 - 2. ALLEGED HISTORY: See attached unit file.
 - 3. FINDINGS:

Col Adevoso has agreed in writing to withdraw all of his units from the files pending investigation and to waive all rights of any further claims of the Hunters, with the exception of casualties and the Bisumi Fighters. (See attached certificate by Col Adevoso).

- 4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: This unit appears to have no political aspirations or affiliations.
 - 5. RECOMMENDATIONS:

Recommend that the Medical and Women's Auxiliary Corps be not favorably considered for recognition.

Subject: RECOGNITION? Request for : The CHIEF GUERRILLA AFFAIR SECTION, AFFAC

1. Request that the Medical and Women's Auxiliary Corps of the Binan Emergency Hospital be entitled to recognition for the following reasons:

A. Said Medical and Women's Sauthiary Corps has been an active and necessary unit in the functions of the U. S. Army during the period of liberation. Said unit took care of the welfare of the masses, giving first aid, medical care, feeding and rehabilitation of somewhere around 40,000 civilian evacuees.

B. Said Medical and Women's Auxiliary Corps has functioned under the 48th. Regt. prior to the arrival of the U. S, Army to the southern provinces of Manila.

Said unit functioned purely as a non-profit organization receiving nothing for its services.

Said unit greatly helped the come-rade in arms and civilian evacuees from the massacered areas of the Provinces of Laguna and Batangas.

With the arrival of PCAU No. 2 U. S. Army in their sector, said unit were recognized and given regular supplies of medicine and food for their patients.

Request that the MEDICAL and WOMEN'S AUXILIARY CORPS of the BINAN MERGARICY MOSTIAL be given priority for recognition by the Philippine Army based on the following reasons.

1. That we belong to the 48th Inf. Regt., 47th Division of the HUNTERS or ROTG GUERILLAS under Lt. Col. Jose Bourbon.

2. That we are entitled for the said recognation like the other members of the organization.

3. That we gave medical care to all Guerilla organizations, and civilian casualties from the massacered areas of Laguna and Batangas province prior to the arrival of the UNITED STATES ARMY in this sector.

4. That we have accomplished our duties as part of the 46th Inf. Regt., 47th Division HUNTERS OF ROTE GUERILLAS, and had worked with FOAU 2, UNITED STATES ARITY without compensation.

Enclosed herewith are the supporting papers for our claims.

48th Inf. Regt. , 47th Division HIRTERS or ROTC GUERILLAS

On 4 February 1945 the 48th Inf. Regt. HUNTERS or ROTC GUERGLAS under Lt. Col. Jose Bourbon entered the town of Biffan Laguna and drove the Japanese out of their garrison. Together with this unit was the Regimentel Aid Station to give medical treatment to the sick and wounded guerilla members. As the 48th Inf. Regt. push towards the town of Cabuyao and Calamba Laguna encountering Japanese troops, many civilian casaualties poured into our Regimental Aid Sta-

tion. On 11 February 1945 I suggested to Lt. Col. Jose Bourbon that we need a emergency hospital to housed the increasing guarillas and civilian casualties. Our request was granted, and the Lake High School building of Billan Laguna, was used for the said purpose.

On 12 February 1945, the Womens Auxillary Corp was organized out of the fair sex who volunteered to help the Medical Company in its effort to cope

with the situation. On 17 February 1945, the BIRAN MINIGERRY HOSFITAL under the Medical and

Womens Auxiliary Corps, begun to function inspite of the insufficient supply of medicine, food, and equipments. The Relief Section of the Auxiliary Corp have a house to house compaign for voluntary contributions to support the hospital, The people gave a warm response, so that whatever aid they gave was a step toward our success. The Mursing Section did their job by helping the Medical Staffin the hespital 24 hours daily. However, due to the great number of evacuoes from the nieghboring towns and provinces, the Relief workers helped them solved their housing problems, by alloting and looking for wacant houses for them to stay temperarily. Food and clothing were also distributed to those who are in need.

On 4 March 1945, two weeks after the Billian Emergency Respital has started to function independently, utilizing whatever supply they had gathered from the town people, the UNITED STATES ARMY, followed by FOALWY, arrived in Water Virgil Asheraft to give us medical and food supplies for the maintainance our request was granted, From that day, we received regular supplies of medi-BIRAN MERCENCY HOSPITAL and entrusted to its personnels the job of rehabllitating the townpeople and evacuees from the massacred areas of Laguna and Botoness, thus serving as their only station for this town. - 1. CRGANIZATION: The 48th Hunters Regt of Lt Col Boris or BOURBON had for its area of operation the towns, barrios, and fields of San Pedro Tursaes, Minan, Sta Rosa, Osbuyao, Carmona, and Bacood of west lagues and Esat Cavite. Regt Hg had always been in the Carmons area. During the occupation there were organized troops in the towns and barrios and always regular combat troops in the hills. Town units supported the mountain regular troops and provided a supplyof mempower for training and combat duties on a rotation system. The 48th Regt HQ was responsible to the 47th DIVISION HQ in turn was responsible to the GRAY IN TOWN THE AND THE MAN THE AND THE AND THE AND THE STRAIN STUDEN. BETANKES Under undersigned. The MAN & HOSTITAL UNIT is an element of the BINAN OF BLUE LAKE BATTALION of the 48th Regt.
- 2. As far as I could remember, the Blue Lake Battalion was organized in OCTORER 1944 so that possibly the WAG & Hospitalunit must have been organized at the same date. It consisted of the best proffessionalmaterials from the town.
- 5. OPERATIONS: During the occupation (Oct '44 to Jan'45) the principal duties of this WAG & Hospital Unit were as follows:
 - a- canvassing of medical & food supplies and also money from among the town population and sending same to BN and REG'TL HQS where members serving active tours needed them.
 - b- Collecting, evaluating, and sending information on Jay strengths and disposition, movements, armaments, etc. to REGT'L HQS in Carmona mts. Running messenger errands.
 - c- Care andhospitalization right in town of sick men taken down from the mountains. The mountains of Carmona-Silang where the combat and regular troops stayed were treacherous for their malarial mosquitoes.
 - d- WHEN the American 11th A/B Division struck the beaches at MASUGH, BATAMAS on 31Jan 1945, 6HQ HUNTERS ordered all Hunters-ROTC Units andother units cooperating under it to STRIKE. The combat troops of the 48th Regiment under Lt Col BURBON assisted by HQS troops from the 47th DIVISION HQS offit Gol Coampo immedistely attacked all Jap garrisons and/MKAPILI concentrations in all towns within the regimental sector, is: Gabuyao, 5t a Rosa, Binsn, San Pedro, Carmora, Bacood, and even ran after the Japa as far as Muntinglups where the Japa escaped in bate by benca across the Lagua de Bey to the other side of the Bay. At this juncture the MAC #Hospital Unit of the BULE LAKE BN, just like similar units of other battalions of the 48th Regt., came out into the open. They occupied a long low stone building as their unit HQS and hospital.

e- During the Battle for SOURLERN MANIL & E- During the Battle for SOURLERN MANIL & accommodated in the ROTC hospitals in Bacod, Las Pins, Parrio Cupang, and Muntingings Bill bid Prisons were slawys taken to BINAN WAC & Hospital Unit for care and hospitalization. This hospital with a capacity of possibly 50-40 beds took care of civilian casualties and guerrille casualties allies. In fact most of the patients were the victums of the CAIAMRA-STO TOWAS-RAY-ICC MANCS massacre of the Japs. At that time too, a RADPLCKK composed or ROTC guerrilse was established satride the CABUNAO-CAIAMRA ROAD to prevent an enemy attack from that time for a RADPLCKK composed or CAIAMRA which was then still occupied territory as inst the lith A/B Division Rear. The lith DIV then had thrown its full force against Weikinley and where Southern Manila and had to rely on guerrillas to protect its flanks and rear. The WAC & Hospital unit took care of all casualties from the Image guerrilla force composing the readlocks.

Ft Mokinley finally terminated, the 11th Airborne Division with its complement of guerrilla forces turned about and %ixiaxked drove southered passing through the 46th Regt area. Casualties from Los Banos and eastern Betangas towns beganpouring into the hospital and other 48th Regt hospitals at a renewed xxxx rate.

g-Aside from taking care of guerrilla and civilian casualties the MAC & Hospital Units also took care of refugeer from Japheld territories. There were thousands of such refugees that flooded the 48th Regiment area that were taken cared of either by this unit or some other similar units of the Hunters.

h- This unit was disbanded possibly in May 1945 as per order of GHQ Hunters-ROTG sometime in April 1945.

4. SUPPLIES: Supplies sent by this unit during the occupation to the BM & REGOT! LHGS in the hills were canvassed from civilian supporters or from amongst themselves. Supplies such as food, clothings, and medicines used by this unit during the liberation campaignof February-Waxrid&Ext Merch '45 were requisitioned from the people and local stocks or were captured from the Japaness stocks. Supplies, etc. used by the unit for the care of refugees during April & May 1945 were supplied by the PCAU. This unit was reconsized by the PCAU altho not paid as it was understood that it was a unit of guerrilles.

5. OSSERVATION: Aside from the ROTO Unit Hospital in the BILIBID PRIBONS, the Biran WAO's hospital was the best I had seen during the liberation camps ign of Feb-way '45. There were hospitals in LAS PINAS, BACCOD, CURANN, STA ROSA, CABUNAO, NAIO, INDAMAN, TAGATHAY, MASURUBU during the campaign prior to the Fall of Manilabut this one was among the best ran and best manned. I believe that it sumber is justifiable. During one of the inspections I conducted I believe that I had met about 70 0's and EM in the propital. The rest of the staff may have been outside taking care of the refugees THEN.

She is a lawyer here in Manila. I contacted here originally on approx. 29 May 46. She said that Borja worked somewhere here in Manila but she did not know where. However she said she would find out through mutual friends and let me know immediately so an investigation of the unit could be conducted. The did not call or write for over a week. About a week from the original contact date I was passing through Binan so 1 stopped to see her She was not there but I left a written message with her husband to contact me as soos as possible, Nothing happened, Approx, 20 June 46 I sent Sgt, Sebastian Songsong to Binan to contact her and have her call me.
