## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

Lt Col Wallace M. Hanes:

1. Basic, ltr fr Mr Sebas P Leano to CG, PHILRYCOM, dtd 29 March 48, requesting reconsideration of the unfavorable decision rendered by this headquarters on 2 Jul 46 on the request for recognition of the Philippine Militia Company and forwarding papers & rosters of that unit, together with rosters of the Volunteer Guards of Salay, Misamis Oriental, carried in our files as a part of the Philippine Militia Company.
2. This unit with a strength of 108 was RFC'd 2 Jul 46. Mr Leano has split his original roster, added a few members, and represents them as the Philippine Militia Company and the Volunteer Guards of Salay. Mr. Leano has forwarded a few affidavits and certificates from local citizens in support of his claim. These are of no material value.
3. The unit was a homeguard type and was not maintained in the field. All 10th MD members worthy of recognition, according to Col Fertig, were recognized on his official rosters.
4. It is recommended that Mr. Leano's request for reconsideration be not accepted and that this constitute the final determination of and action upon the claim for recognition of the unit.

Dear Mr. Loano:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 29 March 1948, requesting reconsideration of the unfavorable decision rendered by this headquarters on 2 July 1946 on the request for recognition of the Philippine Militia Company and forwarding papers and rosters of that unit, together with rosters of the Volunteer Guards of Selay, Misamis Oriental, carried in our files as a part of the Philippine Militia Company.

It is desired to emphasize that after extensive investigation and full consideration of all substantiating evidence submitted by your unit under the name of the Philippine Militia Company and a careful analysis of all other available information of the military activities of your unit from its inception, scrutinized in relation to the overall resistance movement, it was determined that your unit failed to fulfill the requirements of our constant guerrilla recognition criterion used in the consideration of all claimant guerrilla units. As a result, the Philippine Militia Company, which included the Volunteer Guards of Selay, was not favorably considered for recognition by this headquarters on 2 July 1946. A letter to this effect was dispatched to you at Selay, Misamis Oriental, Philippines.

In view of your request for reconsideration of this unfavorable decision, a thorough review has been made of all the information upon which the original decision of non-recognition was based and a detailed examination has been made of the papers forwarded with your letter of 29 March 1948. This study definitely substantiated the original decision of non-recognition and failed conclusively to reveal any material which would justify further consideration of your entire unit. Your request for reconsideration therefore cannot be accepted.

This constitutes the final determination of end action upon the claim for recognition of the Philippine Militia Company. Sincerely,

The Commanding General directs that you be informed that your request for individual guerrilla casualty recognition, previously not favorably considered for recognition, has been reconsidered at your request.

Previous investigation of the alleged activities and scrutiny of all supporting papers available to this headquarters at that time revealed that your claim was supported by insufficient evidence to justify casualty recognition. Reinvestigation of your claim fails to indicate evidence of such nature as to warrant revision of our previous decision.

Therefore, it is with regret that we must inform you that the reinvestigation of activities continues to reveal that the record of military service rendered is insufficient to justify official recognition as a member of the Philippine Army in the service of the Armed Forces of the United States. This decision constitutes the final determination of and action upon your claim for guerrilla casualty recognition.

Dear Mr. Leano:

The "Philippine Militia Company", purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippine, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all available substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- b. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- c. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, copy attached.

1. Letter of non-recognition addressed to the "Philippine Militia Company" under the command of Sabas P. Leano; under the overall command of Col. Fertig. This unit submitted a roster of 108 members.

2. Basis for non-recognition:

- a. The unit was a home guard type unit, with each man performing duty one day a week.
- b. The unit was not maintained in the field.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrillas only on a part time basis.
- e. Col. Fertig's remark that all guerrillas in the 10th Military District worthy of recognition, have already been recognized in his official rosters.



Fertig, to all Regimental and Division Commanders within the 10th Military District, dated February 11, 1943, herewith inclosed, and it has been on active duty from the month of April 1, 1943 to April 3, 1944 as per available record shows. While on active duty the officers and men of this organization never received any pay, subsistence nor allowance, although we believed we were entitled to it as per paragraph 7 of the said memorandum.

The organization was ordered to be disbanded by the Regimental Commander 110th Inf. 110th Div., because of the order to reorganized the Volunteer Guards organization of which I was also appointed to reorganized and to head the Volunteer organization.

The undersigned, therefore, further request your honor for the favor and consideration that the Philippine Militia Company organization be recognized for thier services rendered during the war with our army for the liberation of our country.

All Regimental Commanders, Philippines

1. All arms and ammunitions, food supplies, military supplies, peace and order and defense of your sector are under your responsibility. Extent of your sector will be published from time to time.
2. Your Regiment will be organized under the following requirements: two men will be enlisted per rifle; five men per automatic rifle or machine rifle; three men per gary; ten men per machine gun and one man per shotgun, palinted or pistol. The number of sections per arm ~~will be determined by the Regimental Commander.~~
3. The strength of each company will not exceed the following: 3 officers; 1 first sergeant; 5 sergeants; 12 corporals; 25 private, first class; 64 privates; 1 private medical division. The strength is flexible depending on the situation. All officers and men will be required to take an oath of allegiance to the United States. All will then be inducted into the United States Forces in the Philippines and each officer and man will keep the induction paper in his possession for future claim, if any, against the United States Government for pay, subsistence, allowance or pension.
4. Officers and men who could not be inducted into the Army because of the requirement of paragraphs (2) and (3) above will be organized into Militia Companies and called to duties once a week to perform military duties.
5. The strength of the Militia Company is the same as that provided for the Army i.e., 3 officers and 110 Enlisted Men. They are subject to military laws only when on duty.
6. After the organization of the Army and Militia, the rest of the men will be enlisted in the Volunteers. They will perform duties as chargadores, runners, messengers and other duties which the Regimental Commander may prescribe from time to time.
7. The Army is entitled to pay, subsistence and allowance while in the active service of the USFIP. Members of the Militia are entitled to such privileges only when they actually perform military duties. While off duty, in their homes and farms, they are not entitled to such privileges. Volunteers are only entitled to subsistence allowance when performing military duties assigned to them.
8. Strength of the Army, Militia and Volunteers will be determined by the Regimental Commander. Arms and ammunitions on hand and ability of the people to grow and maintain them should be taken into account.

9. You will carefully look into the personal records of application for commission before finally recommending them to this Headquarters. Military training, experience, courage, leadership and other factors a fighter will be given more weight in determining the selection of officers. Brainy persons with military training but who are weak and coward should be eliminated. During these times we need only fighters. If you can have the brains and the courage in a man, enlist him; if not select only the person with courage. Require all officers to submit their application for commission and for those already commissioned, their personal records.

10. To facilitate settlement of mess obligations of the Army, Militia and Volunteers the return of such accounts for these units should be prepared supported by the receipt of receipts. Settlement of donated money and feedstuffs should be made upon receipt of the money from the donor.

11. A roster of officers and enlisted men of your Regiment will be submitted to this Headquarters upon completion of the organization.

12. Any previous order in conflict with the above are hereby superseded.






