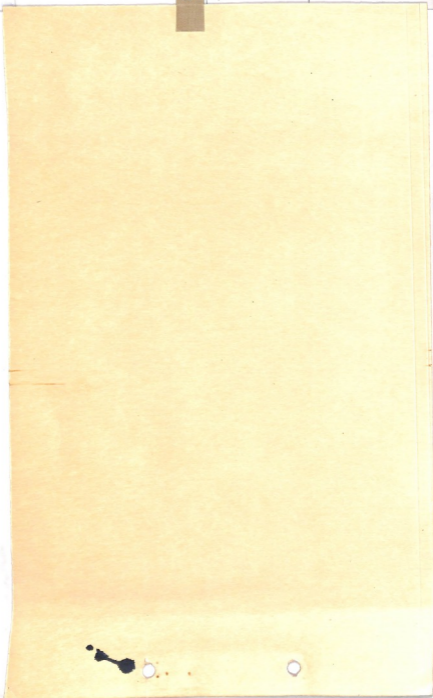

Dear Mr. Gallanoza:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Irosin Guerrilla Forces, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Adequate records of dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions and necessary related information were not maintained.
- d. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders because of desertion of personnel to join other units.
- e. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.

This decision on the proposed unit roster does not preclude submission for casualty recognition by those individuals who are qualified and feel justified in entering such claims. Upon request by interested individuals, appropriate forms will be forwarded.

1. Capt E. R. Curtis and 1st Lt. Charles L. Homewood on 26 March 1947, examined the unit file on Irosin Guerrilla Forces under the command of Maj Pedro H. Gallanoza.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: See attached unit file.

## 3. FINDINGS:

a. No field investigation was deemed necessary after careful examination of the unit file.

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. There are no records of this unit other than one roster which is undated.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy. This unit claims to have had active engagements with the Japanese but does not have any supporting evidence to substantiate their claims.

d. Adequate records were not maintained (dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information). None of the above listed information could be found in the unit file.

e. Performance of the unit did not indicate adequate control by its leaders because of desertion of personnel to join other units. The Commanding Officer states in the unit history that members of his unit had joined other units (Escudero and Lapus Units) and that most of his men were absorbed by those units.

f. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part-time basis only.

g. No useful purpose will be accomplished by further investigation of this unit. There are no members worthy of recognition and a separate casualty roster has been submitted.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the Irosin Guerrilla Forces be not favorably considered for recognition.

REPORT ON SORSOGON MISSION

Pursuant to Paragraph 1, Special Orders Number 107, Headquarters U. S. Army Training Group, AFPAAC, APO 500, dated 18 September 1945, the undersigned departed for Sorsogon, Sorsogon on 20 September 1945.

Governor Salvador Escudero, Provincial Governor of the Province of Sorsogon, was contacted on 29 September 1945. In a conference with Governor Escudero on that date the following information was obtained:

HISTORY

Salvador Escudero was Provincial Governor of the Province of Sorsogon when the Japanese invaded that area in December 1942. He evacuated the capital but did not relinquish control of the government. In July 1943 he was commissioned with the rank of Colonel by Colonel Hugh Straughn and designated as Regimental Commander for Sorsogon. In September 1943 he was designated by Colonel Straughn as Division Commander of the Bicol Region with specific instructions to organize the Fil-American Irregular Troops. The main body of the organization consisted of the Sorsogon Regiment with attached service units and two Albay Regiments in the Province of Albay. The latter were difficult to organize due to conflicting factions in that province.

During 1943 and the greater part of 1944 these guerrilla units remained inactive due to fear of Jap reprisals with which they could not cope because of the lack of sufficient arms and ammunition. In August 1943 they were directed to cease active resistance against the Japanese until further notice. During this period operations consisted mainly of intelligence reports submitted by radio and courier service to Major C. E. Smith on Samar. Copies of these intelligence reports are submitted herewith as part of this report as Inclosure 2.

Active operations against the enemy were resumed on 31 October 1944 and the greater part of the encounters with the Japanese occurred between January 1945 and March 1945. A map of the province of Sorsogon showing location and number of encounters with the Japanese in that area during this period is submitted herewith as Inclosure #3.

## ORGANIZATION

During the period of active resistance against the enemy the Sorsogon Regiment, consisted of approximately thirteen hundred (1300) men including three battalions of infantry and a special combat battalion. Initially the Regiment had approximately one hundred and twenty (120) rifles obtained partly from the Philippine Constabulary and partly from seizure from Japanese elements. The supply of ammunition for these weapons was limited. On 2 January 1945 one hundred and ten (110) Garands, over two hundred (200) Enfields, four (4) 81 mm mortars, nineteen (19) bazookas and two (2) machine guns were received together with sufficient quantities of ammunition from the US Sixth Army on Leyte. However a copy of Arms Inventory dated 6 April 1945, submitted herewith as Inclosure 5, indicates that on that date the Southern Bicol Area Command, of which the Sorsogon Regiment was part, had in its possession only two hundred and twenty (220) rifles of all types, if the arms inventory is correct. In any case, at no time were there more than approximately four hundred and fifty (450) rifles in the possession of the Sorsogon Regiment during the period of active resistance against the enemy. This was sufficient therefore for only four hundred and fifty (450) of the thirteen hundred (1300) men claimed to be in the Regiment. Of the remaining eight hundred and fifty (850) men it is claimed that approximately one hundred and thirty (130) men were engaged in demolition work. This would account for approximately seven hundred (700) men without arms at any one time. It is claimed that these men were kept in reserve and rotated approximately every two months so that over a period of time all of the members of the Regiment had carried arms.

In April 1945 a conference was held at Legaspi, Albay between guerrilla leaders, or their representatives, and representatives from the 158th Regimental Combat Team which had previously moved in to occupy the Bicol Area. The conference was held to further define areas of operations for guerrilla units and to activate one battalion of guerrillas into the Philippine Army. Personnel for this battalion was obtained on a selective basis, most of the selections being made by the then Colonel Escudero from among members of his Sorsogon Regiment. The unit thus formed is now known as the 1st Bicol Regiment, Philippine Army, located at Legaspi, Albay, and commanded by Major Fladio Isleta. At this same conference Colonel Escudero was given the opportunity of again becoming Provincial Governor of the province of Sorsogon which office he accepted and still holds.

The remaining members of the Sorsogon Regiment who were not admitted to the Philippine Army are now inactive and engaged in civilian occupation.

The two Albay Regiments did not actively engage in conflict with the enemy, having only one company active at any one time. The remainder was in reserve and existed only on

paper. A few of the members of these regiments have been recognized and are now in the Philippine Army.

Additional inclosures in this report consist of a brief history of the Bicol Division, (Inclosure 1), periodic rosters of the Bicol Division (Inclosure 4), Claim for Payment of Expenses incurred in Guerrilla Activities (Inclosure 6) and miscellaneous papers (Inclosure 7). All inclosures were obtained as the result of a second interview with Governor Escudero and part of his staff on 2 October 1945.

It is the desire of Governor Escudero to obtain recognition for the remainder of the guerrilla units formerly under his command for services rendered and, if necessary, to have them activated into the Philippine Army should they be needed.

Since all guerrilla units have been disbanded it was not possible to interview other guerrilla leaders, nor did any of them try to contact us.

#### CONCLUSIONS

Guerrilla activities in the way of intelligence reports were no doubt of value to American Forces before and during the campaign in the Bicol Region. However, active resistance against the enemy by guerrilla units, and the results obtained, does not indicate the engagement of thirteen hundred (1300) men all of whom could not fight at any one time due to lack of arms and ammunition. The greater part of the Porsogon Regiment was inactive during operations and existed only on paper despite the fact that all members may have been actively engaged in fighting at some time. It is claimed that all arms and ammunition belonging to disbanded guerrilla units have already been transferred to the 1st Bicol Regiment, Philippine Army, Legaspi, Albay.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

In view of the lack of additional evidence, opportunity having been offered by the undersigned to accept any evidence which might be submitted, it is recommended that no further action be taken toward recognition of guerrilla units in the Bicol Area.
