Sternberg's Detachment:

Lt Adolph Sternberg, Jr. (unsurrendered Sgt, USAC) joined the guerrillas in February 1944. He had been bed ridden in Davao Province with a tropical skin disease for over a year preceding this time. During his illness, he stayed with Lt Col Laureta on the Libuganon River. When he recovered, he reported to Colonel Fertig's headquarters and was sent back to Davao as a liaison officer between the 130th Regiment and the 110th Division. Shortly after, he was placed in command of a guerrilla unit near Malativas, Davao, which was then activated as a Special Intelligence Detachment with about 80 armed men. Lt Strenberg's intelligence activities in the Davao area has been quite valuable.
