Dear Mr. Urrea:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the 17th Regiment, 15th Division (PQOG), purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition.

It is felt that the recognition extended to personnel of the PQOG General Headquarters and of the 2nd Infantry Regiment, President Quezon's Own Guerrillas (PQOG), a composite unit from the overall command, constitutes just and adequate acknowledgement of military service.

This decision does not preclude individual request for casualty recognition by injured personnel or their heirs. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.

PRESIDENT QUEZON'S OWN GUERRILLAS

" HISTORY OF THE UNIT "

Notwithstanding the advent of and the changes incurred upon the history of a country, it has been felt by my countrymen and myself the necessity to fight for a common cause. We, as loyal citizens and residing in a country which our own, decided, conceived and dedicated ourselves to fight for America and for the liberation of the oppressed Filipino people, though we are under the tyrannous rapacious rule of Japan.

Now came the time of enlightenment. It was on the first week of March, 1943, when a band of loyal and energetic men under the brilliant leadership of Vicente S. Umali (now the commanding General of the P.Q.O.G) came and asked, " What are you fighting for?" We answered, " FOR LIBERTY AND DOWNFALL OF THE ENEMY". "So, we are fighting for the same cause. We have got to go together," replied the leader. All these were greeted by a loud merriment and applause. " LONG LIVE THE P.Q.O.G. IN PEACE AND ETERNAL HAPPINESS".

Connected by the bond of this get-together, we joined the P.Q.O.G. with the intention to capture and demoralize the ever increasing number of Japanese soldiers - the most brutal among the Orientals.

Weeks and months passed and in the meantime we used every effort and talent in training ourselves in fighting the barbarous and ever-pretending liberators of the so-called Greater East Asia. But lo, came the trial for the cause we are fighting for. It was on the 20th day of June, 1943, when the combined Japanese and puppet constabulary forces attacked us right at the feet of Mt. Banahaw. We defended our camp with might and valor, with heroism on the extremes and with the impulse to check any other attempt of the enemy to bring forth disaster and death to my men. We were then lucky enough because the combined Japanese and Constabulary retreated after almost a day of heavy fighting. Some of my men cleared the trail where our enemies retreated and they found out that fifteen Japanese were killed.

My men disciplined and ever loyal to America and our Motherland connived and help Gen. Vicente S. Umali in the Battle of Kiling, Saryaya, Tayabas on August 23, 1943, where some of our brave and ever daring men died in action. It was after this battle that we grew more fierce and aroused to greater fury. We went back to our mountain camps. The unit spent most of their time to guerrilla instructions and rested in the jungles of Mt. Banahaw. During those days I ordered my men to work in the field to produce food for the coming season. They planted camotes and cassavas and after sometime the fruits of our labor relieved us from hunger and thirst.

By that time we were very busy in getting detachment contacts in the southern provinces of Luzon. From Tayabas we went to Masaya, Laguna to come in contact with Col. Avanceña. Luckily we met the Colonel. He approved Gen. Umali's instructions and thus our mission was successful. Gen. Umali got sick in Masaya so we got to have our headquarter in the said place. We stayed there for about three months with the convalescing General. As soon as Gen Viceante S. Umali recovered, another mishap befall us because on January 1st, 1944 a company of Japanese soldiers attacked us. Caught unaware, this surprise attack meant much on our part and so sad to be remembered because most of our comrades fell and never did wake. The memory of the said camp was to bitter for us to remember because upon our return to our mountain camps we heard of the news that one of our ablest captain (Tomas Ceroza) was caught by the Japanese. Since then, we never heard of him.

The years passed painstakingly. The new moon shone and set, then bid us goodbye. The time for lonesome months and years turned into moonlights when the real liberators of the oppressed recaptured our Nativeland. They were America's vigilant sons gaining foothold in the Far East that liberated the once and long lost territory--

ACCOMPLISHMENT OF PRESIDENT QUEZON'S OWN GUERILLAS
Rizal, Laguna.

PRESIDENT QUEZON'S OWN GUERILLAS(PQOG) was completely Organized last October 1st. 1943. From the complete Organization up to present time, said Organization has achieved ample accomplishments such as follows:

Every member was always ready to give aids and comforts to every member of the PQOG coming from other places and even to other members of any guerilla unit. The members were always on the alert for the coming of the Japs in the vicinity in order to avoid casualties among the guerillas and Civilians. This was accomplished by the members of the PQOG,

Each of the members as per instruction of the Highest Commanding Officer had kept the morale and faith of the civilians to the American Forces, up to date.

At the arrival of the American Forces in this Municipality of Rizal, Laguna, on or about the early part of the month of April, 1945, thru the initiation of some of the member with the civilians including the beautiful girls received the American Soldiers with joy and satisfaction. Girls threw flowers to the marching gallant Soldiers with loud cheers of " VICTORY ---THOUSAND THANKS TO OUR LIBERATORS".

After the Japanese Forces had been driven to the mountains by the American Forces, the Municipality of Rizal, Laguna, being located just at the foot of the mount San Cristobal which became the hiding places of the retreating Japanese soldiers, the lives of the inhabitants of this municipality became more dangerous for the massacre of the japs. Due to this situation , the members of the Organization had planned the ways and means of repelling every attempt of the enemy to enter populated places.

The members of the Organization were ordered by the Officer and with the help of the civilian^s guarded the vicinities of the town especially at night ready to warn the population in case of emergency. We were ordered and with the aid of the civilian^s made foxholes in every places which may the way of entry of the Japanese. There the guerillas and other civilians stayed the whole night ready to meet the comming enemies.

There were ten Japanese killed and one captured alive who was turned to the American Soldier since April 1945. This happened within the jurisdiction of Rizal, Laguna. This was accomplished by the members of the PQOG, members of the ROTU guerillas, Fil-American guerillas and other civilians. Two members of this Organization(PQOG) were killed by the Japanese up to date.
