guerrilla activity would be taken and there was none. The few real, active guerrillas that were left joined either the Ramsey group or USFIP, HL.

It is recommended that a standard letter of non-recognition be sent to Severino Fabie, nominal S.O. of the so-called Straghn Regt. with the following par. inserted as par. 2:

Records of the unit do not show evidence of those prerequisites necessary to recognition of a guerrilla unit by the U. S. Army. There is not sufficient evidence to prove the existence of a continuous command, continuous effective resistance or cohesive organization.

I MARCELINO J. JACON, actual Municipal Mayor of 1940, was married and a resident of Jacone Iloilo after having been sworn according to law deposed and said:

That as a Municipal Mayor of Jacone Iloilo I knew of the existence of the Jacone Guerrilla unit at the 128th Infantry 7th American Airborne Troop (formerly part of 61st Airborne T.F.P.) under Col. Hugh Strathairn.

That I know officially the instruction given to me by the 2nd Bn of the 128th Infantry USA when they left this place that all Japanese Prisoners of War or Japanese soldiers surrendering to the Jacone Guerrilla Bn would be turned over to the office of the Mayor who in turn would turn them over to the nearest American Unit.

That to fulfill this instruction the following Japanese were surrendered to the Jacone Guerrilla Bn were turned over to the 2nd Co. 128th Infantry USA 57th Division:

September 24 1945 -	80 " "
September 25 1945 -	60 " "
September 28 1945 -	70 " "

That it may be stated here that the American liberators arrived here in this Municipality late last July 8 July 14th August 6 August 16th (2nd Bn 128th Inf) and "B" Co. of the 128th Inf USA 57th Division August 18 to September 21 1945.

That the records of these Japanese soldiers turned over to the American soldiers were not a necessity then because I knew that the Americans were or are our liberators. For the numbers of Japanese POW turned over would be found in the Municipality Police Station of this Municipality.

That I have taken statements at my own residence and true when investigated by the Philippine Constabulary at Jacone Iloilo on 23rd of January 1960 at this Municipality of Jacone Iloilo.

TO : Commanding General, AFPWPAC
(Thru Channels)

1. Seeing the inadequacy of remaining under the old status, the undersigned requests that Command, Your Honor, to consider this request for the recognition of the STRAUSSER REGIMENT, (formerly Claudio Regiment), belonging to the Eastern Pangasinan, consolidated in the adjoining roster, for obvious reasons to wit:

a. That this unit has existed to oppose the Japanese impositions at our sectors in these Islands;

b. That individual happiness of the members were given up to be able to dedicate their entire time educating the civilians resist peacefully and to strike properly and only when necessary without endangering public safety. Many of our men were often in danger, hunted, tortured, some lost their lives, sacrificed for the continuation of democracy in this part of the globe;

c. That in some ways or other, by the sacrifice and help of our men did, facilitated the subjugation of the enemies in four sectors;

d. That our men served the arrival of the Americans in various capacities to wipe out the enemy and many others which partly are noted down in form of historical data. (Have we known the value of records and recommendations, a big volume of book could be filled up.)

2. We reiterate to that High Command that a due consideration be favored to this unit, a unit that can serve our unflinching democracy in the Orient, because in it are found representatives of intellectual leaders of the land, educators, engineers, artists, newspapermen, businessmen, physicians, etc.- America will not regret.

3. A complete roster of this strength of men under different T.O. was handed to Lt. Middleton of the Guerrilla Affairs, AFPAC. With it are original records, some appointments, and other accessories of the unit, on Nov. 5, 1945, the screened roster of the STRAUSSER REGIMENT was again sent to that office.

ADOPTED AND APPROVED IN ITS REGULAR SESSION (IN LIEU OF SEPTEMBER 27,
1945) HELD IN THE FACULTY HALL OF THE NORTH STAR INSTITUTE, MUNICIPALITY
OF SANTIAGO, PROVINCE OF ISABELA, ON MONDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1945.

Acting Governor Gumpal said to the board that during the Japanese administration several guerrilla organizations acting under their own patriotic initiative, secretly operated in this province to fight the enemy; that such militant units were generally composed of dauntless civilian volunteers recruited by heroic USAFFE servicemen who courageously sought to carry on the noble fight against the atrocious and inhuman Japanese forces; that many of these men were either killed or disabled; and that these men, by virtue of the pronouncement made by President Osmena in his speech, dated November 27, 1944, should be entitled to their just compensation as groups of men who sacrificed their lives to help free their country from the yoke of Japanese tyranny and oppression.

"On motion of Member De la Cruz, therefore, it was

RESOLVED that the Provincial Board of Isabela, for and in behalf of its constituents, do hereby petition the High Command of the United States Armed Forces in the Philippines, through the good offices of His excellency Sergio Osmena, President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, to extend recognition to the following guerrilla units that operated in this province prior to its reconquest by the gallant American Liberators, namely the 7th INFANTRY REGIMENT, 34TH DIVISION, the ANAGADANAN GUERRILLA REGIMENT, and the JON GUERRILLA FORCE;

"Resolved, further, that the Board stands in full testimony to the effect that the presence of those units in this province constituted a strong and solid barrier against the execution of oppressive Japanese military policies in this part of the country; and

RESOLVED, further, that this resolution be forwarded to the Guerrilla Affairs Section, United States Army General Headquarters, Manila, for its consideration, and that copies thereof be also forwarded to His excellency Sergio Osmena, President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, Hon. Manuel Roxas, President of the Senate, Hon. Epifanio Quirino, Senator, Philippine Senate, Hon. Melanio Ferraz, Senator, Philippine Senate, Hon. Jose Zulueta, Speaker, House of Representatives, Hon. Lino J. Castallejo, Assemblyman representing this province in the Philippine Congress, and to all the respective Commanders of the aforementioned Guerrilla Organizations in this province, for their information.

1. I her-by report the development of my contact with the Strangth Regiment (formerly Claudio Regiment, Western Pangasinan, and the 1st Bn of this unit) (James Guerrilla Bn, Jones, Isabela (Cagayan Valley))

2. To begin with it would be nice to recall that certain day of January 1945, in Manila:

3. As per directive issued by the High Command, FAIR, under Col. Hugh Strangth, USA, dated January, 1945, in my capacity as Intelligence and Liaison Officer for the McKinley Regiment and Western Pangasinan and Cagayan Valley, I was to contact CDR. SERRINO FAIR in Manila; Lt. Col. ANTONIO H. NICHOL in Jones, Isabela, and Sgt Miller, AG, USA, in Western Pangasinan. MISSION: to arrange plans for the expansion of our forces and fields of operation.

4. In compliance to the above-mentioned directive, I informed Col. Fabie of my going to the province. Before I could leave for the province, Lt. Col. NICHOL, Antoline, showed up in Manila. (Lt. Col. ANTONIO H. NICHOL was at that time wanted dead or alive by the Japs for his escape from his imprisonment in Isabela, PHILIPPINES.) Lt. Col. NICHOL's mission was to secure arms for his unit.

5. A conference was held in the home of Col. FABIE and among other things the following were taken up: (a) due to the big risk of transporting to the province, the three Springfield rifles and Revolver in the possession of COL. FABIE, were retained in Manila; (b) a Quast and Geographic Map and magnetic compass I took from the Weather Bureau were furnished to Lt. Col. NICHOL; (c) the admission of underground members was to be restricted to trusted Relatives and Friends; (d) to inform Capt. PEDRO NICHOL of the 6th REGIMENT, Western Pangasinan, (under HANSEN) about the projected expansion of the FAIR in Western Pangasinan and Jones, Isabela (Cagayan Valley) (e) in my absence in Manila, Lt. ANTONIO FAIR, FA, USAFFE residing in 411 S. Eaura, Manila, in Manila, was my vice; (f) Lt. Col. ANTONIO H. NICHOL was to contact Lt. FERRIS GARCIA of 106th, CAGAYAN; (g) Powers not to carry arms nor suspicious articles, and travel of members to be made only when the situation demanded immediate action.

6. On February, 1945, COL. FABIE proceeded to recruit new members in Western Pangasinan in view of the increasing pressure and repression of the Japs in that sector. It will be noted that Amn. Pangasinan, "non-Registered" to the enemy on or about the 12th of February 1945 the last town in Western Pangasinan to yield since that contact became more and more infrequent.

7. On March, 1945, I came to Manila activated in the 1st PHILIPPINE COMBAT BN, USAFFE, and reported to Maj. LUNA of the 4th Bn. McKinley Regiment, attached to the 44th TAC Bn, USA, APO 74.

8. On June, 1945, COL. FABIE came to Manila to seek recognition of his Regiment.

... or about July 14, 1946, Mr. A. Perez came to Manila to report
that he was attached to the UNAFIP, Southern Luzon under VOEGHMAN, for the
duration of the liberation of northern Luzon.

10. Lt. COL. ARNOLD F. HIGSON arrived on or about the 15 September
1946 in Manila with his roster of the JUNGLE GUERRILLA BN and connections
of the different U.S. Army units to which they had been attached during the entire
campaign in Cagayan Valley by the U.S. Army. The Jungle Guerrilla Bn, had its
sector in Juvet, Tachala- Pangasinan Area.

Memo to : Guerrilla affairs section, AFWESPAC

1. The undersigned was first contacted by leaders of the TANGULAN-MILITARY ORGANIZATION in August, 1942, in the Province of Bulacan. At that time the leaders of the TMO claimed a large number of followers and desired to join the undersigned. The undersigned, then under Col. G. A. Thorpe, took the question under consideration and advised the leaders of the TMO to contact Col. Thorpe and /or Captain Joseph R. Barker, II. The undersigned also advised the leaders of the TMO of his plan of organization and operations against the Japanese and advised that they follow this plan until additional instructions could be obtained from Col. Thorpe or Captain Barker.
2. In December of 1942 leaders of the TMO again contacted the undersigned and presented information regarding members of their unit in the Province of Bulacan and Nueva Ecija and the leaders of these unit were authorized to continue under the guidance of the undersigned. The TMO leaders were also advised to contact other American leaders in various areas for purpose of coordination and guidance.
3. Due to the pressure of the Japs and possibilities of Submarine contact the undersigned left Bulacan and proceeded to the east coast of Luzon. Contact was temporarily lost with the TMO, however, they were able to contact the undersigned in vicinity of Infanta, Tayabas, in late 1945 at which time rosters and detailed information regarding the entire TMO was requested. According to information later obtained from the C.O. of the TMO and confirmed by Mr. Villason, the courier, the rosters and information were destroyed due to enemy pressure while enroute to the undersigned's headquarters.
4. While the undersigned is not in a position to determine the actual active strength of the TMO, it is recommended that they be given further consideration. It is my opinion that the TMO was definitely anti-Japanese and did do their best to assist them with the liberation of the Philippines.

FIL-AMERICAN IRREGULAR TROOPS
Under Col. Hugh Straughn

STRAUGHN REGIMENT
(formerly Claudio Regt., W.P.)

I, the undersigned, commanding officer of the Straughn, (formerly the Claudio Regt., Western Pangasinan, attached to Fil-American Irregular Troops under Col. Hugh Straughn, was an applicant to the Philippine Army just at the outbreak of the war on December 8, 1941. I was given the rank of Major of the camouflage in the Engineering Corps. On the second (2nd) day of January 1942, I was asked to present myself at the recruiting office at the Mahan Garden to receive my assignment, it was the day the Japanese entered Manila, and instead I proceeded northward with the vivid desire to join our forces in the Central Plains of Luzon. I had with me Salvador Espinosa, a newspaperman, Architect Vicente Nicanor and Mamerto Maraval, a law student, respectively assigned as captain and lieutenants in this outfit. Upon reaching Paombong, Bulacan, on the 2nd day artillery duel directing Dinalupihan were heard. It gave us the idea of the impossibility of our purpose, so we proceeded to Pangasinan. On the 26th of the same month, I alone returned to Manila via Zamboale where I saw a battlefield at Iba, Zamboale, devastated, Camp San Marcelino where the 11st. and 32nd Infantry stationed abandoned, wrecks of supplies and buildings every where along the way experienced, and our men who could not reach Batang scattered. I reached Manila on the seventh day of February 1942 to see Manila with no light of hope to live in. - No sensible person did not confine himself at home.

There were brewing troubles everywhere in the city caused by the lowly Japanese soldiers. On the 25th of April, 1942, I was sworn as a guerrillero with the rank of Colonel and accorded with the privilege to group, right to appoint and induct men into the service as per recommendation by senior officers of the Fil-American Irregular Troops under Col. Hugh Straughn, the organization I was sworn in.

I had with me few men cooperating in our activities in later dates. Major Mariano F. Nicanor was posted in the Weather Bureau helping us in whatever capacity he could as guerrillero. Captain Emmanuel Aguirre of the RAMSEY unit in the city, now connected in Zamboale used to have their men meet in the undersigned's home in Manila. Other units followed suit. We had also the opportunity to meet Diego Silang who was killed at the side of the Americans who entered the city, (RAMSEY), and Major Luna, McKinley Brigade, (another group of Col. Straughn of the Fil-American Irregular Troops). These men offered me honorary position in their units, not knowing that I had my men who were scattered in many places.

On July 20 1942, Capt. Antonio H. Nicanor Asst. G-2 of the 61st Div. (USAFS) unexpectedly came to me and talked about the resistance movement. In the course of our conversation, I offered him a commission with the rank of LT. COLONEL, 27 July 1942 and to organize a guerrilla outfit in Jones, Isabela where he evacuated his family. That this outfit should be a part and parcel of this Claudio Regiment, Western Pangasinan, now the STRAUGHN REGIMENT, FAIT., under COL. HUGH STRAUGHN.

On July 15, 1945, Salvador Nilo Espinosa, Adjutant to Major Pedro Edmundo Jr. combined themselves with this outfit, Straughn Regiment, (formerly Claudio Regiment, W.P.), but Maj. Nicanor could not wait the early recognition so he turned to someone who could soon activate them and work for their recognition.

Impelled by the desire to evade an offer to serve the propaganda under Ma-
 de and other impositions of the past administration, on March 2nd, 1944 the
 underground resolved to move to Agno, with the permission then of the unit I
 was connected. We arrived in Pangasinan on the 6th day of the month, already
 the second week the town people experienced water-cure and other forms of
 torture and atrocities to force Sgt Miller of the U.S. Air Corp who was that
 time hiding at a secluded place in Agno, handed to them, the Japanese. They suc-
 ceeded with three others who were killed with him in Alaminos and one José Castro
 who escaped the penalty of death. Lt. Alfredo Razon, Sgt. Abundio Nilo and Cpl.
 Filomelo Nagelto have given their lives up as guerrillas of this outfit. I
 visited our outfit in the West of Pangasinan twice before my family decided to
 live in the place 1942, 1943, September; and lastly 1944 up to June 1945 when
 I came to report part of our men in the ~~United States~~ of the Pil-American
 can Irregular Troops in the city.

My arrival in Agno gave me a closer look-up of the entire outfit of the
 2nd and 3rd battalions under ~~Commander~~ Colonel Francisco Naraval and
 Lt. Colonel Lorenzo Bonado, practicing lawyer and the 9 years reinstated Mayor,
 of Burgos, respectively. The 3rd Bn. under Lt. Col. Antonio Nicamor, a USAFFE offi-
 cer, because of distance and the difficulty of transportation, was given the full
 discretion to act accordingly regarding and pertaining his battalions. Lt. Col. Nicamor
 is a tommy of mine, but now residing in Jones, Isabela with his family.
 However, Lt. Col. Nicamor had made it a point to be seeing me once in a while,
 1942, 1943, and lastly in 15 September, 1945, when he came to submit his roster and
 other activities and or necessary papers from the U.S. Army which operated in his
 sector.

In Agno and other western towns we agreed on a common plan to protect our re-
 putable sectors from the aggressive elements coming from various places that tried
 to endanger the common safety and to avoid useless frictions which terminate in
 the annihilation of the already suffering hard-earned people. The mayors and respon-
 sible citizens of the towns were majority our men and officers. Many of them are
 practicing lawyers, physicians, educators, engineers and other mental professionals
 of the western towns and also USAFFE men, forming common plans for the protection and
 defense of each respective towns. It was a part of our activities to plan devices
 to camouflage our activities. In Agno, the Nationalist Club, presided by the under-
 signed as its first president, and a second president, Salvador Espinosa, who was
 to act in the absence of the first, expressed free thoughts and democratic liberal
 ideas, was forced to close when an order from the government to incorporate it to the
 the ~~tail~~ was received. Company Commanders and Executives visited barrios and
 towns disguised as peddlers to educate the men in their civic rights as free loving
 citizens, and to give instructions to our men what were necessary to do in any
 occasion confronting them.

On August 1944, was seen the first Japanese steamship sunk by a torpedo. It
 was successively followed as we posted men along the coast of China Sea from
 to Tamsong where the Isabela coastal line is visible up to Sta Cruz. Lt. Emilio
 Naraval of the Northern Pangasinan units came twice in Agno posted in Tupa for weeks
 and often times with me. Another of the intelligence wheel unit is in Dagupan in
 Lt. José Sano. He got plenty of his reports from my men. On September and October
 that year an assurance of the strength of the U.S. sea forces could no longer be
 hidden due to the continue sinking of battleships, oil tankers, and the account and
 Japanese casualties drifting along the shores, coming with the tide up the small
 rivers in Tupa and Baruan. Major Mariano Nicamor in his return to Agno had
 just, he occupied the southern portion of the coastal line and was posted in Locooc
 to help Lieutenant Guillermo Naraval and Melanie Lastimosa both USAFFE of the in-
 telligence. The latter too occupied as far as Bolinao to Ililic. According to an
 identified as Tony (cross-eyed guy), who was too much without identification nor
 introduction, the ~~United States~~ sea west of Agno compared with other places had the most

sea victim. The town was the most spotted place by spies of the American and Japanese side, after that water-cure on February 1945. Since then our men took great precautions, lie low, because the patikas and guns that the guerrilleros possessed were all spied and taken numbering more than two hundred. All were advised to watch till the last hour came for an assured attack.

THE BATTLE AT AGNO, PANGASINAN:

After a detachment of Japanese soldiers left Agno, with suspicion arrived a small group equipped with mortar, machinegun and automatic rifles, just few days before the landing at Lingayen by the Americans. They were stationed west of the Municipal Building at the heart of the town instead of the usual headquarter in the Public Schools Buildings at the outskirts of the town, northwest. When the shelling at Lingayen Gulf was audibly heard we knew they were the Americans. On the 10th of January, the town Mayor was secretly advised to order the evacuation of all the civilians of the town for it was the time planned to attack the Japanese. Seeing, of course, the advantages on our side, the 12th was set or scheduled for the attack. I and the Mayor had the understanding that we had to get the help from Alaminos and Bani. I had to sleep in the night of the 11th at Bangan Oda to meet the help, which was brought in a truck managed by two Americans who returned immediately to their headquarter, leaving our men poorly equipped who went on to ambush the enemy in the town. Besides poor equipment our men were betrayed by one TIGER from Alaminos. Perchance I had to send one horseman with a letter of introduction in my name as the bearer signed by the Mayor, to look or call for a help who came immediately, all Americans from Alaminos. It took two days fighting with two losses on the Japanese side and one brave American who made a very close fight. Three Philippine wounded.

The men who gave such service to the affray was Maj. Salvador Rosete, who avoided the spread of the Japanese in the first day when ammunition was near exhaustion, he ran to a near barrio, Pennanstran (Other side of San Agustin,) where plenty were deposited as as to continue the fight. He being in the firing line advised me to send for that help. He aroused the morale of our fighting men until help came. I advised Ignacio Cabantac and other barrio people to collect and prepare food for our fighting men. After that last incident the Japanese found in the vicinities of Agno, Bani, Alaminos, Burgos and other western towns were harmless. After that some began surrendering.

ACTIVITIES IN INFANTA, PANGASINAN:

In Barrio Bayuan, Infanta, Pangasinan, on February 6, 1945, the guerrilleros under Lt. Col. Benado, attacked the Japanese soldiers that separated from their main body killing three of them. In this same barrio other two were killed while finding or looking food to eat. These guerrillas used home made guns.

In barrio Barrachao, Infanta, the the same guerrillas poisoned the water from where they get their supply by employing kamney, karot, and other poisonous plants. Hundreds of Japanese were verified to have been killed.

Most recently, Jose Mejias, with some of his men went to barrio Bayuan, Infanta, where they fought and killed three Japanese and brought the heads of their victims to their headquarter. That was the 10th of August, 1945.

ACTIVITIES IN BURGOS, DABOG, AND MASINI, PANGASINAN:

August 15, 1945, Lt. Ramon Damasco and Capt. Enochaelo Bustamante were sent to hunt after Inspector Casilian and Sgt. Tician both PO under the Japanese command, for maltreating one of our men, Sgt. Leocadio Verano accused as one hiding Pilot Miller, Capt. E. de la Rosa, Simplicio Estrator, and Lt. Emma, all guerrilleros. (The first two were killed in Alaminos taken hiding in Agno where people suffered for them.)

February 20th, 1944, Mabini was ordered to be zonified. Surrender of firearms was the cause. All our men were warned to be always on the look-out, get ready on any eventuality. Policeman Bernardo Dizon was killed. The Municipal Mayor, the Chief of Police and other prominent citizens of the town were maltreated and watercured by the Japanese. Guerrillas had no chance to challenge for lack of arms and ammunition, but Capt. Jose Ca. Mamaril was caught accused of being a guerrilla leader. He was under the custody of ~~83~~ ⁸³ General Sison as a prisoner, sentenced to die. Upon reaching Lt. Col. Francisco Naraval of the news, he (Francisco) with a handful of men went to rescue the Captain. It was successful.

December 10, 1944, Captain Wenceslaw Bustamante and his men captured and killed a Japanese Navy Officer in Nasangrit Beach.- Capt. Bustamante, Lt. Campos, Lt. Damasco attacked about 100 Japs in Cabungawan on the 17th of that month and four were killed.-Lt. Leopoldo Damasco of Mabini caught a Japanese and turned him over to the Municipal Mayor.-One Jap soldier was killed by Malabago by Lt. Silverio Bonso, Capt. Braga and their men on Dec. 23, 1944.- On January 7, 1945, Lt Damasco attacked with his men four Japanese resting in the house of Braulio Nacional killing them all.

January 15, 1945, Landing of the Americans in our area. Our men of the west, Mabini, Burgos, Bani met and helped them in some ways or others as medical services, guides, intelligence work and others. Instances like Lt. Bonso and his men accompanied the first motorized unit and guided them to the hideings of the Japanese in Papalasan, Bobonot, and encounters took place, killings a result 11 Japanese; Capturing machineguns, rifles and other Japanese equipments and other properties. Ammunitions were turned over to the Americans.

Jan 16, 1945, Lt. Campos and his men killed one Japanese soldier and buried him in Burgos Cemetery. During the months of February, March and April the men served as guides ~~xxx~~ locating Japanese hiding places. They acted in the maintenance of peace and order.

June 16, 1945.- A radiozonic belonging to the U.S. Army as identified was turned over to the CIC Dept. of Dagupan, Pangasinan, by Lt. C. Bonso.

July 6, 1945. Perfecto Gines (Sgt.), found a pigeon No. 489 belonging to the Signal Corp and turned it over to the department concerned through the CIC at Dagupan, Pangasinan.

The Jones Battalion, a unit under Lt Col. Antonino N. Nicanor, captain of the USSAFFE, though his men are isolated from my other men has been organized under one leadership and understanding, left for a time to manage its own affairs in accordance to military guerrilla laws we have agreed in our meetings; occasionally due to the difficulty of transportations. He, like my other officers, is a man of wide range of knowledge and experience capable of solving what was at hand. His activities and those of his men deserve much to be considered.

Due to the lack of communication and transportation, the Jones Guerrilla Bn could hardly be contacted by the FAIT (GHQ under Col. HUGH STRAUGHN even at the time of Japan's surrender. About the later part of September 1945, the Municipal Council of the town of Jones, Isabela, with the Mayor of Jones, passed a resolution asking for the help from the FAIT Supreme Commander because the Japanese who are still roaming in Jones, Isabela, with the adapted son of Arsenio Ricarte, as the leader of the Jap brigands, are threatening the civilians in Jones, Isabela. The copy of this resolution is in the hands of the FAIT Supreme Commander, and one given to AFFAC c/o Lt. Charles P. Middleton. This one reason why the Jones Guerrilla Bn (1st Bn) STRAUGHN REGIMENT, FAIT, was not heard from for a long time although it had done a good job.

The undersigned commissioned ANTONINO N. NICANOR with the rank of Lt. Col. and ordered him to organize the 1st Bn. because of his leadership as a USAFFE Officer. This was in July 1942. This 1st Bn would be under the overall command of Col. Hugh Straughn with the undersigned as the Regimental to which Lt. Colonel Nicanor's outfit is attached. Due to the great distance of his territory and the great risks of communication, it entailed, I had very rare meeting or correspond with him. Lately, Lt. Col. Antonino N. Nicanor came to report to the undersigned showing me among other things the ROSTER of his troops and the activities of the JONES GUERRILLA, Jones Isabela (Straughn Regiment).

From the middle of 1942 to 1944, the activities of the unit were confined to gather information from the help of the civilians in the locality in the way of security from the atrocities and abuses of the Japs. At times then three or five Japs would roam about in this territory looking for food the guerrillas would get at them and kill them at the psychological moment, that is when the said guerrillas are very sure they can tackle and kill all the Japs in the group. They would not let even one of the Japs in the group to escape so that the killings were not known at all by other Japs otherwise it would mean the death of all inhabitants living in those places. Weapons taken from the dead Japs were used by the Jones Guerrilla Bn. Small Units of U. S. Army entered Jones, 14th July, 1945.

From January to February 13, 1945, Japs from Echague and other parts of the Valley of Cagayan retreated to Jones, Isabela. Some of them proceeded to Dapping-Pinappagan-Casiguran Area. They were trailed by member of the Jones Guerrilla Bn who noted every move, they made, positions to they took, trenches they dug and also their gun emplacements, for further reference of the Intelligence Units (Maps were furnished later to the American forces that sent to this areas.)

On the first week of March 1945, Captain Marcelo Domingo invited 2 Japs to get some native cherries in barrio Sinawangan, Jones. While the 2 Japs were happily feeding themselves cut their heads off into fan strokes and put their guns and bayonets which was used later for sniping. The months of April and May, 1945 were confined to intelligence work especially against Japs Spies (Ganaps or Macapilis), Japs disposition and movement of troops. Every now and then Japs continued pounding in this area from Villa Verde.

On June, 13, 1945, Capt. Rigoberto Antonio with nine men killed eleven Japs (5 Captains, & 4 Bn) in the barrio of Palagao, Jones. According to these 7 Japs, they were bound for Pinappagan and they compelled the civilians to give them ride. These 10 guerrilleros volunteered but with the plan of killing them. The Japs were entertained with young coconuts first and while they were not at war the intentions of the guerrilleros, they were assailed at the same time. Booties were 2 sabers, 3 pistols, 4 rifles and 4 bayonets which were run over to the CIO at Santiago, Isabela.

In Barrio Abolan, Jones 1st Sgt. Eliseo Arague with four men killed also three Japs looking for food. Captain Alfred Salvador, Captain Dulcisimo Conception with a few men were also doing their job in Barrio Arubod, Jones, which brought in their last of five Japs (killed 1 Lt. and 4 Bn). Arms captured were one saber, one pistol, four rifles and four bayonets and three hand grenades.

About the end of June 1945, 22 Japanese had a ditch battle with Lt. *he*

14. Alfredo Salvador led a platoon of his men on the other side of the river across Iruho, Jones, the battle lasted for a day and during the following night 21 Japs managed to find a way of retreat to the midst of darkness to Dapig, a barrio of Jones. The next morning, the remaining one Jpa soldier surrendered to the guerrillas of this outfit.

June 18, 1945- For the first time Americans of the 37th Inf. Div. went to Jones Isabela and returned on the afternoon to Santiago 30 miles from Jones. They gave few arms to replenish the unserviceable Japs rifles (PRBONO) which were captured by our men. They acted only as informants and guides, patrols of the American units.

June 19, 1945- The Americans went back to Honce, Isabela. The Jones Guerrilla Bn under Straughn Regiment, FAIT, furnished guides, interpreters, combat patrol intelligence information regarding the Japanese whereabouts. Three Japs were killed that day. They went back again to Santiago warning the Americans, leaving the Jones Guerrillas to go after the Japanese.

June 27, 1945- "C" Company, 20th Inf. went to Jones, and stayed there up to August 2, 1945- As usual the Jones Guerrilla Battalion assisted the Americans again. The CIC detachment APO 6, Santiago, Isabela, continued to give arms for the Jones Guerrilla Bn.

August 8, 1945- Captains Bunawa, Frago, Marcelo Domingo, and one of their men went to patrol the barrio of Rubian, Jones, and surprised Japanese killing 32 Japs. They captured 15 rifles, 6 sabers, and 6 cavans rice and 400 rounds of ammunition and 10 Japanese helmets.

August 7, 1945- Companies "I", "K" and "L" of the 128th Inf. 3d Bn, 50th Div. went to Jones, Isabela. The Jones Guerrilla Bn cooperated with these units as shown by the attached papers signed by Capt. EARL W. HALTERS, Bn S-3, 3d Bn, 128th Inf. by Lt. Merrill Hermannson, C.O. "C" Co. 20th Inf. Benjamin J. Weinstein, Special Agent CIC APO 6, Santiago, Isabela. The three companies left Jones, Isabela on August 16, 1945. One week later, they were replaced by "E" Co. of 2nd Bn, 148th Inf. 37 Division under Capt. Schmidt. His company stayed in Jones, Isabela up to September 18, 1945. The Jones Guerrilla Bn helped them in contacting the Japanese to surrender, to distribute to the Japs to through certain medium the leaflets informing them, the Japs to surrender.

It was through the efforts of the Jones Guerrilla Battalion that the Japs were contacted with representatives of Gen. Yamashita, into the remotest Jap infested forests which were not reached by the Americans. Around 16,000 Japanese including 2 colonels surrendered in that place. The forests of Jones, Isabela, were the last remaining ground of the Japs after the VILLA YARD hostility.

After the surrender of the Japanese in Jones, Isabela, all rifles and arms taken from the Japs and those given by the American Forces were turned into the custody of the "E" Company, 2nd Bn, 148th Inf. When there was an order to cease firing beginning Japs accepted to terms of surrender.

Up to his time, November 1945, 414 Japanese surrendered to the Mayor of Jones, Isabela who a Captain of the Jones Guerrilla Bn.
