1. The Albay-Sorsogon Intelligence Net was originally recognized by letter, Hq Sixth Army, dated 18 May 1945, subject: "Recognized Guerrilla Units", Supplement #3, in strength of 69 as of 17 January 1945.

2. Procedure employed in the reconstruction of roster for the Albay-Sorsogon Intelligence Net is as follows:

a. An exhaustive search for original or monthly rosters for the subject unit was made but failed to reveal any available rosters in the files at Guerrilla Affairs Division, Recovered Personnel Division and Hq National Defense Forces. However, a unit SO, dated 16 July 1945, consisting of 37 names was found in GAD files of the Bicol Guerrillas.

b. Names included in the above mentioned SO were carded, alphabetized, and checked against individual processing records at RPD to determine the unit of each individual and at Finance Service, HNDP, to determine pay status. Twenty five (25) of the thirty seven (37) individuals were found to have been paid for guerrilla service with the subject unit.

3. In view of the fact that twenty five (25) of a total of thirty seven (37) individuals on the SO show conclusive proof of membership, it is considered that all of the names appearing on the SO were those of members of the Albay-Sorsogon Intelligence Net.

4. It is recommended that the reconstructed roster of the Albay-Sorsogon Intelligence Net, consisting of thirty seven (37) names, be approved.

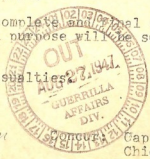

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Albay Sorsogon Intelligence Net, a guerrilla unit under your nominal control, recognized by letter Headquarters, ~~USAFPC~~, dated 17 January 1945, has not been favorably considered for revision of its present recognition date.

A careful analysis of all available information of the military activities of your unit from its inception, scrutinized in relation to the overall resistance movement, has failed to justify sufficiently the establishment of a date of recognition other than that presently published.

This letter constitutes the final determination of and action upon the period of official recognition of the Albay Sorsogon Intelligence Net.

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REVISION REPORT ON THE ALBAY SORSOGON
INTELLIGENCE NET

1. 2nd Lts Raul Diaz de Rivera and Bruce D Bromley Jr proceeded to Legaspi, Albay, to determine whether or not the Albay Sorsogon Intelligence Net warrants a revision of its present recognition date. This unit was recognized by letter, Headquarters, USAFFE, dtd 1 April 1945, through the recommendations of the 158th Regimental Combat Team. The effective date of recognition was 17 January 1945, with a strength of 69 members.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (for reference, see files pertaining to the Albay Regiment and the Escudero Unit)

3. FINDINGS:

a. To clarify a somewhat confused situation, a resume of what has transpired before the Albay Sorsogon Intelligence Net was organized in January 1945, is presented:

In July 1944, Capt Jaime Frayna was sent by the then Maj Smith (Samar Command) to Sorsogon to establish a radio net under the supervision of Escudero. Frayna brought with him two radio sets and a net control station. This net control station (call letter: MAG) was under the control of Escudero. One of the radio sets was given to the Albay Regiment (Ante Group) which was then under Escudero's Command. This relay station (call letters: UBA) was operated by Crispin Ante and was responsible for relaying intelligence reports coming from Albay Province to the net control station in Sorsogon (UBA). In November 1944, the relay station of Ante was raided by the Japanese and silenced. A new relay station was subsequently established by Ante in Jovellar, Albay. The extent of the intelligence reports sent to Sorsogon through this station is unknown, but thought to be negligible. In Jan 1945, Lt Col Smith authorized Maj Sabarre (CO of the Albay Sorsogon Intelligence Net) to re-establish his (Smith's) intelligence net in the Bicol Area. Maj Sabarre then took over the radio station in Jovellar which subsequently became his net control station. This intelligence net was composed of members from different guerrilla organizations in Albay and Sorsogon Provinces. This unit was recognized on the strength of the recommendations of Lt Nellist, of the Alamo Scouts, Sixth Army, submitted to the 158th RCT.

b. This intelligence net was effected by a courier system. Intelligence operatives were dispatched to various units to gather and evaluate reports. These reports, in turn, were relayed to the net control station and eventually found themselves in either Smith's Headquarters in Samar or the Sixth Army Hqs in Leyte and later in Pangasinan.

c. It could be stated with certainty that, after a study of the activities of the unit, all alleged activities

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which cover all the requirements of the five basic points for recognition were accomplished during the Liberation. It is believed that sufficient recognition has been accorded the unit.

d. The unit alleges that it aided in the consolidation of vital enemy information re enemy ground movement, garisons, supply and ammunition depots, gun emplacements, etc., with the intelligence unit of the Alamo Scouts, Sixth Army. They helped in plotting outlay maps drawn to scale, and pin pointing of enemy military objectives, resulting in the bombing of same.

e. These intelligence reports sent by radio seem good, although their reliability is questioned. In general it was found that reports on the presence of the enemy in a given area were correct as to location, however the numbers involved were invariably inaccurate; mostly grossly exaggerated, and a few cases, minimized. They further claim that upon submission of the reports, US planes were dispatched within a day to a week for bombing the designated enemy installations.

f. The undersigned does not question their claims, although there is a possibility that not all reports sent by them, and the resulting destruction of enemy installations, could be solely credited to the unit. The fact remains that the unit did not exist prior to 17 Jan 1945 (recognition date), and all activities of the unit occurred during this period. (Liberation).

g. Conditions definitely do not exist which would warrant a revision of the present recognition date of the unit.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

The unit does not have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the Albay Sorsogon Intelligence Net, be not favorably considered for recognition.

The unit alleges that it aided in the consolidation of vital enemy information re enemy ground movement, garrisons, supply and ammunition depots, gun emplacements, etc., with the intelligence unit of the Alamo Scouts, Sixth Army. They helped in plotting outlay maps drawn to scale, and pin pointing of enemy military objectives, resulting in the bombing of same.

e. These intelligence reports sent by radio seem good, although their reliability is questioned. In general it was found that reports on the presence of the enemy in a given area were correct as to location, however the numbers involved were invariably inaccurate; mostly grossly exaggerated, and a few cases, minimized. They further claim that upon submission of the reports, US planes were dispatched within a day to a week for bombing the designated enemy installations.

f. The undersigned does not question their claims, although there is a possibility that not all reports sent by them, and the resulting destruction of enemy installations, could be solely credited to the unit. The fact remains that the unit did not exist prior to 17 Jan 1945 (recognition date), and all activities of the unit occurred during this period. (Liberation).


g. Conditions definitely do not exist which would warrant a revision of the present recognition date of the unit.


4. POLITICAL ASPECTS:

The unit does not have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the Alby Sorsogon Intelligence Net, be not favorably considered for recognition.
