Dear Mr. Sto Maris:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the Medical Corps, Hunters ROTC, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control has not been favorably considered for recognition.

It is felt that the number of men recognized in the Signal War Regiment, Hunters ROTC, a composite unit of the overall command under Col Eleuterio Adevero, constitutes a just and adequate acknowledgement of the military services performed by the Hunters ROTC unit.

This decision does not preclude individual requests for casualty recognition by injured personnel who desire to enter such claims. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.

SUBJECT: Recognition of Guerilla members
16 : Commanding Officer, AFWESFAC, APO 707

In behalf of the people in the herein attached list I have the honor to request that recognition be extended them for their guerilla activities during the Japanese Occupation. It is not a distinct and separate unit but these men constitute the local unit of the R.O.T.C (HUNTERS) guerilla organization headed by Col. Terry Magtanggol Adevosos. Their activities dated way back in the early part of 1942 up to the time of the liberation of the town of San Mateo from the Japanese. These men constituted the members of the Medical and Supply Corps, who rendered medical service and solicited voluntary contribution from the residents of the town of San Mateo for the support of ROTC men and Americans who were operating in this area during the Japanese occupation. Among the Americans helped by this unit were Mr. Leinham, Mr. Mouser, Mr. Sherlok and Mr. Magdoy who had spent their three years in the mountains fastness of San Mateo. When the Japanese made their retreat in the town and mountains of San Mateo the ROTC men moved from this area thereby these people lost their connection with the ROTC command in the early part of November 1944. Due to this, these men were not included in any of the ROSTERS submitted by the ROTC (Hunters) organization to the Headquarter. Now, in Justice and fairness to these people, recognition of their activities is requested. For confirmation of their claims regarding their activities I refer you to the commanding officer of the ROTC and other officers who stayed in this area during the Japanese occupation.

1. Norberto Santos, messenger, and supply man, became wanted by the Jap. for his activities.
2. Juan Ban sag, supply man and furnished quarter. Locally known as mang Juan.
3. Segundo Badillo, furnished quarter, supply man, and messenger. Locally known as TANAWAN.
4. Teodoro Cuevas, supply man. He was caught by the Jap. tortured, and punished. Released later on.
5. Gabriel Angeles, supply man. Now deceased.
6. Emiliano Angeles, supply man. He was caught by the Jap. and questioned for his activities.
7. Dionisio Badillo, messenger.
8. Pablo Guardiano, furnished quarter and acted as guide in the mountains.
9. Celstino Gutierrez, furnished quarter. Was killed by the Jpa. for sheltering the Americans.
10. Eulalio Marcelo, furnished quarters, and acted as guide.
11. Gaudencio Mendoza, furnished quarter and supply. He was killed by the Jap.
12. Ignacio Atanacio, furnished supply and quarter. Became wanted by the Jap .
