SUBJECT: Confirmation of Ranks in Corrected Roster
of Rizal Guerrilla Group Hqs., Request for

TO : Commanding General, AFWESPAC, APO 707

THRU : Channels

1. Request that the ranks of Officers and EMs appearing in the corrected roster of the Rizal Guerrilla Group Hqs. (R.G.G.), which was approved by Hq: 11th Corps, 6th Army be confirmed for the following reasons:

a. Upon consultation with the Returns Division of the Adjutant's General Office of the Philippine Army, it was found out that they have on file two different rosters of R.G.G. which were both approved by Hq: 6th Army. The original roster is composed of 22 officers and EMs only while the corrected roster, copy of which is herewith attached, is composed of 63 officers and EMs. It will be noted that the attached roster was approved by Major Burkett P. Anderson, AUS, and was made the basis of payment by Lt. Mascardo, PA.

b. Paragraph 1d of Hq: Phil. Army Circular No. 128, dated June 20, 1946, states that in cases where there are two recognitions for the same roster, the earlier roster will be considered, unless AFWESPAC confirms the later roster.

c. It must be recalled that when the then Captain George Miller, AUS, organized the Special Intelligence Section of the 6th Army, which composed of officers and EMs picked from the Markings, Hunters, and Chinese Guerrillas, he lowered their ranks one grade below their authorized guerrilla ranks because the Special Intelligence Section which was later known as the R.G.G. had only then under its overall command one regiment of the Markings Guerrillas, one battalion of the Hunters-ROTC Guerrillas, and one Company of the Chinese Volunteers. After a few months, however, a need for more guerrillas to support U.S. Army operations was felt and by command of Major General Wing, CG of the 43rd Division to which the R.G.G. was then attached, additional guerrilla units were incorporated under the overall command of the R.G.G. In view of this increase to more than double its original strength, R.G.G. expanded its personnel and the ranks of its officers and men were returned to their authorized guerrilla ranks to conform with the authorized Table of Organization. A corrected roster carrying these authorized ranks and additional personnel was then submitted to and approved by Hq: 11th Corps through a directive signed by Major Reither, Guerrilla Affairs Officer.

d. On this authority the personnel of the R.G.G. were paid their salaries corresponding to their respective ranks appearing in the roster as corrected.

e. Upon the termination of its functions, its personnel were served with a Disposition Order from the 38th Division, to report for processing at Camp Murphy, P.A. and it is worthy to note that they were processed according to their ranks in the corrected roster.

f. If the original roster will be made the basis for confirmation of their ranks, many officers and EMs would be forfeited their recognition as their names appear in the corrected roster only.

g. In one particular instance, Lt. Col. Montano D. Nazario, Chief of Staff of the R.G.G., recently got a confirmation of his rank based on the corrected roster, as per AFWESPAC Letter GSCPC-201, dated 28 December 1945, signed by Lt. John D. Grimes, Asst. Adj. Gen.

2. Records of the R.G.G., including the official rosters signed by the American COs and the authority for such, are believed to be with the 38th Division, AUS, to which it was last attached.

3. In view of the foregoing, the officers and EMs who formed the R.G.G., whose papers are now pending action by the Recovered Personnel Division for lack of verification on their status, respectfully request a confirmation of their ranks appearing in the corrected roster, as soon as possible.

1. Undersigned officer is listed with rank of major in roster of Rizal Guerrilla Group on file with the PA. This rank, however, is incorrect, as undersigned had rank of Lt.-Col.
2. Possible explanation for above:
It is true that first roster of Rizal Guerrilla Group as submitted to 6th Army listed undersigned with rank of major. However, this first roster was later revised and corrected, and in this revised roster, undersigned appears with rank of Lt.-Col. Apparently, roster now on file with PA was the first and unrevised roster sent to the 6th Army.
3. Inquiries made by undersigned at AFPAC and AFMESPAC elicited the information that neither are keeping copies of rosters of approved and recognized guerrilla units.
4. Enclosed is copy of a special order issued on the field by the 43rd Div., USA, showing the transfer of undersigned as LT.-COL. to Marking Pay Regt.
5. All other officers and ENs of Rizal Guerrilla Group have been processed into the PA with their respective ranks as per the revised and corrected roster of that unit. Furthermore, undersigned officer has been paid his monthly salary as Lt.-Col., with the approval of the 6th and 8th Armies since his nit started to receive compensation from the PA.
