The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Victorias Legion, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

a set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General Recartbur during the Hieration of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the Procord of this unit. After carrful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned belows

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. Adequate records were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
- e. Sphere of operations and unit strength claimed by the unit were not commensurate with the nature of the terrain, limitation of communication facilities, and the degree of anti-resistance activities of the Japanese in the area during the period concerned.
- f. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of acti-
 - It is desired to emphasize that each claimant member of

the unit is considered to have hed just and adequate appearant for recognition when his services were evaluated concurrently with this study of the unit with which he claims membership.
