The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the San Juan Ermitano Unit, Hunters ROTC, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, has not been favorably considered for recognition.

It is felt that the number of men recognized in the Sigual Ver Regiment, Hunters ROTC, a composite unit of the overall command, under Col Kleuterio Advoso, constitutes a just and adequate acknowledgement of the military services performed by the Hunter's ROTC unit.

This decision does not preclude individual requests for casualty recognition by injured personnel who desire to enter such claims. Upon request from interested individuals, appropriate casualty forms will be forwarded.

SUBJECT: History of the Organization and Account of Activities of the 44th Regiment, 44 hunters Division, Hunters R.O.T.C. Guerrillas, San Juan Ermitaño Unit, from the time of its organization on 8 February 1944 up to the present.

TO : The COMMANDING OFFICER, Hunters Headquarters.

As commanding officer of the San Juan Ermitaño Unit, I have the honor to submit to this headquarters a history of the organization and an account of the activities of the said unit from the time of its organization on 8 February 1944 up to the present.

Being the organizer and ultimately the commanding officer of the San Juan Ermitaño Unit, I feel it is but just and proper that I submit first my own personal history and activities before that of the unit.

Prior to the outbreak of the war on 8 December 1941, my family and I were residing in Marikina, Rizal. I was engaged in the business of supplying gravel and sand to various construction works. In 1940, when the Nichols Field and the Cavite Navy Yard were under construction, I was under contract with the U.S. Army and navy to supply the construction work with gravel and sand. Even after the Japanese heavy air attacks on Manila, I kept on making deliveries of the much needed sand for sandbags to the Marsman building at Port Area which was later used as the Admiral's Office. But after 15 December 1941, when conditions became worst and activities of all sort came to a stand still, I settled down regretfully with my family in our home town.

It was while in Marikina, Rizal, that I was appointed Police Patrol and Volunteer Guard of the Civilian Emergency Administration (CEA) in accordance with Executive Order No. 335. (Please refer to Exhibit "A" attached hereto.) Before the Imperial Japanese Forces finally succeeded in occupying the area, the Civilian Emergency Administration and all its units were disbanded. The actual occupation of Marikina took place on 23 January 1942. Faced with no other alternative I, together with my family, within a reasonable time before actual occupation by enemy forces, fled to the Antipolo mountain and stayed there in comparative safety up to June of that year. During our hiding in the Antipolo mountain I succeeded, after exerting some effort, in contacting the disbanded American soldiers from Infanta, Tayabas, and from the local regions, who were then making their way under the most hazardous circumstances to Batang via the Sierra Madre mountains. Knowing the predicament of these straggling American soldiers, I took it upon myself the duty and privilege to give them all possible aid and assistance within the limit of my resources. In certain cases I went further and looked around and tried to get from other willing sources the much needed food and other items of personal necessity which these American soldiers could not without much difficulty secure in that very much secluded place.

As these Americans did not know the intricacies of mountain trails, I saw to it that they were provided with reliable guides thereby enabling them to know the shortest way possible to their place of destination, and save time and effort.

When I fled to the mountain I took with me the truck which I was using in supplying sand and gravel as I have already stated. For sometime I thought this truck was safe and secure in its place of hiding. Possession of this valuable family asset was, however, wrested from me when a considerable number of "Makapilis", members of an organization of Filipino traitors, came along and threatened my life if I did not consent to have the truck taken to town and be offered to the Japanese Garrison, so that it might be used for facilitating movement of the enemies and their supplies. Under the circumstance I had no other recourse, nor anybody else in my place, than to give up hope of retaining the truck. With the truck my family and I were taken to town by the "Makapilis" who presented the truck to the commander of the Marikina Japanese Garrison through their interpreter named Takahasi.

This act of utter disregard of proprietary rights of Filipino citizens which is amply secured by the fundamental law, the almost daily occurrence of inhuman treatment of Filipinos by the Japanese soldiers and the "Makapilis", and my unquestioned loyalty and allegiance both to the Commonwealth government that sought refuge in Washington and to the government of the United States of America, were the compelling force that drove me to immediate action. I wasted no time in finding ways and means of making contact with leaders of the underground movement.

It was not long after, when in November 1942, I heard that a guerrilla unit was being organized in San Juan, Rizal, by a certain Ernesto Tupas. From Marikina I immediately proceeded to San Juan and succeeded in having a first meeting with the guerrilla leader. I was readily admitted a member of the organization on 1 December 1942. The first work assigned to me was to campaign for membership and counteract Japanese propaganda. We were convinced of the success of our drive by the remarkable increase in the registration of members. Unfortunately for us and for the cause we promise to uphold, our leader, Mr. Ernesto Tupas, was arrested four times for alleged guerrilla activities. Although lucky to escape confinement in the first three instances, he did not have the same luck in the fourth time that he was arrested for then he was sentenced to <sup>be</sup> imprisoned and was, as a matter of fact, confined at Muntinglupa Bilibid Prisons.

The fate that has befallen our leader had its adverse effect on the morale of the organization. The growing ~~consciousness~~ consciousness that we were being closely observed and shadowed by the "Makapilis" and the Japanese Military Police and other agents forced us to temporarily disband ourselves as a matter of precaution.

In the meantime, urged by <sup>a</sup>strong desire to do my bit in aiding the allied ~~cause~~ cause, I kept on looking around for other underground units to which I could possibly attach myself. In July 1943, it was my good fortune to meet one

Amado "Baggie" Laccinto, then a first sergeant in the Hunters or R.O.T.C. guerrilla. I immediately enlisted in his unit as a private. I was assigned to stay in the town of Marikina to gather food supplies and other provisions for the guerrillas of the unit. These supplies were generously contributed by the sympathetic townspeople.

Although our unit has already moved to Infanta, Tayabas, following instructions, I stayed in Marikina. In January 1944, our unit returned to Antipolo mountain after some sort of reorganization of the unit resulting in the promotion of former sergeant Amado "Baggie" Laccinto to the rank of Major. In recognition of past services rendered, I was on 4 January 1944 promoted to first sergeant, Intelligence Unit. (Please refer to attached Exhibit "B") I continued with my assignment in Marikina and as a member of the Intelligence Unit, my job in addition to the procurement of food supplies and other provisions, was to report all atrocities and other forms of mistreatment committed by the Japanese and "Makapilis" in that town. Later, a supply unit was organized in Santo Niño, Marikina, and I was designated to take charge of said unit. (Please refer to Exh. "C" attached herewith.)

On 1 April 1944, I received "Special Order" of the following tenor: "Effective this date, the following promotion are hereby made in the Rizal District Headquarters of the Field Commander, 'THE HUNTERS' to be third lieutenant PEDRO GABRIEL." By virtue of the same Special Order, I was designated Commanding Officer of the Supply Unit in Santo Niño, Marikina, Rizal. (Please refer to attached Exh. "D".)

During the time I was Supply Officer, I have fed and given shelter in my own house, all the guerrillas coming from Malabon, Manila, Parañaque, and Mandaluyong, bound for our Headquarters in the Antipolo mountain. My attachment to the guerrillas and my activities as a member thereof came to a point when concealment was never possible. Constant contact and association with almost countless people to find out things we wanted to know and to get things we then needed necessarily exposed me to the hazard to which a guerrilla's life was subject. It was hard then to ascertain who of the many people I have contacted were with us in the cause and who were not. Those who were not with us must have played the trick. And so the inevitable came. A wanted man I became and a wanted man I remained in San Juan, Rizal, the place I sought as refuge.

Before I left Marikina, for San Juan, Rizal, I reported to our Headquarters at Antipolo mountain. There I was informed of my promotion to Second Lieutenant and at the same time designated as Organizer Officer of "LIMBAS SECTOR" in San Juan, Rizal. (Please refer to attached Exh. "E").

ORGANIZATION OF THE SAN JUAN ERMITAÑO UNIT, LIMBAS SECTOR. - As Organizer Officer and in compliance with the instructions accompanying my designation, I immediately organized the Cubao, Kamuning, Tatalon, and Salapang Units. Even before my designation as Organizer Officer, I had already, though tentatively, formed these units as early as 8 February 1944, together with the San Juan Ermitaño Unit.

PARTICULAR ACTIVITIES OF THE SAN JUAN ERMITAÑO UNIT.

On 20 September 1944, I was, by 44th (HUNTERS) Division Special Order No. 45-b, assigned to the 44th Division, 4th MD, and instructed to be on duty as Commander of SAN JUAN SUPPLY UNIT, 44th Division. (Please refer to Exh. "F")

Following such instruction, I assumed command of my unit. I ordered my men to gather whatever firearms and ammunitions were available so that they could be delivered to our Headquarters in Antipolo for the immediate use of our men. These firearms and ammunitions totaling 15 rifles, 5 pistols of 45 calibre, and about 4,000 rounds of ammunitions of different calibers, were taken from members and non-members of the organization who were able to conceal them. In addition to these firearms and ammunitions, my men also succeeded in securing about 500 sacks of rice during the period from 20 September 1944 up to the day of liberation. The following sum of money in Japanese Military notes were given to and received by Major Ernesto Tupas (who was rescued from the Muntinglupa Bilbid Prisons by co-guerrillas) in the amount of P10,000.00 and Major Dado Montes in the amount of P15,000.00.

In October 1944, our unit, San Juan Ermitaño Unit, took charge of evacuating an entire company of the General Service Troops (G.S.T.) of the Philippine Constabulary of the puppet government, with all their arms and equipments. These constabulary soldiers deserted their post and joined our guerrilla unit in the Antipolo mountains. While in transit from their post to the Antipolo mountains, the San Juan Ermitaño Unit under my command provided them with the necessary supply of rice, dried fish, and money. ☞

In November 1944, our first set back designed perhaps to test the mettle of our men, the firmness of their resolve, and the courage of their heart, came. As was always possible, the Japanese Kempeis, through the instrumentality of some "Makapilis" rounded up our unit resulting in the arrest of twenty seven of our men, who inevitably found their way to Fort Santiago. Of this number all were tortured and final-executed except four who, through Divine help and will, escaped the gallows. In spite of this morale-destroying casualties, the remaining members of our unit did not falter in their firm resolve to carry on. This state of things may be attributed first, to the ever increasing hatred to the Japanese and second, to the unswerving loyalty and devotion to a cause that is more than worth anybody's life. At this time, as in times past, we were in possession of the knowledge of the tremendous advance made by the Allies in this theater of operation. It was this knowledge that encouraged every man in the unit to work harder than ever before especially in the vital and very indispensable task of securing and making available for the use of the different units food supplies and other provisions. I said vital and indispensable because in those dark days of 1944, such items of necessity were as scarce and as hard to secure as never before in the history of the country. There were very very few even among the well-to-do who could, without detriment to their/selves part with what would now be considered a very trifling amount. And so, considering this circumstance, our men have to double their efforts to get by whatever means and at whatever ~~cost~~ these items of necessity.

The Rizalde Trigger Unit of the R.O.T.C. made contact with us and requested supplies. We were able to give them Japanese notes amounting to P40,000.00.

During the months of December 1944 and January 1945, our line of communication with our Headquarters at Antipolo was cut due to the fact that all way leading to it from our sector became heavily guarded by Japanese sentries. Nevertheless, we continued with our intelligence work taking note as always of movements of enemy troops in anticipation of a possible chance to relay the information to our Headquarters so that it may in turn transmit it to the command concerned.

When, on 5 February 1945, the forces of liberation started entering Manila and the Japanese remaining garrisons in the City commenced, presumably under orders from their respective commanders, to wipe out the civilian population and destroy civilian properties before retreating, we armed ourselves, and as an organized body sallied forth in defense of these helpless civilians. Our activities then were confined in San Juan, Rizal, where retreating Japanese soldiers began the massacre of civilians irrespective of age or sex and wherever found. Not being able to suffer seeing and witnessing such man's inhumanity to men, we in our unit, after occupying a vantage position on 7 February 1945, opened fire at a company of Japanese soldiers at the San Juan new reservoir. In this encounter ten of the men in our unit gallantly died in action. They were: Jesus Reyes, Eustaquio Cruz, Zacarias Benedicto, Francisco Dixon, Ireneo Reyes, Francisco Libita, Antonio Libita, Toriano Mangahas, Santos Mangahas, and one whose name I no longer remember. This list of casualties has already been duly recorded and reported to our Headquarters and forwarded to the AFWESPAC.

On 8 February 1945, our unit met the American First Cavalry Division at Broadway street, New Manila, and guided them to the unmined roads leading to San Juan, Rizal. We joined the American troops in the mopping up operation in the town. From San Juan we led the American soldiers to Mandaluyong and it was there that they instructed us to return to San Juan. Upon reaching San Juan, we met the Bomb Disposal Unit of the American First Cavalry and aided them in their job of locating and disposing off bombs and other explosives by pointing and indicating to them the mines planted by the Japanese from N. Domingo street to Pinaglabanan street and the White Cross building. From then on we continued reporting to our Headquarters which was transferred to Tagaytay, Cavite, and there we resumed receiving orders from time to time until the question of recognition of <sup>our</sup> unit came up. Since then we held series of conferences where ways and means of having our unit recognized were discussed. Hence, the present proceedings for recognition.

A BRIEF STORY OF THE ACTIVITIES AGAINST THE JAPS IN  
PHILIPPINES. By. JESUAN HEROSA

It was on June 23, 1943 that Mr. Antonio Bado a close friend of mine told me that an organization was founded here in San Juan, Rizal. This was to fight for the freedom of our country which was by that time occupied by the Japs. invaders. The name of this organization is the Centers of R.O.T.C. Guerrillas, because I want to serve my country. I joined the organization. This organization was founded by General Terry Adevoso Magtanggol.

Lt. Antonio Bado told me to pick or choose some men who could serve our country. He assigned me to do intelligence work which I like very much. I told him I had a little experience because I was with Lt. Comdr. Henson and Capt. Bravial before the start of the war helping them investigating crimes committed against sailors by crooks in the city.

JULY, 1943 - My work was to give complete details of important places where we can get arms and munitions. All report was submitted to Lt. Antonio Bado.

AUGUST, 1943 - A complete report was given to Lt. Bado of all activities of those Japs spies or Filipino Mil. Police. Unfortunately Lt. Antonio Bado was arrested and sentence and later on was deported to Mindanao.

SEPT. OCT. and Nov. 1943 -- By this months I have to follow all instructions given to me by Lt. A. Bado to shadow all Japs. Spies in San Juan, Navikins, and Manila.

DECEMBER, 1943 -- Met Capt. Reynaldo Bernal and gave all reports of the past investigation I have done.

JANUARY, 1944 - Capt. Reynaldo Bernal and other companions and I was chased by the Japs. Military Police in N. Dononga St. when we came from a mission.

Capt. Beltran became traitor and arrested many of our men and he was always saying that he was going to clean Manila and San Juan of all guerillas. This report was given to Capt. Reynaldo Bernal.

- Feb. 1944 - Encounters with Filipino Military Police can not be avoided, here in San Juan who were giving all details to Japs Military Police of the activities of the guerillas. And on Feb. 28, 1944, my brother Lt. Conrado Edrosa, and intelligence of Colonel Feralta of the Vissayas was arrested and tortured to death.
- Mar. 1944 - Capt. Reynaldo Bernal introduced me to Capt. Inteco (Dodo) who by that time was very active here in San Juan and Manila, harassing Japanese spies.
- April 1944 - Help Capt Reynaldo Bernal and Capt. Inteco (Dodo) to collect funds, from Mr. Pedro Santos, Mr. Pedro Vera, Cecilio Noble, Mr. A. Lingco, Mrs. Marcela Artiaga, Mr. Rogelio de la Rosa, Mr. Lucas Paderna, Mrs. Alejandra Vda. de Johnson and Mr. Calixto Duño.
- May 1944 - Collect funds and medicines for persons in Laguna.
- June 1944 - Help, Capt. Reynaldo Bernal and our contacts who were wanted by the Japanese Military Police in hiding in my hut in S. Tulaño St., San Juan, Rizal and reported all reports of the Japanese activities.
- July and Aug. 1944 - We lay low because of the sanctification of places like Malabon, Quezon City and Mandaluyon.
- Sept. and Oct. 1944 - Lt. Ernesto Estrella and I helped Capt. Reynaldo Bernal in collecting funds and round all areas in San Juan and Manila for the purpose of helping our comrades in Laguna.
- Nov. 1944 - Lt. Ernesto Estrella, Lt. Arsenio Luna, Cpl. Geronias Valentin and I escaped the Japanese Military Police when they searched Babrio Once, San Juan, Rizal. We were then wanted. Lt. Arsenio Luna and others proceeded to Laguna while Lt. Ernesto Estrella and I stayed in Manila to continue intelligence work.
- Dec. 1944 - Japanese Military Police were very active and we had a very hard time in going from one place to another as they sanctified small towns and even hotels for guerillas.
- Jan. 1945 - Lt. Ernesto Estrella and I reported the evacuation of the Japanese Army going to the North and all places which were kind in Manila and San Juan. I gave full warnings to the civilians of the activities of the Japanese, such as rounding civilians for enforced labor. By that time the evacuees from Laguna had a hard time before they can reach Manila, because of sentries posted in all places. Capt. Beltran with some Jap soldiers shot one of the pilot who landed here in San Juan. Capt. Beltran boasted that

that he will clean the whole San Juan and Manila of guerrillas. This report was given to Major Reynaldo Bernal.

Feb.

Feb. 1, 1945 -

It. Ernesto Estrella and I gave the full report Maj. Reynaldo Bernal that the Japanese Military Police were already gone with the troops and the city was already free and the guerrillas continued their activities. Many, some parts of San Juan and Mandalayon had only few Japanese soldiers. Intraburo, Sta. Cruz are the places only which had many troops who were preparing to meet the invaders who were our allies. Feb. 4, 1945 the invasion of Manila and Feb. 4, 1945 occupation of San Juan and on March 25, 1945. I was commissioned by Major Reynaldo Bernal to act in the name of the Intelligence of U. S. A. and by that time Manila and San Juan were already occupied by the American troops.

Feb. 3, 1945 -

It. Ernesto Estrella and I entered one of the former office of the Japanese Military Police at the end of Munga Ave. and found important pictures of the Filipino Resistance spies, and gave them to Major Reynaldo Bernal with their names and addresses.

Complete activities I accomplished.


