Dear Colonel Acosta:

Your letter of 19 March 1947, indorsing the communication of Colonel Dominador B. Ruis, commanding officer of the 4th Infantry Regiment, Central Division, Army of the Agno, has been received.

As in the case of your previous letters of 20 March 1947, forwarding similar communications of Lt Colonel Teodoro Y. Gomez and Lt Colonel Angel L. Macaraeg, the present communication appears to center about "screening" -- that is to say, reduction -- of rosters previously submitted and considered by this headquarters in the announced rejection of the subject unit for official recognition. Statements contained in the letter of Colonel Ruis include request for permission to remove "less deserving guerrillas included in the roster."

Referring to our letter of 12 April 1947, it is again emphasized that a basic principle of operation in the conduct of guerrilla affairs is our assumption that rosters presented by commanding officers are just and accurate musters of the guerrilla units they advance for official recognition, i.e., containing only bona fide and deserving guerrillas. Wherever it becomes evident that such proffered rosters contain undeserving guerrillas, they are rejected summarily. The rosters thus advanced by elements of your guerrilla organization were similarly accepted by this headquarters in good faith. We are therefore disturbed to have ranking officers of your organization now offer belatedly to remove from the submitted rosters all names of those admittedly not bona fide guerrillas.

Your request, therefore, for the amending of rosters of your rejected units is not favorably considered.

Replying to your communication of 6 February 1947, I have the honor to make the following answers regarding the activities of the Fourth Infantry Regiment, Central Division, Army of the Agno, First Organized Pangasinan Army Corps, Fil-American Guerrilla Forces "USAFEL", now a portion of the WORLD WAR II ARMY OF THE AGNO VETERANS' LEGION, registered and incorporated under the laws of the Philippines, to wit:

- a. The records of service of this unit are and will be substantiated if properly given due consideration for re-examination in the premises. The undersigned in his capacity as commanding officer of this unit, acting in behalf of his members, hereby request your good honor to give them a chance to prove that the records of their works during the Enemy occupation deserves them to be recognized. It is an injustice and inhuman if this unit will not be accorded the benefit of recognition, when in fact they have sacrificed not only their very lives but also the lives of their dear ones as well as the lives of their closed relatives and friends in joining the underground works against the Enemy. The National Volunteers of the Philippines, in recognition of their valuable services rendered by the members of this unit including the Commanding Officer, have decorated two its members, including the said Commanding Officer, with the DISTINGUISHED SERVICE MEDALS of the said National Volunteers last 15 March 1947 at Luneta, Manila in a solemn Military Review. The citation of award to the Commanding Officer of this unit, Colonel DOMINADOR BORDADO RUIZ, NVP read as follows: "Pursuant to a resolution promulgated recently by the Supreme Council and in recognition for his long, honest, faithful and continuous services to the National Volunteers of the Philippines; for his exceptional courage, loyalty, patriotism and sacrifices by risking his own life in actively and continuously performing the most delicate and dangerous task in espionage and

f. There is a perfect of continuity of activity and organization has not ceased its persistent resistance against the Enemy. Since 1942 especially after the surrender of Bataan and Corrigidor, the Army of the Agno, of which this unit is a portion, had greatly molested the whole Japanese Forces in Central and Northern Luzon especially in Pangasinan. As a matter of fact the puppet constabulary could not patrol in the mountains unless some members of such puppet constabulary has within among them one or two members of the Army of the Agno who is acting as our operatives to inform us of the War Plans of the Enemy.

g. The members could not have stayed at home even if they wished to for most of them if not all of them have always been wanted by the Enemy. General Acosta was wanted by the Japanese and that the Japanese since 1942 offered \$50,000.00 for his head, dead or alive. How could these members of this unit stay at home rather than in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations, when General Yamashita in his testimonial before the War Crime Commission that tried him as a War Criminal, testified that the only guerrilla organization that disturbed his military plans and movements of his troops was the Army of the Agno, of which this unit is a portion of such a guerrilla organization in Central Luzon? The members of this unit have greatly and actively contributed to the strength of the Army of the Agno, whom General Yamashita called the Overall Commander of such a guerrilla organization the TERROR OF THE NORTH. The members of this unit received instructions from the Overall Commander from the field for the further prosecution of the aims of General Douglas MacArthur to clean or pave a way for the coming of the Liberation Forces of the Americans under the direct command of Said General MacArthur, to return, as he did return.

In view of the foregoing, the undersigned hereby request that the decision given be put aside and that the unit be given opportunity to screen less-deserving guerrillas included in the roster. It should be noted that few of those in the roster have already been processed if not reprocessed in the Army of the Philippines for having been activated with the American Liberation Forces. The recognition of the whole unit is the goal of the presentation for recognition.

Executive Order No. 68 of His Excellency the President has already been complied with as all the arms have been handed to the proper army authorities on the liberation of



Dear Mr. Ruiz:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the "Fourth Regiment, Central Division, First Organized Pangasinan Army Corps, Army of the Agno, Fil-American Guerrilla Forces, USAFFE," purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. A definite organization was not established.
- e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders.
- f. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.
- g. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

Report on the "Army of the Agno"

1. The following report takes into consideration the overall command of the Army of the Agno, which consists of numerous regiments as listed in paragraph 2. The investigation of the Army of the Agno consisted of two phases; Phase 1, being a physical investigation of the 31st Infantry Regiment, Army of the Agno by Capt Tabora and Lt De Silva, to determine if further investigations of the subordinate units of the Army of the Agno would be necessary. The report on the 31st Infantry Regiment is attached as inclosure 5. The result of the investigation indicates that no further field investigation would be necessary. It is considered that this investigation is adequate. Phase 2, was an investigation by Capt Robert L Morton of the records of the unit and the interviewing of top guerrilla leaders and Philippine Army personnel who had operated in the region claimed by the Army of the Agno.

3. ALLEGED HISTORY: The histories of the various units of the Army of the Agno varied as to the means and methods by which organizations were formed, but the general drift of all the histories combined, is that the Army of the Agno was organized in the early part of 1942 through the leadership of Miguel Acosta, who gathered USAFFE stragglers, deserters, and men who were cut off from the main lines of resistance by the Japanese forces. Apparently the organization became big and, in addition to the USAFFE members, inducted persons from all walks of life. During the year 1942 the Army of the Agno undoubtedly resisted the Japanese to some extent as many members of the unit were USAFFE men who had maintained their arms and had the will to continuously fight the enemy.

In the early months of 1943, Acosta surrendered to the Japanese and the organization was disintegrated. The members who wished to continue guerrilla activities, joined with other units such as the ECLGA, under Lt Col Edwin P. Ramsey; Luzon Guerrilla Army Forces, under Major Lapham; USAFIP NL, under Col R S Volckmann; or ROTC-Hunter's under Col Terry Adevosos, whereas, the remainder of the unit not wishing to carry on active resistance, returned to normal civilian pursuits.

b. As stated in preceding paragraph, it is probable that a few of the original USAFFF members of the original unit had resisted the enemy in the year 1942, but it is impossible to determine these members, for they have undoubtedly joined other guerrilla units and are no longer carried on the rosters submitted for recognition. The Army of the Agno, claims activities throughout the Japanese occupation and the American liberation, but these activities consisted mainly of "home guard activities" as partly admitted by the unit's history, and were not the activities of a well organized guerrilla organization.

c. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. The Army of the Agno, and its subordinate units, as presented for recognition, remained absolutely passive during the occupation and the liberation. It was not in any sense a well organized guerrilla unit, due probably to lack of arms and the absence of an overall command. There is no supporting evidence presented to substantiate the claims in resistance against the enemy. Though the unit claims attachment to an American Force, the evidence presented shows attachment as paid labor battalions and individual laborers. Affidavit from disinterested persons recommend certain individuals as to their existence and activities. It is to be noted that in most case, if not all, those persons were recognized members of other guerrilla units. Thus further indicated that Acosta took certain politicians and recognized guerrillas and built his unit around them, hoping to get consideration on the basis of the activities of the recognized personnel.

d. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy, because the USAFIP/NI, ROTC-Hunter's, LG.F, and ECLGA, all recognized guerrilla organizations, operated and dominated the area claimed by the Army of the Agno. The statements of guerrilla leaders, as discussed in paragraphs 4 h and 1, indicates that the unit did not exist during the occupation and liberation.

e. A definite organization was not established by this unit because the overall commander, Miguel R. Acosta, was an officer with the Japanese Constabulary from the early

part of 1943 until late in 1944, and did not return to the area of claimed operation of his unit until February 1946. During the greater part of his absence from his unit, Acosta was assigned to the Japanese Constabulary in Cebu, and remained there until the liberation, at which time he was attached to the 6th Army and was taken to Okinawa and Japan. Officers and enlisted men of the Army of the Agno lived with their families and supported them by means of normal civilian pursuits, throughout the occupation. Many members of this unit carried on the roster as battalion commanders and other top positions, held political positions during the Japanese occupation.

f. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its commanding officer and subordinate commanders because the commanding officer was absent from his unit throughout most of the occupation, and when subordinate commanders and non-commissioned officers were questioned, they had to rely upon notes in order to give answers to the interviewing officer, which indicated that the members had been coached prior to the interview.

g. The unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization because it cannot show any achievement accomplished during the occupation or liberation, nor can it show any supporting evidence.

h. General Calixto Duque, G-3 of USAFIP, NL and at present, Deputy Chief of Staff, Army of the Philippines, stated that he had operated at Dagupan, Pangasinan, both during the occupation and early liberation, and he stated that he had never heard of the Army of the Agno nor any of its subordinate units during the occupation. Colonel A. G. Gabriel, a recognized guerrilla with PQGG, who had operated in Central Luzon, and at present G-2, Headquarters, Army of the Philippines, stated that he had had intelligence officers in Pangasinan during the occupation and that he had never heard nor received reports of the Army of the Agno, and he recommended that it be flatly refused recognition.

i. Colonels Angleon, Marking, Anderson, Volckmann, all stated that they had never heard of the Army of the Agno during the occupation and liberation. Whereas Colonels Ramsey and Adevosio stated that they had heard of a guerrilla unit under the command of Acosta, during 1942, but the unit was disorganized and the activities were slight. They further remarked that when Acosta voluntarily surrendered to the Japanese, some of the active members joined with their command, and the remainder of the unit disintegrated. Colonels Ramsey and Adevosio recommended that the unit be not favorably considered for recognition for any of the activities which it claims. It must be noted that the deserving guerrillas in Pangasinan have been recognized with one of the units previously mentioned.

j. Attached hereto as Incl 1 is an article from the Manila Times, dated 16 December 1946, in which the Philippine Army declares the Army of the Agno as illegal.

k. Attached hereto as Incl 2 is the G-2 report from Headquarters, Army of the Philippines of its investigation of the Army of the Agno which given basis for its claiming the Army of the Agno as illegal. This report proves beyond a doubt, that the Army of the Agno has been inducting personnel into its organization as late as March 1946, and that the leaders of the unit have been collecting fees from the members inducted. Headquarters, Army of the Philippines claims that the officers and members of the Army of the Agno maybe prosecuted under the Revised Penal Code, for the following reasons:

- (1) Usurpation of Official Function - for issuing firearm licenses and permits without being duly authorized.
- (2) Illegal using of Army uniforms and insignia.
- (3) Swindling or Estafa.

l. Attached hereto as Incl 3 is a copy of confidential document, MEMORANDUM FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE, subject: "Army of the Agno", from the San Fernando CIC Field Office. This report emphasized the following points of interest:

- (1) The absence of the overall commander from the region he claims to have operated during the greater part of the occupation and liberation.
- (2) Recent induction of members into the "Army of the Agno"
- (3) The non-existence of the "Army of the Agno" during the occupation and liberation.

Exhibits referred to in the report do not accompany the report, but may be examined at Headquarters, 1135 CIC Detachment, APO 707.

m. Attached as Incl 4 is the various complaints against the Army of the Agno for recruiting and organizing after the liberation. It was proven by the investigation that there was ground for those complaints because disinterested parties were interviewed and they too made the same charges. The general gist of those complaint letters is that the Army of the Agno was never a guerrilla organization during the occupation or liberation, and that many of the members were collaborators of the Japanese.

n. Timoteo Certeza, spoke highly of the unit, but at the same time stated that the strength was too large. Certeza admitted that he appears on the rosters of the "Army of the Agno" as a Major General, but when questioned about his activities he remarked that he spent the year 1942 and early part of 1943 in the mountains near San Jose, Bulacan, and

then returned to Manila to carry on his normal pursuits, and has done so until the present time. He further admitted that the only connection he had with Acosta was that he authorized Acosta to organize a National Volunteer unit in the province of Pangasinan.

o. Capt Tabora, an officer of this section, who operated throughout Pangasinan during the operations, claims there was an organization under Acosta, during 1942 and although they possessed many arms their activities were null, and that the unit had never operated as a guerrilla organization. He further stated that the unit disintegrated after the surrender of Acosta, and recommends the unit be not favorably considered for recognition. Check sheet of Capt Tabora's regarding the Army of the Agno, is attached as inclosure #6.

p. No useful purpose will be served by any further investigation of this unit.

q. There was no members worthy of recognition and it is doubtful that the unit suffered any casualties due to their activities with this unit, although it is noted that few casualties were claimed in the rosters. They could submit individual requests.

5. POLITICAL ASPECTS: It is noted that many of the leading figures in the submitted rosters were the leading political aspirants who inducted personnel into the unit and applied for their recognition indicating that the unit is being used to support many of the politicians, in their political field.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the Army of the Agno and its subordinate units be not favorably considered for recognition.

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 15 July 1946 in which you request the approval and recognition of the promotion of Col. Donador Ruiz, Commanding Officer of the 4th Regiment (Central Division).

Please be informed that this headquarters has no authority to confirm promotions of unrecognized guerrillas. After a guerrilla unit is recognized, the officers and men become a part of the Philippine Army and retain their guerrilla ranks until such time as the Philippine Army issues orders to the contrary. Furthermore, the matter of promotion of guerrilla officers within the Philippine Army, once recognized, is also a matter pertaining to the Philippine Army and not to the Army of the United States.

If it is your desire to present Col. Ruiz to this headquarters for recognition as a full Colonel, it is suggested that a formal request to that effect be forwarded to the Guerrilla Affairs Branch, SA Division, OS-3, Headquarters, AFMAG, APO 707. It is the belief, however, that your request is primarily for the purpose of confirming the promotion of Col. Ruiz. It is further suggested that, if an individual request for Col. Ruiz is submitted, it be withheld until the Army of the U.S. is investigated and a decision rendered.

The following history of the 4th REGIMENT, CENTRAL DIVISION, ARMY OF THE AGNO, is hereby published for the information of all concerned:

INTRODUCTION

As long as the bloods of Lakandula, Laru-laru, Luna and Bonifacio still runs the blood vessels of some Filipinos, one would not be surprised in times of stress and strain to find heroes in every corners of the Philippines.

Mindful of the many danger that lurked where Japanese were found, many brave Filipinos dared to fight them openly or in the night, risking not only their very lives, but also the lives of their closed relatives and friends. Their activities against the enemy consist of espionage, sabotage, preservation of peace and order among their people and above all keeping alive in their hearts the ember of faith in America's return, thereby loyalty to the Philippine Commonwealth and to the United States of America.

ORIGIN AND ORGANIZATION

The went-up feeling of hatred against the Japanese and its allies by the Filipinos culminated after hearing of the treacherous attack of Pearl Harbor on December, 1941. Not willing to be caught unaware by the treacherous enemies and conscious of the possible landing of the American Forces in Luzon, Lieutenant Colonel Dominador B. Ruiz, then Captain, who is imbued with loyal spirit to the mother country and with strong and dynamic patriotism immediately organized his Guerrilla Organiza-

tion, a body of brave and loyal Filipinos whose purpose was to help resist the enemy and also help fellow civilians in their sad plight, specially the children, women and the weaks during the evacuation.

The Japs spies pointed him as leader of the resistant movement, So he had to go to the central part of Pangasinan to hide. It was then that he came in contact with one Maximo Garcia in the barrio of Goliman, Malasiqui, who told him that the owners of the land his father is acting as encargada is a member of the resistant movement. He is Hon. Teodoro Y. Gomez, one time a Representative from the 3rd Representative District of Pangasinan, and also Mayor Angel L. Macaraeg of Malasiqui. He at once decided to see either of these two and so he joined Maximo Garcia on his way to the poblacion of Malasiqui at night to see Hon. Teodoro Y. Gomez because Mayor Angel L. Macaraeg could not be located in town.

It was there that he learned that Hon. Teodoro Y. Gomez was already a guerrilla leader since the 8th of that month (January). It was Hon. Teodoro Y. Gomez who verified the existence of a guerrilla leader who had been authorized to commissioned leaders of the resistant movement by General Douglas MacArthur, to organize guerrilla outfit. With these news civilian Dominador B. Ruiz went to Camp Douglas MacArthur and presented himself to Captain Miguel R. Acosta, commissioned guerrilla leader for the Agno Valley. He was appointed organizer and leader of the central and western Pangasinan with the rank of Captain. Before he left for his district

Captain Ruiz received further instructions from the authorized guerrilla leader regarding the organization of his own guerrilla outfit. It was he, himself, who gave the instructions that no officer could be given a rank higher than a Captain.

EARLY ACTIVITIES

The early days were hard and dangerous. The provinces were thick with spies, moreover, the guerrilla leader observed that the people were beginning to lose hope after promised help of America. But nothing daunted, he proceeded to organized his guerrilla organization. With a few devoted followers, he met Brigadier General Miguel R. Acosta, then Captain, who encouraged him to continue on his espionage work and further encouraged him to convince more followers to the underground works. Soon after the departure of Captain Acosta, Captain Ruiz met civilian Bartolome Tarectecan, who promised to work with him in his espionage and underground works. Under authority of Captain Acosta, Captain Ruiz commissioned Bartolome Tarectecan, Mauro Muñoz, Quintin de Vera, Faustino Junio, Ernesto Sison, etc. all as First Lieutenants. By his untiring efforts and unexcelled eloquence, by his ceaseless campaign for the preservation of peace and order in an otherwise lawless peace, he won the confidence of the people.

His first men and loyal followers were farmers-barric people who had very little, if any, education at all. This simple, hardworking people know very little about international politics, it is true. They did not know why the Japanese invaded their land. It was enough that

the Japanese were here - fierce, insulting, cruel and intolerant. And so what ever these people had, they shared with the guerrillas. What every thing was to be accomplished they gladly help.

The men were scattered among the twons - Bayambang, Malasiqui, Alcala, Bautista and San Carlos. He had officers and operatives in all these towns, but he keep his headquarter at Lareglareg, Malasiqui. Notable among these supporters were: Lieuts. Bartolome Tarectecan, Dionisio Ermitaño, Damaso Bongar, Mauro Muñoz, Arnolfo Acosta, Domingo Peralta, etc. But they were not alone in helping. Besides aiding him in hiding and operating, even actually becoming members of his guerrilla organization, the following were liberal contributor to the cause: Sergeants Maximo Garcia, Mariano Bautista, Alvero and Lieut. Teodoro Gomez Jr.

In March, the Japanese comprising of about 30 guided by spy, Federick Scotch, surrounded the headquarter of Mayor Angel L. Macaraeg, then Captain of his guerrilla organization in the barrio of Banaoang and the Japanese captured firearms and ammunitions. Our intelligence officers failed to spy on the capture of Captain Macaraeg at his headquarter.

On the latter part of June, another group of representatives were send to contact Captain Miguel R. Acosta and submit the rooster of our organization. After the tragic fall of Bataan and then that of Corregidor and in the early part of July 1942, when the Japanese were just beginning their occupation of the Islands, and as a result of the conference with Captain Acosta, the local

organization was converted into a part of the detachment of the Army of the Agno.

On July 4th, 1942, when Mayor Angel L. Macaraeg, then Captain of his own guerrilla organization, celebrated the Independence Day at Lareglareg, Malasiqui. Sergeant Maximo Garcia introduced to me Mayor Macaraeg. The two Captains planned to combine their forces for a better protection of their organizations. Unfortunately, four trucks of Japanese Soldiers surrounded the barrio market of Lareglareg, where the celebration was being held. As a result, Mariano Bautista, Rosendo Mamaril, etc. who were in charged of the firearms and munitions were captured and taken to Binalonan Japanese garrison.

On the latter part of July, Sergeant Maximo Garcia and Lieuts. Teodoro Gomez Jr. and Arnolfo Acosta, were directed to spy on the Japanese and to notify our headquarter to be on the lookout for the Japanese who were searching the houses of Lareglareg. Several Filipinos were captured and manhandled and other resorts of inhuman tortures, they were at last released.

On the latter part of August, 1942, Captain Ruiz, Lieuts. Mauro Mufios, Bartolome Tarectecan, Dionisio Ermitaño, Teodoro Gomez Jr. and Sergeant Maximo Garcia met Major Miguel R. Acosta for a conference. In the conference, Major Acosta reiterated his plea for the formation of a bigger guerrilla units, systematic and armed resistance and non-cooperative, etc. against the enemy.

On October 26, 1942, a big conference of all officers

of the guerrilla units of Major Angel L. Macaraeg and Major Ruiz to take up the advise and suggestions of Lieut. Col. Miguel R. Acosta. About mid-night after the conference, the Japanese Military Police of Dagupan, Pangasinan captured Lieut. Anselmo Manaigan, one of the officers of Major Macaraeg. We had just adjourned our conference when the Japanese Military Police captured Lieut. Manaigan.

About the early part of December 1942, due to the fact, the members of the guerrilla organization of Lieut. Col. Angel L. Macaraeg was big enough to compose a regiment, his two batalions were transfered under the command of Lieut. Col. Dominador B. Ruiz. Thus the guerrilla organization of Lieut. Col. Ruiz together with the two Batalion transfered from Lieut. Col. Macaraeg, formed the 4th Regiment of the Central Division, Army of the Agno. Upon this arrangement, Brigadier General Miguel R. Acosta, on 24 December 1942, promoted Major Ruiz to the rank of Lieut. Colonel. Upon assuming the command of the 4th regiment, Central Division, Army of the Agno, the following batalions composed the said 4th Regiment, Central Division, Army of the Agno:

The detachment after its creation, like other units

began to operate and under measures intended to obstruct and at the same time prostrate Japanese occupation of the islands. It had done espionage work, sabotage and at appropriate times engaged Japanese soldiers in minor sporadic skirmishes. People were advised not to give food, not to extend help and never to cooperate with the Japanese.

The regiment was beginning to be known by the public as a tangible force for good - but otherwise for the Japanese. And the Japanese, incensed at the boldness of some of the men who would enter Jap garrisons in their rabid search for firearms, evolved a systematized way of rooting out our guerrillas. They concentrate a Jap force at a certain locality, assemble all civilians, and detain, often times maltreat them for days without food and water unless they give information concerning guerrillas. This was about the early part of the year 1944. For months they did this in central and western Pangasinan so that for their safety of his men and to lessen the troubles of the civilians, the commanding officer ordered cessation of all operations. The men were told to disperse. Lieut. Col. Ruiz, himself, had to hide. In caves of the Agno River bank, in cornfields, in sugarcane fields, coconut groves and bamboo thickets, he had to hide and so rigid was the Japanese mapping out that if not for the constant alertness of his faithful non-commissioned officer, Sergeant Maximom Garcia, he would have been captured. Sergeant Garcia, informed the headquarter of the guerrilla units of former representative Hon. Teodoro Y. Gomez that Lieut. Col. Ruiz, the commanding officer of his outfit need some supplies because he was cut

OFF from his supply officer. Upon hearing this story, lady Lieut. Elisa G. Macaraeg, who have evacuated near the headquarter of Lieut. Col. Teodoro Y. Gomez, offered to give aid to the isolated commander. Especially the isolated commander was not new to the lady officer but had met him perhaps way back last 1940. With sergeant Garcia, lady Lieut. Elisa G. Macaraeg together with the supply officer of Lieut. Col. Gomez, delivered the needed supply for Lieut. Col. Ruiz. This saved Lieut. Col. Ruiz from starvation.

For almost a year, the Japs were vigilant and watchful. Patrols were sent to the barrios everyday. But little by little as the guerrillas kept low, their vigilance relaxed. Then on the latter part of the year, operations were resumed. Once more guerrillas roamed at night, looking for arms; investigating crimes, doing intelligence works, striking at straggling Jap columns when they came out. A Jap soldier going on a foraging expedition may fail to return; even Jap sentinels would disappear; and bodies - Jap bodies would be found floating in the river. It is no wonder that people still kept faith in America.

BEFORE THE LANDING

Our Liason Officer, Major *Biancaido*. Macaraeg, informed the headquarter that the day of liberation was approaching. This information was taken from a radio set he is keeping in an underground compartment of his house. The Japs were not able to detect the operation of this radio in his house. upon this information, the commander decided on a general program of training, so on the second week of December 1944, he directed Major Juanito L.P. Gomez, Ex-Bataan officer, to establish a training camp. The training called Camp Palaris, was established at Lareglareg, Mala-

siqui, Pangasinan. There were many problems to be met. Training had to be carried on under cover, so a system of guard was devised, the job falling into the hand of the Regimental Staff. It was conducted in such a manner that no body could have reached within a kilometer to the camp without being noticed. All problems were discussed and all trainees were satisfied.

A new year arrived and vague rumors began to circulate of the American landing. Leaflets from low-flying planes were found warning people to keep away from roads and encampments. Realizing that the time for concerted action against the Japs had come, the CO ordered the transfer of the Regimental HQ to a place near the bank of the Payas de Americano.

When the American Liberation Forces landed at Lingayen and Dagupan, representatives of our Army met them. At the same time our intelligence men were sent out to keep watch on enemy movements. Members of pioneer platoons were sent to guard bridges from being destroyed by the enemy so movements of the landing troops could be facilitated, and to locate possible fords at the Agno River so that crossing will not be delayed. Raiding parties were sent to the roads at night of the seventh of January, 1945 when the coast towns were being bombed and strafed. Planes also bombing and strafing the Japs garrisons at Carmen just three kilometers away. And each detonation of an exploding bomb would cause the men to cheer and wave hands at the diving planes.


The first American Unit that reached Malasiqui

was met by our men with the band of musicians. We all rejoiced over the coming of the Liberation Forces. On many occasions the Malasiqui detachment made reports to the Americans with the guide and help of our men regarding the Japs hiding in the fastness of CABARUAN HILLS, LAREG-LAREG, etc. In some occasions our men engaged some stragglers and captured most of them alive and turned them over to the American Forces. At one time the head of a Japanese was taken to the town and presented to the proper authorities.

Such is the history of the 4th REGIMENT, CENTRAL DIVISION, ARMY OF THE AGNO. The 4th Regiment was greatly handicapped by the insufficiency of firearms, munitions and other insurmountable difficulties, they were imbued with the true spirit of nationalism, patriotism and inspired by the unfailing help of American Liberation Forces. They were ready to shoulder the responsibilities of their duties and to shed their blood and to die with the American friends that God send as Liberators and Saviour of our land.

Thus it is that the men of the 4th Regiment will still remember him when the days of war are over. And when the unit shall have been processed and wherever shall happen to it afterwards, the motto of the 4th Regiment, is to cherish to live up to. They have their faith; they have done their best.


