SUBJECT: Commissions  
TO : All Concerned

1. Whenever recommendations for commission of officers are made to this General Headquarters, it is requested that the following be specified:

a. Whether the officers are being commissioned for the first time.

b. Whether they are being promoted.

c. Whether they are being assigned to positions other than to which they were originally commissioned, and whether these new assignments involve promotions.

d. In case certain officers are assigned to other positions, who are the officers to take their respective places, or are the positions to be left vacant?

e. When an officer is replaced, where was he transferred, or was he discharged or derated?

2. It is noted that special orders coming from the Divisions commissioning officers sometimes conflict with each other. In a certain special order received here, for instance, an officer was commissioned to a position and in another order of the same date, the same officer was commissioned to a distinctly different position. Again, in certain instances, there were officers assigned to other positions who were promoted at the same time, but the fact that these officers were promoted was not so stated.

3. It is also desired that before an officer is commissioned or assigned to a certain position, the battalion, regimental or division personnel or intelligence officers or inspectors investigate the fitness of the officer for the position to which he is intended to be assigned. It was noted by this GHL, for instance, that in a certain town unit a dentist was commissioned Town Judge Advocate who has had no previous experience as such. Similar anomalies have been noted which need not be specified here.

4. Reasonable care must be exercised in the appointment of officers, especially town officers, because if the

if the Town Commander or the other town officers could not command the respect of the community, the townspeople would most likely not believe in, or support, the town organization.

5. It is desired that Division and Regimental Commanders, and all others concerned, make separate recommendations to this GHQ as to the ranks which the officers under them may assume if by any chance they are inducted into the USAFFE. It cannot be denied that certain persons have been commissioned as officers in this Command, while others were given ranks, only for purposes of a guerrilla organization. There are officers of this organization who cannot, under Army regulations, be commissioned as officers into the USAFFE.

6. In recommending the ranks which might be given to certain officers if inducted into the USAFFE, the following must be taken into consideration: (1) educational attainment; (2) date of induction into the organization; (3) positions held in the organization; (4) accomplishments in the organization; (5) previous military training and experience; and (6) exact age.

7. All Division, Regimental and Battalion Commanders and all others concerned are enjoined to rush to this GHQ G-1 Form No. 10 as accomplished. Late rosters and those not in accordance with G-1 Form No. 10 will not be forwarded to GHQ, SWPA.

SUBJECT: Order to Strike No. 2

TO : ALL HUNTERS and Loyal Guerrillas

1. All members of this Command and that of other loyal guerrilla organizations are now authorized and encouraged to ambush all Japanese Army messengers, staff officers or unescorted Commanders, within limits of personal and general security.
2. GHQ, SWPA is greatly in need of more vital information as those that can be gathered from captured log books, diaries, etc.. Messages, orders and other documents, therefore, which could be taken from the person of Japanese Army messengers should at once be forwarded to this Headquarters.
3. GHQ, SWPA further desires that captured Japanese soldiers, and especially, officers, be forwarded to it for questioning and interrogation.

SUBJECT: Additional Instructions from GSG, SFA

TO : All Loyal Guerrillas and Loyal Civilians

1. The following message has just been received by this Headquarters from GENERAL MACARTHUR'S HEADQUARTERS:

"YOU WILL IMMEDIATELY AND CONTINUOUSLY PERFORM ALL POSSIBLE SABOTAGE OF ENEMY TRANSPORT, COMMUNICATIONS, SUPPLY AND AMMUNITION DUMPS PERIOD MAXIMUM DESTRUCTION OF AIRCRAFT ASSEMBLY, GASOLINE AND OTHER SUPPLY INSTALLATIONS, POWER LINES, ROLLING STOCK, RAILROAD TRACKS, VEHICLES AND EVERY OTHER MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION."

2. This information will be forwarded and spread to all known loyal people so that the maximum destruction of enemy equipment will be possible.

3. Employ the Inter-Guerrilla Courier Service to the fullest extent to carry out the orders of our COMMANDER-in-Chief, General Douglas MacArthur.

4. Every loyal person who receives this communication is enjoined to strike the enemy with all power at his disposal in order to carry out these orders.

SUBJECT: Message from General Douglas MacArthur  
TO : All Commanding Officers

1. Following is a message from the General Headquarters, Southwest Pacific Area.

2. It is hereby being transmitted to the Commanding officers of all guerrilla units in Central Luzon, for their information and guidance:

"I DESIRE THAT YOU TAKE SUCH STEPS AS ARE AVAILABLE TO YOU TO MAKE IT PATENTLY CLEAR THAT WHEN OUR MILITARY FORCES HAVE REACHED THE ISLAND OF LUZON, IT SHALL BE MY FIRM PURPOSE TO RUN DOWN TO EARTH AND BRING TO JUSTICE EVERY FILIPINO WHO HAS DEBASED THE CAUSE OF HIS OWN PEOPLE. I SHALL RUN DOWN THOSE WHO HAVE MOLESTED OR OTHERWISE IMPAIRED THE SERVICE OF ANY USARAF OFFICER OR MAN WHO HAS CONTINUED TO RESIST THE ARMY, OR ANY CIVILIAN PATRIOT SUPPORTING THE RESISTANCE MOVEMENT. IT HAS COME TO MY ATTENTION FROM SEVERAL SOURCES THAT THERE ARE DE LOYAL ELEMENTS AMONG THE FILIPINOS IN CENTRAL LUZON. INFORM ANY SUCH PERSONS THAT THEIR ACTION CONSTITUTES DIRECT AID TO THE ARMY IN THIS WAR AGAINST THE UNITED STATES AND THE PHILIPPINE COMMONWEALTH. IF THEY CONTINUE SUCH ACTIONS ALL NECESSARY FORCES SHALL BE COMMITTED IN SUCH TIME TO CLEARLY EFFECT THEIR APPROPRIATION AND PUNISHMENT FOR THE CRIME OF TREASON BOTH AGAINST THE UNITED STATES AND THE COMMONWEALTH. I CALL UPON THEM NOW TO AID AND SUPPORT OUR CAUSE AND TO OBEY AND OBEY MY INSTRUCTIONS."

SUBJECT: Instructions  
TO : All Filipino Patriots

The set of instructions issued by General MacArthur is quoted hereunder for the information and guidance of all Filipino patriots:

"Your general norm of conduct should conform as such as possible to the following:

"1. Secure your family with such food as is available to you as rapidly as possible at points away from vital enemy installations which our military forces shall ceaselessly attack with increasing violence until destroyed.

"2. Support the local commander whom I appoint over the area in which you reside or, if none is so appointed, the local leader of the resistance movement.

"3. Avoid any assistance to the enemy, but, on the contrary, harass him incessantly, taking full advantage of every favorable opportunity to do so. Harass him by disrupting his means of communication and essential lines. Harass him by destroying his munitions, food, fuel, transport, and other vital supplies. And harass him by cutting down or subduing him at every turn, showing him that he may know no rest or relaxation within your community, that no enemy soldier may escape the fate which inexorably confronts all: DEATH OR SURRENDER.

"4. To the people in enemy areas far removed from the zone of active operation, I counsel a period of alertness and preparation, a period in which full advantage must be taken of favorable opportunity to strike blows, but in which premature or ill-considered action, if it be at the expense of needless loss of life, is to be avoided.

1. Requests that District Special Troops, Hunters (ROTC) Guerrilla be recognized.

(a) - History and Activities

1. That Looc, Detachment Troops was organized under the Command of Capt. Ambrocio Liwanag, attached to 49th Regt 47th Division, Hunters (ROTC) Guerrilla 1942-43.

2. That the mission of these organization was for security purposes, protection of the civilians, and harassing the enemies. The place during these days was often times visited by the enemies.

(b) - On or about 15 October 1944 the GHQs of Hunters (ROTC) under Col Terry Magtanggol (Eleuterio Adevos) was transferred from Cavite to Kutad Mts near Looc, North western part of Bataangas.

(c) - 1. Looc, Detachment Troops, was reorganized into - District Special Troops, with Major Ambrocio Liwanag as the Commanding Officer and Major Dionisio T. Sebial as the adviser and Commandant of Troops School. - October 1944.

2. This was organized with the following purposes and missions, as per directives from GHQ of Hunters (ROTC) Guerr.

- (a) Security of the GHQ (Hunters ROTC) Guerrilla.
- (b) Constructions of Barracks.
- (c) Troops Schools.
- (d) Hauling supplies.
- (e) Intelligence.
- (f) Harassing the enemies.

3. Different outposts were organized - Malaped-mabato - holding the way from Masugbu to Kutad Mts (GHQ Hunters ROTC), under Lt. Mariano Torpo.

Galayo Cave - south - under Lt Delfin Buhain, holding the place from any possible landing of enemies.

Fatungan - northwest - under Lt Eutiquio Gamboa, holding the place.

Papaya Cove - under the General Headquarters Service Company.

The mission is to detect and make reports of any enemy activities for the information to GHQ Hunters (ROTC) Guerrilla.

4. Troops schools, construction of Barracks and hauling of supplies were undergone by the District Special Troops. Military training to the Civilian Guerrillas were given. Quarters were constructed for the Personnel both Filipinos and Americans in GHQ Hunters (ROTC) Guerr.

5. Operatives were sent out to the covered places of

the enemies, and paroles were sent out also on occupied point like Bakanita point, and Pating Kohoy Mts. Mission is to gather periodical reports on enemies positions and reported to GHQ of Hunters (ROTC) Guerrilla for transmittal.

Activities with American Troops.

1. 1. Two days after the landing in Masugbu, Batangas, 31 January 1945, District Special troops reported to GHQ Hunters (ROTC) Guerrilla transferred to Masugbu.

We were attacked and had participated the following operations in Batangas area.

(a) Operation in Lion, Batangas under Lt Col James H Farren - 1877 L. 11th Airborne Division - see attached true copy of the letter by Col Farren.

(b) Operation in Balayan, San Piro, Macukak, Batangas, see attached letter of R.C.P. 156.


(c) Operations in Macolot Mts, Cuenca Lips, Batangas under 187 Infantry, 11th Airborne Division.

2. Some of our men were with combat team in all this operations and some were in the water point guarding thus preventing them from being included in the first recognized resters.

3. The morale was very high that even without shoes, clothes and lack of foods, still we continued fighting for the liberation of our Country from the enemies.

4. Major Ambrosio Linsag on the day of invasion withdrew his command from District Special Troops, thus - Major Dionisio T. Sebial took the command.

5. Our services continued until Batangas province was liberated.

1. Requests that DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS, HUNTERS (BORO) GUERRILLAS, be recognized.

## History

2. That, immediately after the General Surrender of the UNITED STATES in the Philippines, the people of Iloc, Masuga, Patague under Captain Andronico Iivana (Old Man) organized his co-formers of the Huelanda (Van de Bona) to protect their properties, especially amaranth and rice products from being looted, 1942.

3. That, when the 49th Regiment of the Veterans (BORO) under Lt-Col Juanito del Pilar, established his Regimental CP in Yated mountains near Iloc, immediately, the said Iloc organization reported and joined the Hunters (BORO). The mission of the Iloc organization was for security for the 49th Regimental CP and harassing the Japanese patrols who often times visited the Huelanda and protections of the properties of the civilians in 1943 and in the early part of 1944.

4. That, when the General Headquarters of the Hunters (BORO) under Col Eleuterio Adevero (Harry Martensell) Commanding Officer of the Hunters (BORO) Guerrillas transferred his headquarters in Fubad, Masuga, Bataan on October 1944, the said Iloc organization was reorganized into District Special Troops with the surrounding cities or barrios as follows: Iloc, South, Calayo along the coast, - South east, Patungon - Terment and Malagad-na-bato, north east. Then the General Headquarters was at the center.

5. That, field orders were issued for the District Special Troops to do. The mission was so very important as it protects the lives both the Americans and Filipinos at the General Headquarters.

## (a) The missions were:-

1. Security- Outposts to the different barrios were posted to sight and make necessary reports to the HQ on enemy activities.

2. Training- Rotations of officers and enlisted men from the different units of the organization undergo military training, combat principles and marksmanship which were conducted by District Special Troops in Iloc, Masuga. Instructors were the Ex-Philippine Scouts and Army personnel.

3. Hauling supplies- Shipments of supplies and hauling of food supplies towards the HQ were undertaken by the members of the District Special Troops.

4. Construction\*- Construction of barracks for personnel and warehouses for the supplies. There were American Officers and Enlisted men - like Major Jay D. Vanderpool, rescued American aviators or pilots so that quarters were constructed by the District Special Troops.

5. Intelligence- Operatives were sent out, towards the neighboring towns, like Masuga, Bernate, Lian, Calatagan and small islands to gather periodical reports on enemy activities and reported to HQ, Hunters (BORO) guerrillas.

6. That, the District Special Troops rendered services, both combat, intelligence, construction of barracks and hauler of supplies.

ACTIVITIES DURING THE LANDING AT THE LIBERATION PERIOD

1. Two days after the landing in Zamboanga, Batangas by the 8th Army, American Troops (February 1945) District Special Troops were attached to 1855 I, 11th Airborne Division under Lt-Col James H. Warren in the following operations; Pico, Zamboanga, Batang Bay, Lian, and Balayan, Batangas.

2. Attached to 168 BOC, 11th Airborne Division in the operations of Makokok, Balayan, San Pedro Mt and Galatagan.

3. Attached to 187th Inf, 11th Airborne Division in the operations of Guanoa, Macolet Mt, Lina, Santo Tomas until the liberation of Batangas area.

4. The morale of the troops was very high, that although without shoes, clothes and other necessary equipment, they keep on fighting, side by side with the Americans, for liberation, justice and preservation of democracy towards the Filipino people, which is sponsored by the United States of America.

CHIEF HISTORY OF THE DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS

The Hunters ROTC of Col. Terry Magtandol making a stiff fight against the Japanese Army in and near Manila Area and causing severe damage to the Japanese Installation, made the Japanese command to make a desperate chase or hunt for the few Hunters ROTC Guerrillas. A wise decision of Col. Terry Magtandol and his Staff to transfer their General Headquarters to a high Cuted a mountain area between the boundary of Batangas and Cavite but sloping toward the shore of the south of Manila Bay near the approach of Corregidor Island. Upon establishing his GHQ in Cuted Col. Terry Magtandol absorbed the Guerrillas of near by cities and barrios of Calapa, Lobo, Patungan, Malapad na Bato and etc. In one Battalion called DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS under the command of Lt. USAFPA man Major Dionicio Sebial, these units above mentioned troops form the nucleus of the organization of the HUNTERS ROTC in Batangas Area. The men of the District Special Troops, had the solemn and trustworthy duty of guarding the HUNTERS ROTC GHQ against the invading Japanese Army and other bad elements which had another aim rather than the purpose of guerrilla activities for America and the Philippines win the War against the Japanese. Aside for guarding duty said men of the HUNTERS ROTC DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS also procure food and vital supplies for the men of the GHQ.

Advance Intelligence Operatives of the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS of Calapa men were stationed in Marugbu near the Japanese Garrison to mainly spot Japanese movements and reports received by the GHQ from said operatives were transmitted to GHQ of General MacArthur by Cuted GHQ of HUNTERS ROTC, the unopposed landing in Marugbu Bay January 31, 1945 of the American Liberation Forces was the said close contact of Cuted GHQ Hunters ROTC with the GHQ of General MacArthur. Intelligence Operative Officer of DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS met the landing elements of the 11th Airborne under General Swing and of the 81st Army under General Robert Kilbinger in that morning of January 31, 1945, giving vital enemy position and possible places on the way to Manila where Anti - tank traps were made by the Japanese Army. The HUNTERS ROTC GHQ with the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS moved to Marugbu Area and Attached to the American Forces serving in mopping operations and flank guards in the Batangas Area, Cavite, Laguna, Tayabas and Manila Operations.

In January about the end to February 1945, Japanese soldiers stationed in Carabao, Freila Islands and also from Corregidor escaped to the mountain area in said boundary of Batangas and Cavite and annihilate the civilian population far from American Army Installation men of the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS HUNTERS ROTC, with some American Officers and soldiers made the mopping operation. Lt. Furnwood of the 11th Airborne Division, one of the officers who led the operation even mentioned that it was a jungle fight like the one they made in New Guineas. Remnants of the rifle, saber and etc captured from the Japanese in said operation can be still be seen in the custody of the respective guerrilleros who had kept for souvenirs.

Continuation of History

One and will never be forgotten activities of the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS before the landing in Nasugbu January 31, 1946 of the American Liberation Forces was the advance landing made by the U.S. Navy Seaplane in CALAYO COVE , January 9, 1945. Said advance landing though Top Secret was made known to the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS for preparing the putting of marker made of white blankets and preparing the boats to meet the seaplane. The seaplane arrived at 10:30 A.M. unload the supplies of Ammunition, canned foods, medicine and etc. and left said place at 12:30 P.M. Officers present and who meet the seaplane crew were : Major Jay D. Vandervoort , Col. Terry Magtangol , Col. Atienza , Lt. Col. Ferrer, Major Dionisio Sebial, Major Juanito Ferrer , Lt. Col. Castillo , and Major Monfort.

After said seaplane had takeoff , the men of the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS HUNTERS ROTC mostly of "B" Company under CAPT. Delfin Buñin of Calayo after doing of meeting the seaplane, unloading and hauling the said supplies as well as guarding, then prepared for an any time assault of the Japanese Army, intended to fight to the bitter end . God Bless us the Japanese did not come.

Before the end of this brief history we of the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS will remind that before guerrilla activities is made active here and there in the Philippines, Bataan and Corregidor still fighting but supply of food getting low, in the month of February 1942 U.S. Army Transport Ship crossed Manila Bay from Bataan to get a fresh supplies of rice, pigs, cows, vegetables, fruits for Bataan and Corregidor to CALAYO, LOOC, Municipality of Nasugbu , under the command of then Major Jose Razon and Capt. Jose Rusda, USAFFE officers, both said officers got their Silver Medal for such splendid services as mentioned above, but if not for the manpower of the male population of Calayo and Looc, their voluntary services of procuring, giving what they can spare, hauling and guarding in the beach said supplies. Said supplies cannot be accumulated and hauled to the ship in such a short time possible as Nasugbu Area is already occupied by the Japanese Army. The Japanese Army had known of that and in retaliation they mopped up the barrico of Looc. Killed some people and then burned the village. Now of those male population mentioned above who did said services for the U.S. Army, they are the men now who composed the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS HUNTERS ROTC , still unrecognized but we hope that upon this brief history we try to portray to the Contact Team of AFWSPEC, that the DISTRICT SPECIAL TROOPS is a guerrilla unit that had done some splendid services during this War.
