Dear Mr. Villafior:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Non Christian Tribes Ibalas Unit, Church of the Philippines, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders, because the commanding officer joined another unit.
- e. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.
- f. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

1. The Non Christian Tribes Ibalao Unit, Church of the Philippines consisting of 30 men, has not been favorably considered. Only the Commanding Officer has previously been recognized.
2. This unit does not fulfill the requirements of the five basic points for recognition. See attached team leader's report.
3. No useful purpose will be accomplished by further investigation of this unit.
4. The worthy members have been recognized and no casualty roster was submitted.

Report on Non Christian Tribes
Ibalao Unit

1. Lt E. Sta. Romana on 10 February 1947, examined the unit file of Non Christian Tribes, Ibalao Unit.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (No attached unit History)

3. FINDINGS:

a. No field investigation was deemed necessary after careful examination of the attached unit file.

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. After careful consideration of all documentary evidence in the unit file, it is concluded that this unit did not exist as a guerrilla organization during the Japanese occupation. The documentary evidence on file with this unit were appointment of V. Villafior as Sgt of Police of the Non Christian Tribes Organization, dated 22 Feb 1936, signed by Secretary to the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines an appointment signed by the Provincial Governor of Nueva Ecija in 1936, and induction into the Non Christian Tribes signed by Bishop Sam Brown of the Non Christian Tribes. During the Japanese occupation the Commanding Officer, Villafior, received authority from the Commanding Officer of Squadron 303 to collect rice from the civilians for the use of Squadron 303. Villafior was inducted early in 1942 into Squadron 303 and was recognized as Sergeant with that unit. This indicates just acknowledgement of his military services rendered.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. In the unit file there was no evidence that the unit actively opposed the enemy. They were in no sense a guerrilla organization.

d. Activities of this unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. Claims submitted were for helping the guerrillas by giving rice, maintaining peace and order and protecting themselves from the lawless elements. The Commanding Officer of this unit was attached to Squadron 303 from 1942 up to the liberation. The 29 men were left in town to continue their normal duties for the Non Christian Tribes. This indicates that the Non Christian Tribes, Ibalao Unit, was not a guerrilla unit. The activities of this unit were individual, and not those of an organization.

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders. The duties performed by the 29 men under the Non Christian Tribes were voluntary and for the interest of the Non Christian Tribes only. The Commanding Officer left the organization early in 1942, and joined Squadron 303.

f. The unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. No evidence was submitted to support claims of guerrilla activities.

g. Members of this unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations. The members apparently lived in their homes and engaged in Non Christian Tribes activities within the town and the surrounding Barrios.

h. It is noted that V. Villaflore uses his appointment by the Secretary of Nueva Ecija and his induction into Non Christian Tribes by Sam Brown, Bishop of the organization, to request recognition of this unit.

i. No useful purpose will be accomplished by further investigation of this unit. There are no members worthy of recognition and no evidence was submitted to support the claims of those 15 casualties alleged to have been sustained by this unit.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the Non Christian Tribes Ibalao Unit be not considered for recognition.

This press release was given wide newspaper circulation as well as being broadcasted over local radio stations.

Your request for recognition of Non-Christian Tribes Guerrilla Ibilao Unit was received at this headquarters 15 April 1946 and does not meet deadline referred to in paragraph 2, above.

It is considered generally that all concerned have had ample opportunity to prepare applications for recognition. In the opinion of this headquarters, an extension of the time limit mentioned above is not justified in your case and therefore is not favorably considered.
