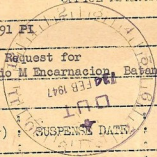

SUBJECT: Non-recognition of Guerrilla Unit

TO : Chief of Staff, Army of the Philippines, Camp Murphy,  
Cusson City

TO : 1st Lt Antonio M. Encarnacion, Batangas Province (NFC)

1. The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the 4th Battalion, Golden Regt. Blue Eagle Brigade, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

2. A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. A definite organization was not established.
- e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders, because of desertion of personnel to join other units.
- f. Sphere of operations and unit strength claimed by the unit were not commensurate with the nature of the terrain, limitation of communication facilities, and the degree of anti-resistance activities of the Japanese in the area during the period concerned.

g. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.

h. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.

i. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.

3. It is requested that you comply with the provision of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 Sept 1945, copy attached.

Report on "4th Battalion, Golden Regiment, Blue Eagle Brigade"

1. Major Vincent K. Coates and 1st Lt. George E. Kemper proceeded to Calaca, Balayan and Nasugbu, Batangas, on 21 January 1947, to investigate the 4th Battalion, Golden Regiment, Blue Eagle Brigade.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached unit file)

3. FINDINGS:

a. The following persons were interviewed and their statements are reflected in the findings.

Lt Col Eduardo C Villadolid -----	CO Golden Regiment
Col Mariano H. Cabarrubia -----	CO Rainbow Regiment, Blue Eagle Brigade
Col Quintin Gellidon -----	Formerly Deputy in charge of Guerrillas attached to 11th ABD.
Lt Col Jose Razon -----	Formerly labor contractor for 11th Air-Borne division
Lt Col George O. Pearson -----	Exec. and later CO of 187 P.G. Inf., 11th ABD
Juan Chiudian -----	Citizen of Manila, former resident of Nasugbu
Luis Licopa -----	CO Licopa Unit
Lazaro Malabanan -----	Executive Off, Gagalac Unit

b. The record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. Records during the period of occupation are non-existent.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy, because it was a reserve unit of the Golden Regiment and was not used except for labor work. When the American Army landed at Nasugbu, the men of this unit were among those used to unload the ships. For this labor they received pay and rations.

d. A definite organization was not established by this unit because it existed principally as a paper unit and engaged in very few homeguard activities at the most. Members of this unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian and family obligations. Those who deserved recognition joined other units and were recognized with them. The remainder stayed home and a few of these contributed small bits of intelligence information.

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its commanding officer, because some claimed members of this unit joined other units during the liberation. The leader admits this and also admits that some of these men were recognized in other units.

f. The unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization, because the leader states in his history that the unit had no arms and could not act as a whole unit. Other guerrilla leaders who operated in the same area knew of no activities of this unit.

g. Eduardo C. Villadolid, Commanding Officer of the Golden Regiment, says that this was a reserve unit that was not used by his organization.

h. Colonel Gellidon, Lt Colonel Pearson and other officers in charge of Guerrilla units under the 11th ABD say that this unit was not active.

i. No useful purpose will be served by further investigation of this unit.

j. No roster nor evidence was submitted with the request for recognition.

k. All worthy members of the Golden Regiment have been recognized.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the 4th Battalion, Golden Regiment, Blue Eagle Brigade be not favorably considered for recognition.

SUBJECT: Request for Recognition and Processing of Guerilla Unit.

TO: Commanding General, Headquarters, AFWESPAC, APO 707.

1. In view of the latest news from our headquarters in Nasugbu regarding the recognition of the unit of the Golden Regiment under the command of Lt. Col. EDUARDO C. VILLADOLID, request that a part of this unit (4th Bn, Golden Regiment, Calaca, Batangas) now considered as Reserve, be recognized and processed in the Philippine Army.

2. Attached herewith is the history of the organization. Roster on the time it was made part of the Golden Regiment was submitted to UTG by Lt. Col. EDUARDO C. VILLADOLID.

3. While other units of Batangas which are now processed in the Philippine Army are enjoying the privileges given by the Army, I ask that justice be granted this unit in as much as this unit can claim to have made what other guerilla units have done since its organization in 1943. I can point out units whose organization began only during the American liberation already, yet they are now processed in the Philippine Army. These units haven't risked their lives during the time when Japanese Military Police are questioning every movement of our members. The procedure of recognition and processing it seems, is based on how near the leader of the unit is to some people's graces. If this will be the procedure of recognition, then, I am in the position to believe that injustice is being tolerated in our Army today which was established on the principle of democracy and to save democracy.

4. Request further that your office investigate the facts surrounding the case of this guerilla outfit that seems to have been forgotten.

HISTORY OF THE 4th BATTALION GOLDEN REGIMENT

On 1st November 1943, late Lt. JORGE ESPINA (killed by the Japs) with late Lt. MARCIANO EVANGELISTA and Mr. NANY REYES, all of Batangas, Batangas, at about 11:00 P.M., contacted Lt. ANTONIO M. ENCARNACION in Calaca, Batangas. The men being all ex-USAFFE Officers except the latter, were on a guerilla mission, they being connected with Lt. Col. STRANGN's guerilla forces in Sierra Madre. After brief explanation of the mission, Lt. ANTONIO M. ENCARNACION was made to understand that guerilla forces were to be organized in the Province under the leadership of Lt. ESPINA. It was understood that every thing was to be kept secret.

On 23 November 1943, an organization known to be Fil-American Irregular Forces gave birth in Calaca, Batangas, under the command of Lt. ANTONIO M. ENCARNACION with Lt. OLIGARIO DE JOYA, Lt. GODOFREDO ESPINOZA (deceased, shot by Japanese on 11 February 1945), and others. Under the very noses of Japanese civilians as well as Japanese Military Police, the organization began its secret mission of organizing the men of Calaca into a real combat team minus the arms which were badly needed that time, although it was dangerous to have one. Plans were made and men were given assignments.

On 24 December 1943, contacts were made to all units from <sup>4</sup>emery, Batangas, to Nasugbu, Batangas. Different leaders were selected and designated commanding officers of the different units in the different towns.

On or about 15 June 1944, an intelligence group was organized under Sgt. JOSE MERCADO, the mission of which was to furnish information about the currency in Calaca. This information was turned over to Lt. ESPINA in Batangas, Batangas.

On or about 30 January 1944, Lt. Col. DOMINGO V. BAKILAR, known contact man from the McKinley Brigade, came to Calaca and made contact with our unit. Believing that the mission of this man was the same as ours, we made a connection with him. Rosters were prepared by us for higher headquarters to know who were we and what we were. With this connection being made, weekly contact with Lt. Col. STRANGN was made through courier furnished by this organization. Expenses were incurred.

When the Japanese made a final drive against guerillas in the later part of March 1944 against our unit in Calaca, there were a few who suffered death in the hands of the Japanese Military Police. Until now, none was known as to what had become of them. Lt. ANTONIO M. ENCARNACION then in command of the ~~Fil-American~~ Irregular Troops in Calaca was brought to the Japanese garrison in Nasugbu Central. Fortunately he was not killed. Japanese spies became so active in Calaca that the men had to travel by night; the officers and men had to have conferences in the mountains; women had to act as guards and couriers had to be suicide men to carry rosters and information about the enemy. All this, our organization had gone thru.

On or about 15 April 1944, Major RAMSEY (US Army) with one other American EM from the Central Luzon Guerilla Forces, went to our place seeking help as to how to go to Mindoro. It was this unit that made possible their safe transportation to the island of Mindoro, with risk of life. On the return of Major RAMSEY from Mindoro, it was also this unit which made possible his return to Central Luzon. Lt. BAYANI S. ESGUERRA, PA, a companion of Major RAMSEY in his work made contact with our unit knowing fully well how this unit helps Americans go to Mindoro.

It was also about this time that Lt. ESPINA and Lt. EVANGELISTA with the rest of the officers and men of the Batangas Irregular Troops died in the hands of the Japanese Military Police. Nothing was heard of them. The guerilla forces under our organization was left without any higher headquarters, nevertheless, the organization labored day and night under the life risk to function as a guerilla unit. The organization depended upon the McKinley Brigade of the ~~Fil-American~~ Irregular Troops for morale support. Finally, units of different guerilla outfits came to our organization to ask us for information regarding enemies in our sector. Our unit was just too willing to give out information about the enemy.

Under directions of Lt. ANTONIO M. ENCARNACION, with the rest of the staff we made our way thru until 31 January 1945. This was the only time that our organization came into the open.

Japanese telephone wires were cut down under the orders of Major NANDERPOOL (Guerilla Liaison Officer). Encounters with the enemy were made.

On 3 February 1945, our unit encountered the enemy in Calaca. Although we suffered some casualties (Sgt. JULIAN FANGANIBAN, deceased) we were able to drive the enemy away from our sector.

Contact with the landing party (American) was made prior to this event. In this contact, this organization of ours in Calaca was made part of the Golden Regiment, being made the 4th Battalion. This transfer

of unit was made with the intention of giving a more coordinated command in as much as Lemery, a nearby town of Calaca, belonging to the same division. Beginning 1 February 1945, this organization took commands from Lt. Col. EDUARDO C. VILLADOLID, then Regimental Commander of the Golden Regiment.

On 10 February 1945, the organization suffered a set back. With barely enough arms, the organization was not able to hold the drive of about 500 Japanese soldiers against the town of Calaca. Staying in the nearby barrios, the organization continued to fight Japanese patrols most of the time.

In the mopping up operation in the barrios of Lemery, a platoon of armed men from our unit joined the combat team of the Lemery unit on or about 15 February 1945.

Although this organization cannot act as a whole unit, men of this unit in a way or another tried to harrass the enemy. It was also this unit that made possible the evacuation of civilians in Calaca, which would have caused massacre in this town. Although there were some people killed, it was entirely not their fault. Most of these people killed in Calaca were members of our organization doing secret mission for the American forces which were about to push the drive to our town.

On 6 March 1945, with all armed men in our organization and units of Balayan and Tuy and the American unit, the town of Calaca was liberated after a minor encounter with the Japanese.

Our organization though unarmed tried its best to help in the fight against the Japanese. When guerilla units were attached to the American combat units, men of our organization volunteered their services. Most of those people are now processed in the Philippine Army, but not under our organization.

This organization is part of the Golden Regiment until this date. Roster and history records have been submitted to the Golden Regiment.
