Dear Mr. Valencia:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Casiguran Guerrilla Force, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army. ✓

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
- e. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, copy attached.

REPORT ON: "CASIGURAN GUERRILLA FORCE"

1. REQUEST FOR RECOGNITION RECEIVED 25 Jan '46
2. ALLEGED HISTORY: SEE ATTACHED UNIT FILE.
3. FINDINGS:
 - a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. No papers of any sort except a list of activities was contained in the unit file.
 - b. Unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field as the unit was formed in late 1944 and the members lived at home.
 - c. Activities did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. Propaganda and the spreading of news were the only activities claimed by the unit.
 - d. Adequate records as to dates of enlistment and promotions and necessary related information were not maintained.
 - e. Members did not devote their entire time to military activities to the exclusion of normal civilian pursuits.
4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

There appear to have no political affiliations or aspects.
5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the Casiguran Guerilla Force, be not favorably considered for recognition. No useful purpose will be gained by further investigation of this unit.

Events and Activities

- I. 21 Sept. 1944, Hundreds of American planes passed over Casiguran skies Casiguran Guerilla Force Organization effective this date.
2. 15 Oct. 1944, Mayor Angara with Family abdicated his office and joined the Guerilla Force. 2:00 AM After the celebration of Philippine Independence, Sponsored by Capt. Nishizaka Garrison Commander. Benefit ball at the Casiguran, Elementary School Building.
3. 15 Oct. 3:00 PM. Japanese fighter plane had a force landing at Bo. of Calantes, 2 and a half km from the town.
4. 1st week of Nov. AM First raid led by Cpl. ~~Coronado~~ Mora at Sitio of Gumanenang Bo. of Tinib; 5 Japanese soldiers of the Radio Station were seriously injured. Bow and Arrow were used.
5. About 2nd week of Nov. 1944. Zonification of Casiguran people ordered by Capt. Nishizaka. People to within 2 and half radius of the poblacion.
6. 2 Dec. 1944 Japs machine gun Guerilla headquarter at Ura, Sierra madre mts.
7. Relatives of Guerilla members were concentrated at the town plaza; investigation and torturing happened.
7. 28 Dec. 1944 Mayor Angara and family with 3 relatives left Casiguran bound for Baler.
8. First week of Jan. 1945; 2 Japanese fighter planes made force landing at Pudoc seashore Casiguran bay. pilots were alive.
9. 2nd week of Jan. 1945 Another Japs plane force landed at Marikit ricefield plantation; aviator was slightly injured.
10. Feb. 1945 U.S. Naval Ship G F I anchored at Casiguran Sound. Lended the Guerilla with Carbines.
11. 4 March 1945 Japanese soldiers Station in Casiguran together with those who arrived on retreat from south left the town after setting it with fire.
Houses of Mr. Catalino Hernandez, Vidal Portera Lucio Valencia and Honorio Valencia were turned to ashes.
12. Last week of March 1945 Bow and Arrow Raid at Dilasag beach led by Sgt. Angara, Venancio. 5 Japs were killed
13. May, 1945 3 japs sailor on a banca surrendered to C.G.F. at Diapitan bay Dilasac. This japs were turned over to Pathfinder U.S. Sub-chaser.
14. April 1945 13 Japs on a sailboat were shot to death by Guerilla station at Sibato Shore Casiguran Bay, Arms and other Japs property were given to the Pathfinder in exchange for clothes and cigarettes and mededines.
- 15 July 1945. 10 Japs under the command of Capt. Jacobo were surprise attack by ~~Capt.~~ Angara and 15 members all were killed, except one taken prisoner turn over to ~~other~~ ^{U.S. Officer} ~~Japs~~.
- 16 Information from runner;
Sept and Oct. 1945; 100 Japs surrendered to the C. G. F. and were taken by B. S. Mainag.

Events and Activities

1. 21 Sept. 1944. Hundreds of American planes passed over Cashiyama and the Cashiyama Guerrilla Force Organization effective this date.
2. 15 Oct. 1944. Major Angars with family abdicated his office and joined the Guerrilla Force. 2:00 AM he left the celebration of Philippine Independence, sponsored by Capt. Nishizaka, Guerrilla Force Commander. Benefit ball at the Cashiyama Elementary School Building.
3. 15 Oct. 2:00 PM. Japanese fighter plane had a force landing at No. 4. 1st week of Nov. an F-47 was shot down by Guerrilla forces. Radio Station were seriously injured. Bow and Arrow were used.
3. About 2nd week of Nov. 1944. Fortification of Cashiyama people ordered by Capt. Nishizaka. People to within 2 and half miles of the population.
6. 2 Dec. 1944. Japs machine gun Guerrilla headquarters at Hsu, Shieh road happened.
7. 28 Dec. 1944. Major Angars and family with 3 relatives left Cashiyama bound for Haler.
8. First week of Jan. 1945. 2 Japanese fighter planes made force landing at Haler. Cashiyama Guerrilla Force were active.
9. 2nd week of Jan. 1945. Another Japs plane landed at Haler. Guerrilla force was slightly injured.
10. Feb. 1945. U.S. Navy ship G E I anchored at Cashiyama Sound. Landed the Guerrilla with Cashiyama.
11. 4 March 1945. Japanese soldiers in Cashiyama town together with those who arrived on retreat from south left the town after setting it with fire.
12. Houses of Mr. Catalino, Hsu and ex. Vidal Fortera in Haler, Haler and Haler were turned to ashes.
13. Last week of March 1945. Bow and Arrow Raid at Haler beach led by Capt. Angars. 3 Japs were killed.
14. May 1945. 3 Japs sailor on a dance were turned over to Guerrilla. This Japs were turned over to Guerrilla.
15. 2nd Chapter. U.S. Air-Force. The Japs on a sailboat were shot to death by Guerrilla. Guerrilla force Cashiyama, Haler and other Japs property were given to the Guerrilla in exchange for clothes and cigarettes and medicines.
16. Japs under the command of Capt. Japs were surprised. 15 Japs and 15 members all were killed.
17. Except one taken prisoner turn over to Guerrilla.
18. Information from number: Capt. Angars, 100 Japs surrendered to the C. G. T. and were taken by E. S. Haler.
