My dear Colonel Pales.

I understand that your Office is very busy investigating Guerilla units pending recognition. Hewever, much as I regret to bother you about our unit- the TUGUICUIT Tuy, Batangas Unit under the hate Col. Straungh, I ambompeled to do so in view of a very disturbing information that came to my knewledge to the effect that the said unit is not listed as among those still pending recognition. During the past few months we have been repeatedly given assurance by our Colonels that our case is still pending and that erectual recognition may be forthcoming.

For your information I wish to state here that after the death of our original Colemain-Col. Espins of Satangas, Satangas- and Col. Tuguigui of Tuy Satangas erganizers of the said unit, Maj. Calingaan and Major Apacible also members of this unit, took command and both becoming self-appointed Colemals and by invitation of the SLUE ENGLE COMMAND, which was about then to be processed, they attached themselves with the Blue Eagle, including only part of the Tuguigui Unit, and those who did not know about it were left behind- eventually the Flue Eagle has been processed and with them our commanders and part of our unit. So that what happand to us was just like the crows of a ship abandoned by its commanders to take command of another pair, Very strange indeed! We were abandoned by the men on when we depended much to carry on our unit after the execution of Col. Estains and Col. Tuguigui.

Remember 6el, that we joined the organization without any promise of compensation except that we were told that we are to help in the de-

of our democratic principles and that we are under Col. Straughn (we learner RECORDS later that he was executed by the Japs.). We joined the organization knowtent FILE ing that a little mistake would cost us our necks.

Remember also Colonal, that if we claim now for eventual recognition, it is because we consider our case also entitled to all the benefits accorded other Guerilla Units. I personally know of some men luckier that us because they have been processed long time age, and yet some of them have refused to join us- Our Engineer Com. when organized in 1942 (Oct. 12) here in Lumbangan, Nasughu, Batangas, just a few weeks after its organization withh originated in Tuy, Batangas, Was it because the Japs were victorious then? But mind you Colonal Stunrt, were Col. Espina and Col. Tuguigui living teday, things will be different. Suffice to say then that after all we have contributed something to our Country and to Mother America.

In closing, I only beg of you Col. Pales, on my own behalp, my Co. and fellow efficers of the 2nd and 3rd Sm. of the referred unit, to kindly inform us the exact fate of our Unit. I am very much obliged and thank you so much Col. Stuart Pales.

- The "Tuy Unit FAIT" consisting of 1200 members under the command of Vicente Calingasan has not been favorably considered for recognition. An undetermined number of forer members of the Tuy Unit FAIT pave previously been recognized in the roster of the Blue Eagle Brigade.
- Col. Marking Agustin and Terry Adevoso PA overall commanders of the Fil-Americans and Hunters ROTC respectively state that the Tuy Unit PAIT was a passive organisation.
  - 3. Basis for non-recognition:
- a. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- b. Activities of the unit did not contribute material-
- c. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information.
- d. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.
- e. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.
- f. Some personnel listed as members of the unit assisted it by contributing money and supplies but did not serve in a capacity considered to justify such membership.

  g. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.

#### REPORT ON "THY HATP."

In accordance with verbal instructions from Chief of Section, Guerrilla Affairs Branch, G-3, AFFAIRS, literants Leonard J. Atbachon and Eliseo Sta. Romans proceeded to Tuy, Batangas to contact the Tuy Unit FAIT in order to determine whether or not this organization should be recognized by the Thited States army. #### HISTORY

Desings A. Tuguigul a minister of the Disciples of Christ Church is claimed to have been active in sepionage extivities, in Mania in early 1942. In August 1942 he learned he was wanted by the Japa, so he left Mania and went to Tuy, Batagass where on 3 September 1942 he began to organize the Tuy Unit FAIT asserting that he had been given authority to form the unit by Gd. hugh S. Strughn.

During the years of accupation the unit confined its activities to maintenance of peace and order, spreading propagands, hunting Japaspies, sabotaging the Japasperimental cotton crops and assisting in the organization of other guerrille units. Ty 1944 the unit adjained a membership of 2000 members and the arms they possessed totaled forth.

The Twy Unit FAIT was organized during September 1942 with Dowingo Inquigud as CO and Vicente Calingsen Mayor of Twy as Executive Officer. The Unit had very few arms so could not operate as a combat organization. According to the statements of vicente Caligasen and Application. Apacible, leaders of the organization, their activities were confined to maintenance of peace and order munting out spies, spreading propagands and helping to organize other guerrilla units. They also claim to have sabotaged the Jap cotton raising experiments. All of these activities were patriotic work, but were more sinor in nature and cannot be considered as having

It is apparent that the organization was very loosely but, for after the dest of Dowingo Tuguthui, it never operated as a unit and each company worked independently. It is the belief of the investigating officer that the unit actually ceased to exist after Tuguinui's death for the members of the organization were extremely Ravy as to activities and operation after this time. On October 1944 Ficente Calingasan and application injectible recruited approximately \$ 700 forces members of the Tug Unit FAIT which group became a part of the Sainbow Reet, Blue Eagle Command that was then in the process of organizing.

# POLITICAL ASPECTS

Both Vicente Calingasan and Amlinario R. Apacible are politicians and evidence was found that they used the Blue Eagle

Brigade for political purposes during the recent election campaign however it is believed by the investigating officer that the Tuy unit FAIT was too disorganized to be used effectively as a political weapon.

# RECOMMENDATION

After careful consideration of statements made by members of the organization and an analyse of the documents presented, it is recommended that the Tuy Unit FAIT be not favorably considered for recognition.

Immediately after the organization of the Unit on Zeptember 3, 1942. the Unit at ence ergenized a prepagenda section which eperated 2 radio receiving sets, one ewmed by Capt. Temas Panaligan and the other by Capt. Culicane afable, both members of the prepagands section of the Unit. Incidentally, Capt. Leenarde Almanzer, also a member of the propaganda section, is an experienced stenegrapher and could take radio news breadcasts from San Francisco daily in shorthand and transcribe them on the typewriter. The typewriters in the effice of Capt. Clemente Sale, the incumbent municipal treasurer and the municipal mayor's effice were always used when doing this transcribing jeb, Ser veral cepies were made. Translations into the local dislect was also made and typewritten cepies sent to the nen-english reading folks. English transcribed netes were sent to other guerrills units of neighborring municipalities like Balayan, Masugbu, Lian, Calatagan, Calaca, Lenery, Tasl, Batangas and even as for as Manile. As Jap spier were lurking here and there even the convente of . Tuy, with the venevelent censent of 1st Lt. Eufresine Leuterie, attached chaplain of the Unit, and even the gutters of the municipal building of Tuy. places which were to be least suspected to mest anti-Jap activities, were the very places where the receiving sets were kept and news breadcasts taken. Te these whe heard the "Veice of Freedem" the breadcast was like a shet in the vein to give them renewed life and jey. For America was speaking, America was premising, America was fighting, MacArthur was returning! The way may be lined with cresses from New Quines to the Philippines, but Democracy and freeden must return here and with American arms the Filipines were willing to fight side by side with the Americans until the enemy has receiled to his hemeland and learned his lessen there. Such a desire was net wanting in the efficers and men of this Unit. They were biding their time and limited thenselves to keeping up the merale of the people high by means of effective propagenda activities, pretecting the civilian population against lawless elements. liquidating Japanese-hired spice like the neterious Merberte Menales of Masugbu, Batangas and his men. Nemales was killed tegether with his men right in the middle of the tewn of Tuy under the direction of Major Vicente Culingagen in Saptember 1943. Nemsles was responsible for the uncarthing of arms and ammunitien, also gaseline in Nasugbu which the retreating USAFFE men left in the wake of their systematic retreat. Besides this he was a constant menace to the peace of the people as he committed abuses here and there.

On January 12, 1943, Major Deminge A. Tuguigui went to Manila and the dev fellowing he went to the Samanille puilding to see an important guerrilla figure in connection with his guarrilla activities. He did not know that he was being fellowed by the Japanese Kempei Tai. He was arrested and Fort Santiageed. Major Deminge A. Tuguigui was all the time busy organizing other guerrilla units of the FAIT in neighboring municipalities. - 5. That due to the loss of command due to the news of the arrest and execution of our organizer, Major Desinge A. Tuguigui, the Unit was effi-listed to the Blue Eagle Command on October 15, 1944;
- 6. That in the fusion or attachment to the Blue Eagle Command some of the officers and men of the Fil-American Irregular Troops of the Tuy Unit were not included due to the lack of time and the lack of adequate means of communication;
- 7. That notwithstanding our attachment and induction into the Blue Eagle Command, the non-affiliated and non-inducted members of the Tuy Unit of the Fil-American Irregular Troops which was organized by Major Domingo A. Neutral on September 3, 1942, suffered likewise untold sufferings and sacrifices for the cause of democracy and freedom, under the risk of losing their own life and beyond the call of duty before and during the liberation.

sir:

This is to file complaints against Mai. Vicente Calingasan of Tuy, Batangas, belonging to Rainbow of Dlue Bagle Regiment which is now being processed, as follows:

- 1. Vicente Calingasan, served as the Municipal Mayor of Tuy during the Japanese regime.
- 2. As Mayor he terrorized the ignorant barrio people, exacting from them foodstuffs for the consumption of the Japanese Army, often times getting plager quantities of foodstuffs than the requirement of the Japanese for the purpose of selling them for profits for nis own personal benefit,
- 3. He established a buying corporation for the Army and Nevy, of which he is thehead, by geining \$1.00 per kilo of foodstuffs for his purchases.
- 4. One time, he gave a reception for F. Concepcion de la Rame, now detained for charge of treason, when said Mr. de la Rame came to Tuy to find out the situation of the Buying Corporation headed by Vicente Califigasan.
- 6. Vicente Celimgasan caused the murder of one Rosales of Tuy, prother of Justino Rosales, of the same for criticising the high-handed conduct of the Municipal police of Tuy.
- 6. Vicente Califigasan kept some Americans in the mountain during the Japaness occupation, and collected contribution from various people, specially from the officials of the Sugar Gentral Don Pedro, located in Nasugbu, Estangas, and pocketed the contributions for his own use and benefit.
- 7. At present he has in the possession of his men who are the lawless elements of the town, about 70 guns of all sizes, and make, in spite of the law requiring all guerilles to surrender their erms. He will use these erms, and he did before, in lawless exts, and hold the people down by means of force and terroriam. Even during the Japanese time he was connected with robbery and locting cases.
- 8. A policemon was caught with a stolen horse. He confessed that he stole the horse following the instructions of Mayor Califigasan. After the confession, he instructed the Japanese Kempi to kill nim. He was killed immediately.

9. Vicente Calingasan was arrested by the Japanese Wilitary Police as a guerilla suspect. He squealed against almost all the people of Batangas, who were later arrested and tortured.

- 10. Thru use of intimidation and force Calingssan ordered bamboos cut from private lands and sold them for profit without paying the owners.
- 11. The elected Mayor of Tuy is Apolinario Apacible, an attorney, and refused to serve the Japanese, but political mechinations, returned Vicente Calingasan to the same post he occupied during the Japanese occupation.
- 12. In the hold-up perpetrated by an American and a dozen Filipinos in Palico, Nasugbo, Estangas, where one man was wounded and over Plo. 200. 00 were taken by the bandits from several people, Vicente Calingasan tried to quash the case because of his connection with the lawless elements.
- 13. Vicente Calingasan is now busy recruiting men to form his guerilla group to be processed, men who had never taken any active part in the resistance movement, just to get a Colonel rank. Two of his new recruited officer, Tirso Cruz and Domingo Pasia were members of the Makapili organized under Vicente Calingaran. They made speeches asking young men to join the Makapili and organized the Purchasing Corporation for the Japanese Army and Navv.

- I recommend that Maj. Rueda in the Criminal Investigation. M. P., Manila, be detailed to investigate secretly the charges against Vicente Calingasan, and his present activity in recruiting men for his guerilla group. Maj. Rueda was once a Constabulary officer of the place and knows all the people around. All should be made secret because Caliggasan and his men ere armed. Thesepeople should be kept in prison instead of processing them in the Philippine Army.
- I am a widow with five small children. My husband died because Vicente Calingasan reported him to the Japanese. I live in a farm, and I cannot risk revealing my identity because
