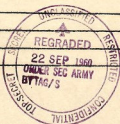

Dear Mr. Dalagan:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Baybay Battalion, BATT, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. A definite organization was not established.
- d. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders.
- e. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 66, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, copy attached.

RAYBAY BATTALION, FAIT

1. Lts Pete C Bress and Raul Diaz de Rivera proceeded to the Raybay Region (S.E. tip of Laguna de Bay), on 19 Feb 1947 to investigate the Baybay Battalion, FAIT.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY:

(See attached unit file)

3. FINDINGS:

a. The following named persons were interviewed, and their statements are reflected in the findings:

Lt Col Eusebio M Delagan	CO
Mej Sofia D Salgado	Executive O
Col M. V. Agustin	CO, MFA
Col David	CO, III Corps MFA
Col T Adevero	CO, ROTC
Col Agapito Valera	CO, Valera's Regt, Dominant in Baybay
S/Sgt. G. Neigum	Former guerrilla and RA EM

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. Few people in the Baybay area knew of the activities of this unit, yet the CO claimed his unit had received liberal help from the civilian population. The CO was unable to convince the contact team of the veracity of his unit's claimed activity. The CO did not have a thorough knowledge of his unit's activities.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. Cols Marling and David both stated this unit was not at all active. Sgt Neigum, who also operated in the Baybay area during the occupation, affirmed this fact. This organization maintained a combat unit, which did not leave its mountain barrio, the men living at home.

d. A definite organization was not established. The majority of the men of this unit are carried on the roster of Valera's Regt., MFA. Activities claimed by this unit are not their own but those of other established units in the area. There is no proof that an organization was definitely established and maintained.

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leader. According to Sgt Neigum, this CO spent the majority of the occupation on the other side of Laguna de Bay. According to the CO himself, many of his men joined other units; he was notified of this by the men concerned, only upon the completion of such action, and then accepted the action as being final. The CO was given eight days in which to assemble his unit for the investigation, and his men were still unassembled at the designated time.

RESTRICTED

f. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. A large number of this unit's members were caught in zonifications in the Baybay region; this fact being indicative that these men lived at home carrying on their normal civilian occupations. From what the contact team was able to learn, this unit did not exist except on paper.


g. No useful purpose will be accomplished by further investigation of this unit, since there are no members worthy of recognition. The CO said a separate casualty roster has been submitted, but it is not present among his unit's papers.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

This unit has no apparent political aspirations or affiliations.

5. RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that his unit be not favorably considered for recognition.

HISTORY AND ACTIVITIES OF THE BATTALION

I. ORGANIZATION:

The undersigned, Eusebio M. Dalagan, being practicing attorney, educator, and farmer with a burning patriotism in his heart and spurred to action by the sudden operation by the Japanese forces, in the absence of the declaration of war against the United States of America, the mother country of the Philippines, began organizing in October 1942, a battalion of men ready to sacrifice for the country. Men from different towns mostly Baybay towns, like Longos, Paete, Pakil, Pangil, Siniloan, Habibeo, and Santa Maria, some being students and cadets of the Baybay Academy, a recognized high school which he authored until now is the director, joined us in others known to us and to us known to be endowed with loyalty to our mother country.

The organization was gradual but sure and became faster when we retain contact with Col Hugh Straughn in the Sierra Madre mountains. To our regret the original list of our men was burned in Paete, a town was razed to the ground by fire intentionally made by the Japanese, upon their belief that all people there were guerrillas.

Company "A" under the command of Captain Aguedo M. Regalado a public school of Pakil was composed of men from Pakil, Paete, Pangil, Siniloan, Habibeo and Santa Maria. Company "B" under the command of Capt Claudio C. Macabasco was constituted entirely by men from the barrio of Kabulusan, Municipality of Pakil, province of Laguna. Company "C" was ably organized by Longos, Laguna by Capt Turiano D. Montes former member of the ~~Philippine~~ provincial Board of Laguna and until present a justice of the peace of Pakil, Laguna supported by men of high and professional attainment. Among them are Lt Benigno Ragasa, a graduate of law, Lt Nicetas Hermoso, Civil Engineer, Lt Porferio Miraflores, holder of B.S.E. and Lt Augusto Aguino, holder of B.S. and Dr. Jose Prospero Medical Officer. Some prominent women have also joined willingly the organization.

Major Sofio D. Salgado, a public school teacher in Pakil Elementary School, Pakil, Laguna did all his best to interest more men to join our forces until we finally could be considered successful.

In visiting Alaminos and Calauan to get in contact with the Philippine Quezon official guerrillas (PQG) I was also able to enlist some men there to be on watch with the movement of the Japanese army ~~and~~ Los Baños, Alaminos, San Pablo, Bay, and Calauan.

II. ACTIVITIES:

1. Enlisted men and officers were trained in different places and towns due to difficulties in communication and transportation and to evade apprehension from the enemy. Longos unit was trained far from the barrio of San Antonio

Longos, Laguna Those from Pakil and Kabulusan, Pakil Laguna on the other side of Laguna Bay, and those from Pangil, Paete, Siniloan, Mabatoc, and Santa Maria in the wilderness of Paete, Laguna. Such training was given at different periods to enable the men to come down to town as civilians to earn livelihood for their families and at the same time to do some intelligence work against the enemies.

2. Supplies from towns were furnished the combat units and members of the Fil-American army who escaped capture in Bataan and Carrigidor

3. All enlisted men and officers were on full time service day and night, always on the look out for Japanese and pro-Japanese elements as well as the bad elements like bandits

Later during the year it was deemed best to concentrate the force in Papatahan, Sirra Madre mountains, Paete, Laguna for a more united action. This was made possible thru the cooperation, loyalty and efficiency of all officers and men. During this time we planted cassavas, camoting baguin and other short season crops. We were practically self-supporting and were only forced to ask help peacefully from residents of towns when the Japanese army apprehended ~~in this~~ discovered the existence of our organization against them.

More arms and ammunitions were gradually secured from the Japanese by ambusing them and from Filipinos who were pro-Japanese and from civilians who did not need them very badly and were willing to help us win our course.

4. Protection and aid was given by us to evacuees whose lives became more and more subject to the atrocities of the Japanese the hated makapiles, and the bad element

5. Cooperation with other units such as the Hunters ROTc under Capt Dominador Santos, Markings under Major Neigum and PQOG under Col Juan Aquino was secured with good results.

6. Training of men under me and other officers was continued until ~~the~~ certain degree of efficiency was reached.

7. Supplies were sent by contact with Col Hugh Straughn while he was in Malaya, province of Rizal, under most adverse condition.

Sabotage and Destruction:

(1) Japanese cotton interest in Calauan, Bay, and Los Baños were disturbed from time to time until finally they decided to move to Tarlac.

(2) Destruction of possible ways of advantage to the Japanese army

8. Medical attention and supplies were offered to all Filipinos, guerrillas or not., with the help of drug stores, owners in towns.

9. Many of our men from Longos were killed in action and others from Paete, Pakil, Pañgil, Siniloan were garrisoned and tortured.

10. With more tortured and atrocities on the part of the Japanese army due to the activities of other guerrilla units we decided to remain with some underground activities

and waited patiently for the landing of the Americans in Leyte.

11. When the Americans landed in Leyte and Pangasinan we gave more training to our men to prepare for cooperation with the Americans by furnishing them information and intelligence regarding the strategy of the Japanese thru the allied intelligence unit of the Seventh Military District GHO, Negros.


12. Some of our brothers decided to join the American forces ~~XXXX~~ and in fact they processed ahead, under other units.

13. In connection with our operations in different places around ~~some~~ some 52 pro-Japanese Filipinos and 216 Japanese more or less were killed by our unit

14. After the liberation of Baybay towns, we continued serving the people in the regular army by doing patrol work against Japanese snipers, day and night. Some Japanese snipers were captured alive and some killed in Paete, Loigos, Pakil, Pañgil and in Sinloan.

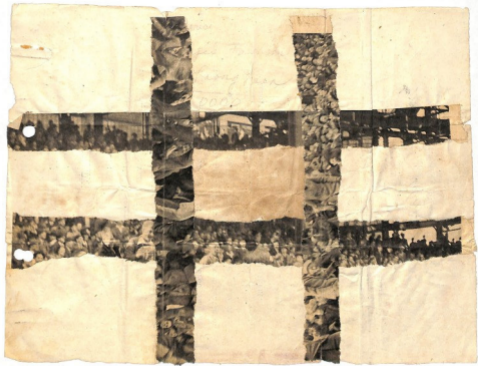

To whom it may concern:-

This is to testify that I know Rufino Alcaran since September (around the middle) of 1944 when he came over to the above address to notify me that my sister, Elisa Baja, was inside Fort Santiago and was alright. He used to bring letters from my sister to me and vice versa. He used to bring her food from me. After Elisa was out, he still came for about two times to inform me that my father, Colonel Emmanuel Baja was still inside and was going to be transferred to another place. This is all my information about Mr. Alcaran.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to certify that I knew Mr. Rufino Alcoran personally. The facts herein stated below, brought about my connections with Mr. Alcoran, and a lasting friendship was cemented thereafter.

Sometime, in the middle part of September, 1944, my uncle Dr. Joaquin Rodriguez (R.I.P.) together, with my cousins, relatives, and friends, were prisoners at Fort Santiago. God only knows how they suffer there! I was introduced to Mr. Alcoran thru a nephew of mine. I knew then that Mr. Alcoran was attached to Fort Santiago, by the underground movements. I bought medicines, at once when I knew it important and passed it to Mr. Alcoran. I received afterwards, the first news from my uncle. He told me to send him thru Mr. Alcoran, dried Talampunay flowers to alleviate his periodic sufferings from Asthma. This was only the beginning of many acts of service rendered to me by Mr. Alcoran. Almost everyday thru me, he brought food, clothing, medicines, words of encouragement to my uncle and relatives and vice versa. In fact, at one time, (I was told afterwards by release prisoners) when my means was very low, and I failed to send food, Mr. Alcoran was able to steal from the Jap kitchen, bring sweet potatoes, cold rice, and cigarettes for my dear relatives inside Fort Santiago. These services rendered by Mr. Alcoran, lasted about the last part of November when it was almost impossible on the part of Mr. Alcoran to carry on. An instance, was, when Mr. Alcoran came to me one day, badly cut and mutilated in the face, (after I advise him to be careful) when, he confided to me that he was being suspected already of connivance with prisoners and been beaten up by the Japs. I told him not to trust the Japs any further, and thru this the time to fled to the mountains. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~

This is my statement concerning Mr. Rufino Alcoran, and willing to state under oath the foregoing facts.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to certify that Mr. Rufino Alcoran who was serving in Fort Santiago as "Yoin" had helped me, my father, and my co-prisoners at Fort Santiago.

I, Reynaldo Rodríguez was one of the military prisoners who were caught in Malaboa, Rizal, on September 15, 1944 by Japanese Military Police.

After three days of detention and investigation (Third degree) in our place in Longos, Malabon, we were taken and imprisoned in the dungeons of Fort Santiago.

My family as well as those of my companions did not know where the Japs have imprisoned us. For weeks they vainly searched for us. Arturo G. Austria, my brother in law had been informed by his nephew, Ricardo A. Carandang that he, Ricardo Carandang knows a guerilla member by the name of Rufino Alcoran who entered Fort Santiago as a Jap soldier to spy, and to help those prisoners inside Fort Santiago. My brother in law then was introduced to Mr. Alcoran. Mr. Alcoran voluntarily promised to my brother in law to help him. The following day Mr. Alcoran verified that I and my companions were in Fort Santiago. For many times he secretly gave us food which we badly needed for we were given too little food inside the cell. He was then informing my family of our conditions inside the prison.

On October 7, 1944 I was released with some of my companions but my father was left behind. Mr. Alcoran continued to help my father. I secretly sent food, medicine and clothing to my father thru Mr. Alcoran knowing that the discovery of which will cause the head of Mr. Alcoran. To this, I pray that the vital needs of my father will pass thru successfully and safely.

This we continue to pass food, clothing and medicine until Mr. Rufino Alcoran was sent to another place.

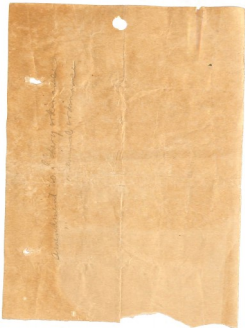

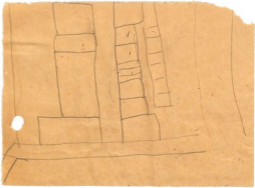

SOUTH CENTRAL ZONE

SUBJECT: HOW I GUIDED COL. HUGH STRAUGHN U. S. ARMY FROM PAKIL, LAGUNA
TO JALAJALA, RIZAL, VIA CABULUSAN AND TAAI.

It was early one morning in the month of Jan. 1942, the day of which I could not remember, while I, Claudio G. Macabasco, was standing in front of the Municipal Building of Pakil, Laguna, an American with two Filipino comrades, they were a man of about fifty and a boy of about fifteen came riding in an automobile stopped and inquired for the Municipal Mayor. The Municipal Mayor being in the Municipal Bldg. that time welcomed the American and asked why he inquired for him. The American answered that somebody told him that there was a way from this town to Manila by crossing the lake then up the mountain trails beyond the lake.

The American asked the Mayor if he could find for him a man to take them across the lake by boat for he wanted to reach Manila as soon as possible. He told that he came from Pailillo, Tayabas. I being present before them volunteered myself to take them across the lake and he greatly appreciated it. I prepared my boat but as it was too small for us I got another one for our trip. I got Santos Balita, of this municipality to pilot the other boat. The American rode in my boat and his two companions and Santos boat. We started at about 10:00 A.M. and as there was favorable wind we easily cross the lake. My boat got ahead of Santos, so we reached barrio Cabulusan first. We reached there at about 11:30 A.M. We took our rest while waiting for the boat. It did not take long and the other boat arrived. An hour later we continued our trip to Taal barrio also of Pakil, the nearby barrio southwest of Cabulusan. We reached Taal in about twenty minutes. He had his companions and myself stayed in the house of Ciriano Ramirez, my brother-in-law. I found out that his elder companion was his cook and the younger was his boy.

During that time in that place there were many evacuees from the neighboring places. Many people were in doubt for he might be a German citizen and a Japanese spy. I told him about the peoples' impression about him and he was greatly amazed. He showed me his identification and I have known that he was retired Col. Hugh Straughn of the U. S. Army. We spend the day discussing about the barrio people. At twilight he told me to get three men to help carry his baggage and I be the guide for their journey to Jalajala the next morning. I got Juan de Ofonte, Anacleto Dorado and Marcelo Dorado. The next morning we started for the journey at about six o'clock A.M. We reached Jalajala about 1:00 p.m. safely. In Jalajala Col. Straughn look for the Mayor. The Mayor was Mr. Gregorio Borja that time. The Mayor greeted him and conversed with him. I did not know what they talked about for I was very far from them.

An hour later he told me if we could continue to guide them to the next barrio Logos, for he was informed that there was a passenger motor boat bound to Manila. I asked my companions if we can still go. They told me that they could not go any further for we might be overtaken by the night in going back to Taal. And besides we were informed that there were already Japanese in Tanay.

So we left them in Jalajala and I and my three companions returned to our barrio. But before leaving he gave us fifteen pesos as a compensation for our services. We bade good-bye and we did not know what happened next.
