- b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable vidence. Neither this unit nor the Finneer Balayam Town Guerrilla, Bahia-Deguito Unit, FAIT, to which this unit claims affiliation, can present any evidence of having ever existed other than on pager.
 - c. The unit was not unithelined satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the energy. The unit never functioned as a combat unit either before or after the arrival of the Americans. The unit claims to have had 30 arms, all homemade. The unit has no certificates of attachment with US Army units.
- d. A definite organization was not established by this unit. With few exceptions, all the officers and non-commissioned officers in the unit are members of two families, de Joya and de Leon. The unit never kept rosters or any other records. Although this is a small unit, 117 men, the leaders did

A set of general requirement for guerrills recognition, established by General Meadribur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. Ifter cureful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of vitnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrills unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

a. The unit was not saintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the energy.

b. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.

c. A definite organization was not established

d. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
