Receipt is acknowledged of your letter, dated 11 February 1948, requesting confirmation of rank from second lieutenant to captain with the USAFIP NL, the revision of your period of official recognition to include your services with the Eastern Cagayan Guerrilla Force, and the recognition of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrilla Force.

Regarding your request for confirmation of rank from 2nd lieutenant to captain with the USAFIP NL, it is considered that your commanding officer assigned you the grade commensurate with the duties performed and in conformity with an appropriate U. S. Army table of organization. Reductions were not only necessary but unavoidable in the process of reorganizing guerrilla units for recognition.

With regard to the claim for recognition of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrilla Force, it is desired to inform you that this unit was not favorably considered by this headquarters on 22 March 1948. It is necessary to emphasize that you received just and adequate consideration for recognition with this unit when your services were evaluated concurrently with the study of the unit as a whole. It is suggested that you communicate with Captain Cecilio R. Penafior, in care of the Adjutant General, Armed Forces of the Philippines, Camp Murphy, Quezon City, for any further information you may desire regarding the final action taken by this headquarters on this unit.

Subject: CONFIRMATION OF GUERRILLA RANKS

To : Director, Guerrilla Affair Division, G-3
Headquarters, Philrycom, APO 707

1. Request the consideration and confirmation of my guerrilla rank from 2nd lieutenant to 1st lieutenant thence to captain, for the following reasons:

a. That I have been a bonafide 2nd lieutenant, USAFFE when I was inducted into the Army of the United States on 18 July 1942. I am a 2nd Lieutenant until now.

b. That I have served in key positions as Provost Marshall and Chief Intelligence Officer in the field in the 14th Infantry AUS under Lt Col Guillermo Nakar, for the duration of its operation as a unit.

c. That I have always actively participated in the resistance movement as evidenced by the service pistol cal.45 (pre war issue) which I have always had and used against the enemy from time to time. It was never surrendered to the enemy inspite of repeated investigation and grilling made to me. Possessing a firearm in those days of occupation meant only one or two things - hostility; and death to those possessing them.

d. That I have always been loyal to the cause and never served in any capacity under the Japanese or the Japanese puppet government.

e. That I with Captain Cecilio R Penaflores Lt Pagalilauan organized the Suicide Bn which openly operated as a unit on or before September 1, 1944.

f. That I was assigned as Company Commander, "A" Company, Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas, and besides my other duties, was second in command and an S-3 of the Bn Staff, from its reprocessing and reorganization on 15 September 1944 up to and including its incorporation into the USAFIP NL on 28 April 1945. See exhibit "E" (Par. 2-a, GO # 33 USAFIP NL dated April 1945) attached.

g. That I was promoted to the grades 1st lieutenant and again to Captain on 20 September 44 and 1 January 45 respectively, by a competent authority at the time (CO, Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas). See exhibits "A", "B" & "C" (S.O. 2, 4, & extract of Roster of officers and troops herewith attached. Also attached is a copy of Ltr, subject - Confirmation of guerrilla rank dated 15 January 47 for individual recognition. See exhibit "D" attached.

h. That after its incorporation into the USAFIP NL, I became Company Commander "D" Company, R/C Bn and 1st Lt (now Captain) was made Company Commander, "C" Company R/C Bn. See Exhibit "F" attached. The men of the organization were picked up with their guerrilla ranks. However, the officers were picked up with their bonafide ranks. Due to the intensive operations that have occupied us then, there was nothing done until we submitted our own Roster of officers and troops together with all supporting papers of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrilla for recognition as a unit on or about 31 January 1946 and receipt thereof acknowledged by AFMSPAC HQ, APO 707 on 25 May 46. See Exhibit "G" attached. I remained as CO, "D" Company R/C Bn USAFIP NL until its reorganization cmd, about or after V-J Day in August 1945.

1. That the guerrilla rank I held (Captain) was commensurate to the positions I held during the war, guerrilla days and liberation.

2. To this end, I appeal for justice and the extension of the same consideration that were accorded to others. Promotion in war time is common to those who fought the enemy. Precedents have shown that EM - nay even civilians, who, for having a command and participated in the resistance movement, were given commissioned ranks commensurate to their unit. If so, why not in my case - a bonafide commissioned officers of the USAFFE and AIE who fought during the Japanese invasion in 1941, participated and fought the enemy during the occupation and again fought the enemy during the liberation until V-J Day. I was always loyal to the CADESE and played my part accordingly.

3. In fairness to the dead and the living members of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas, request for the recognition of the unit as a whole and the recognition of my guerrilla rank individually.

It is desired to inform you that upon the completion of a re-investigation of this unit, which comprised a thorough evaluation of all the documentary evidence submitted in support of the unit claim, extensive interrogation of interested and disinterested persons, and a detailed examination of all related information appearing in the records of this headquarters, it was determined that the unrecognized portion of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrilla Forces does not satisfy the requirements of the constant guerrilla recognition criterion of this headquarters used in the consideration of all claimant guerrilla units. Therefore, the unit is not favorably considered for recognition.

It is considered that the recognition of elements of this organization which were recognized as Companies C and D of the Replacement and Casualty Battalion, 11th Infantry, USAFIP-ML, constitutes just and adequate acknowledgment of military services rendered.

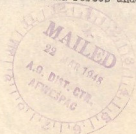
This decision constitutes final determination of and action upon the request for recognition of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrilla Forces.

HISTORY

OF

THE EASTERN CAGAYAN GUERRILLAS

-----cccc0cccc-----

The Eastern Cagayan Guerrilla Unit was organized during the Japanese occupation whose objective was, to cooperate with other resistance elements in the Philippines in the expulsion of the enemy from this country so that its people will enjoy once more the democratic way of life.

This humble organization was composed of a few loyal and patriotic ex-USAFFES and volunteer civilians who could no longer withstand the sight of the pitiful plight of their country and their countrymen under the tyrannical and despotic rule of the Japanese invaders.

That as a symbol of their true intentions, the members pledged to a sacred oath which was signed with their own blood, (these oaths were sent to Palrycom but lost by that office). This oath reads as follows:

"I, _____ (Name) _____, of _____ (Place) _____ do hereby solemnly swear without physical or mental restraint, that as a member of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas, I will, to the best of my ability, and even at the cost of my own life, fight for my beloved country, the Philippines, and my mother country, the United States of America. That in the pursuit of this common objective, I shall give up personal interests, convenience, and family love, until our goal shall have been attained; so help me God."

Before one becomes a full pledge member of the organization, he is given not less than 7 days probation. Within this period he is tested on qualities of courage and loyalty. He is also made to understand the mission of the organization and the untold sacrifices that he is to undergo as a member. It is emphasized on him that the reward of his sacrifices will be honor and the happiness of his family and Filipino people as a whole, and that the penalty for disloyalty or treachery is death. After the period of probation he takes the oath in a brief ceremony then signs it with his own blood as ink.

This organization was first conceived by 1st Lt. CECILIO R. PEÑAFLO, an ex-USAFFE officer, in March 1943 after his release from enemy internment: In view of strict surveillance by the Japs, Lt. Peñaflo's activity was limited within the city of Manila. His plan was to organize the nucleus of a resistance movement among provincemates who were in Manila, then move to Cagayan to operate against the enemy. He rounded Cagayanos who were in Manila and in June 1943, he had enough to compose the nucleus of a bat-talion headquarters.

In October 1943, Lt. Peñaflo contacted former Governor Marcelo Adduru of Cagayan who had just been released from the enemy internment camp. At the advice of the latter, Lt. Peñaflo's outfit was incorporated with the Cagayan Guerrillas of which

Adduru was the leader. The two agreed to move to Cagayan with their followers, reorganize thereat and commence hostilities against the enemy.

Adduru moved to Cagayan about June 1944. Peñaflor moved later in August of the same year. Upon arrival, Peñaflor reported to Adduru at his residence in Tuso, Cagayan. In the interview, Adduru informed Peñaflor that he (Adduru) was under strict surveillance by the Japs and that he (Peñaflor) too should be cautious. This was the last contact between the two. Adduru was re-interred by the Japanese Kempai at Tuguegarao about the end of 1944. Contact between the two was then impossible. Peñaflor could neither locate the remnants of Adduru's headquarters, nor know who they were.

The Japs were then exercising strict vigilance over all Filipino male citizens at that time that to go places was risky. Japanese guards were posted at strategical points along the National Highway and along the eastern bank of the Cagayan River. Crossing the river was a dangerous undertaking.

Lt. Peñaflor was thus marooned on the eastern side of Cagayan. There was no means of contact between him and Adduru or his staff. In view of this fact, Lt Peñaflor conceived the idea of putting up a suicide unit to do whatever it may possibly can in furtherance of the resistance movement. With the help of his few followers which he brought with him from Manila, he organized a unit composed of ex-USAPFES, former Adduru guerrillas, and volunteer civilians. In September 1944, there were about 200 members. In view of the great danger and risk surrounding the organization and its mission, it was named the "SUICIDE BATTALION." This unit operated only on the eastern side of the province of Cagayan embracing the towns of Tuguegarao, Iguig, Peñaablanca, Amulung, Baggo, and Alcala.

From September 1 to 14, 1944, the headquarters of the Suicide Battalion was in the mountains 8 kilometers east of the town of Iguig. Lt. Peñaflor and his headquarters' personnel lived in this place. A simple radio receiving set devised by 2nd Lt. Esteban Pagalilusan (AUE - former member of Nakar's Outfit) kept the unit informed of news all over the world. This news were typewritten in many copies with the signature of Capt. Ciampi (Code name of Lt Peñaflor - from his initial C.R.P.), and carried by couriers to friendly civilians who read them. Only the Key men lived in the headquarters with their families. Most of the members disguised themselves and lived with the civilians. The unit started with 1 Cal. 45 Pistol, 2 Cal. 32 revolver, 1 Cal. 38 revolver, 3 enfield rifles, and 3 shotguns. All other members armed themselves with bows and arrows, spears and bolos. Food supplies provided by the members themselves.

The whole area of operation was divided into 3 sectors, each sector under 2 officers, one as commanding officer of the sector, and the other as Intelligence Officer. The Peñaablanca-Tuguegarao sector was under Lt. Lope Turingan (AUE), the Iguig-Amulung sector was under Lt. Esteban Pagalilusan (AUE), and the Baggo-Alcala sector was under Lt Paciente Baleva (USAPFFE). The sector headquarters was located within its own sector. Its missions were to control the members within its sector, to enlist more members, make intelligence reports to the battalion headquarters, sabotage enemy supplies, and to ambush Jap patrols only when outside of civilian areas. It was also given a special mission to apprehend all civilian offenders of the law, like looters, bandits, spies, etc.

On 14 September 1944, the Suicide Battalion was about 450 in number. During this period alone the unit had the following accomplishments:

1. Burning and sinking 3 boats containing about 1,000 cavenes of rice for the Japanese Army.
2. Killing of 7 Japanese soldiers.
3. Capturing 6 Japs rifles and a few grenades.
4. Enlisting more members.
5. Encouraging the people to become antagonistic to the Japs.
6. Construction of a big Camp at Guinobat Mountains.

On 15 September 1944, the headquarters was transferred to Guinobat mountains about 15 kms east of the Cagayan River. This day marks the beginning of the first general assembly of all the members. A brief ceremony was held during which the members took their oath and signed their formal induction papers (These papers were sent to Philirycos in Jan. 1946). During this day the unit was reorganized. There were 3 companies. Company "A" was under Capt. Lope Turingan with Peñablanca and Tuguegarao as his sector. Company "B" under Capt Esteban Pagalilanan had Iguig and Amulung as its sector, Company "C" under Capt Paciente Baleva was assigned Baggao and Alcala as its sector. The Headquarters Company was directly under the Command of Capt. Peñaflor. The whole unit was renamed the "Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas".

Thenceforth, full scale operation was conducted against the enemy. The companies were sent to their respective sectors and instructed to intensify hostilities. They were given specific instructions to give top priority to securing more weapons for the unit at all cost.

On or about 15 September 1944, the Battalion Commander reiterated in a General Order issued to all units, that in the exercise of their duties, or in the execution of their missions, they shall not loot, steal, scare the people, or abuse their authorities, and that they should exercise extreme behavior in dealing with the people in order to win their sympathy. Severe punishment was meted out for offenders. Members were also warned not to collect food supplies or anything from the people. This job was given to Food Administrators who were assigned to every town. These Food Administrators were civilian members who were influential in their respective localities. They were given strict instructions by the Battalion Commander not to force the people to give them food or clothing, or, to receive anything from them without issuing a receipt. They were also instructed to receive only what the people may voluntarily contribute to the organization.

In view of the strict policy of the Battalion Commander on the collection of food supplies, rationing in the camp was very limited. The members eat one or two meals a day only. There were times when the members did not eat for the whole day. The diet was supplemented by eating wild fruits, fishes and meat of wild animals. Clothing was scarce. The members used rugged clothes. There was no medicine for the sick and wounded. The members were generally thin and sickly. Many died due to lack of medicine.

This was the pitiful plight of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas. They knew these hardships beforehand, but they were willing and ready to take whatever consequences that the war will bring upon them in their fight for freedom. In spite of their very miserable life and the great odds of which they were confronted, their morale was high. The members were anxious to go on raids against the enemy. To them, the fight and to sacrifice was a privilege. There was no sidetracking; no retreating.

On 20 October 1944, the news about the landing of the Americans was heard through the receiving set at the battalion headquarters. The people were immediately informed about the news. They were also advised to evacuate to the mountains or to the western side of the Cagayan River in anticipation of bombing raids of the towns by American planes. Many people who were confident of the guerrillas

took heed of this advise, while a few who thought the Americans will never make the mistake of bombing their homes, stayed. Many of these people were either killed by American bombs or by the Japanese.

The Japs were then becoming more and more vigilant over the whole population due to our intensive operations against Jap patrols and military supplies, that it was almost impossible to travel. They were beginning to kill civilians. The names of many guerrillas including their families were in the list of wanted persons. The Japs suspected the nearby mountains as hiding places of guerrillas that they raided those places often times. About the middle of December, 1944, before they could send a big patrol to raid our camps at Guinobatan Mountains, the battalion headquarters was transferred farther to the interior of the Sierra Madre Mountains. A special suicide group of guerrillas left to snipe the raiding Japs inflicting 11 casualties on the enemy. There was no casualty on the guerrilla side.

Since this raid, intelligence operations was intensified. The cooperation of all civilians was enlisted. Before the Japs could leave the outskirts of their garrisons for any operation, the guerrillas are informed on due time by the civilians. Even the women and children were actively participating in espionage work against the enemy. Reports were made to the nearest intelligence operatives sent by the Sector Commanders. Some of these intelligence reports were sent to the 11th Infantry, USAFIP, NL by the Battalion Commander. The success of some air raids conducted by American planes on the eastern side of the Cagayan River may have been partly due to intelligence reports coming from the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas, because it was only this unit then who was in a position to know the position and activities of the enemy on this part of the province of Cagayan.

Unlike the other parts of the Philippines, there was no ill feeling between the civilians and the guerrillas in this area. There was a very good understanding between the two elements. Even those who were formerly collaborating with the Japs went to our side. Some of them took refuge to our camp for fear of being located by the Japs. There was no killing of civilians. Only bandits and those who were believed to be dangerous to the existence of the liberation forces were arrested. The civilians were well protected against such people. Even Jap patrols who try to molest the people were attacked by the guerrillas. It was for this reason the people understood the good intentions of the guerrillas and thus sympathized with their cause.

Collection of food supplies was easy. The people offered part of their food, clothing and medicine. They offered anything of value to the guerrillas including private firearms and ammunition. Ladies volunteered their services. They cooked food for the guerrillas, washed and mended their clothes, and took care of the sick and wounded. On this part of the province of Cagayan, there was no such thing as "Commandeering" or "Terrorism" as was heard in other parts of the Philippines.

In February 1945, on invitation of Lt. Col. Donald Blackburn, CO of the 11th Infantry, USAFIP, NL, Capt Peñaflor and his staff went to his headquarters at Tuso, Cagayan. The result of the interview between the two was the incorporation of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas with the USAFIP, NL, as the "C" & "D" Companies Replacement & Casualty Battalion, on 1 May 1945.

From September 1944 to 30 April 1945, some of the accomplishments of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas were the following (summarized due to loss of some records of the unit during the campaign in the Mountain Province in July, 1945):

1. Burning and sinking of 2 big boats containing about 700 sacks of rice and killing 5 Japs therein, at Cagayan River.
2. Seizing one boatload of Prime Commodities for the Japanese Army and killing 3 Japs therein at Paret River, Baggao, Cagayan.
3. Destroying 11 bancas (Small boats) intended for crossing the Cagayan River, at different places along eastern bank of the Cagayan River.
4. Destroying several bamboo rafts intended for crossing the Cagayan River toward the western side.
5. Burning thousands of bamboo piles intended for the Japanese Army at Peñablanca and Baggao, Towns.
6. Cutting of Jap telephone lines within the area.
7. Attacking (at different times & places) 3 truckloads of Jap soldiers killing a total of about 15 soldiers.
8. Burning of Jap supplies at Peñablanca, Iguig, and Baggao sectors.
9. Raid on Jap Garrisons at Iguig, Baggao, and Peñablanca sectors.
10. Killing a total of about 65 Japs.
11. Capturing the following weapons:
 - 30 Jap rifles
 - 11 Enfield rifles
 - 6 Springfield rifles
 - 5 Sabers (Jap)
 - Several Jap & US Hnad grenades
12. Sending of intelligence reports to the 11th Infantry USAFIP, NL.
13. Protecting the people from bandits and terrorists.
14. Conducting a safe crossing of civilians through the National Highway and the Cagayan River toward the liberated areas on the western side of the province.
15. Supplying the people with up-to-date news about the war.
16. Capturing of suspected Jap spies.

The above accomplishments of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas were little as compared to the recorded accomplishments of other guerrillas units, but they were done heartily, honestly, and to the utmost efforts of the members of the organization. These few accomplishments were unrecorded and unheard, but to the people of Cagayan who actually witnessed them, they were enough to demonstrate the good intentions of the organization and the fighting spirit of its members.

The Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas did not sit on their ash and wait for the Great Allah to come and receive their well prepared rosters. Instead they worked and fought heartily and humbly to the accomplishment of their missions, forgetting whatever reward the future had stored for them.

After its organization, it is hereby attached to the Headquarters Battalion, 11th Infantry. It will immediately proceed to this headquarters for instructions.

5. 1st LIEUTENANT FIDEL VILLAFLO and SAULO B. GARGANTA will, upon completion of their duties in connection with the reorganization of the Eastern Cagayan Guerrillas return to this headquarters without delay.

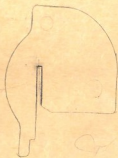

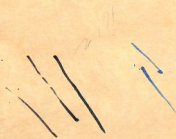
