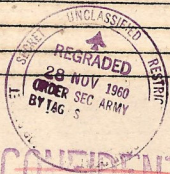

Your Honor:

I, the undersigned for and in behalf of myself and my companions have taken the liberty and audacity to address to your good offices this letter with the humble desire that proper representations be made for the just cause we are fighting for, which is, none other than our guerrilla recognition.

This kind of request may be very common in your office but I hope that with the little explanation I am making our case will turn out to be different even if it be in certain aspects only. We are all civilian guerrillas who have joined in 1943 the Western Pangasinan Guerrilla Unit under the late Captain Charles U. Putnam, which was later re-designated as the 2nd and 3rd regiments, Pan - gasinan Tarlac Military District under the over-all command of Col. ^{CL} Edwin P. Ramsey, ELCA. We have been in continuous service in the underground resistance movement from our induction to the time we have been discharged from the active service for the convenience of the government.

All of us have been given our corresponding serial numbers in the Philippine Army, and we have also our special orders and discharge certificates. Likewise, we have received our current initial pays including differential allowances for periods specified in our discharge papers.

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However, the irony of it all is the fact that our papers re, claim for back pay with the Philippine Army Branch, Living Claims Section, Recovered Personnel Division, PHILRYCOH, APO 900, have not been given due consideration or in effect have been denied on the ground that our names have not been carried in any recognized roster of the PTMD.

We have been processed at Camp Ord, Tarlac, before we have been reverted to inactive status. All evidence of our individual induction into the PTMD, and services in the same have been submitted to the processing officer, such as certificates from our immediate commanding officer and affidavits of our co-enlisted men, which now make up our 201 files at RPD.

When informed of the unfavorable action of the Recovered Personnel Branch on our claims we took the pains of verifying our individual military records. We have made representations to Major Concepcion of the Returns Division, HNDP, Camp Murphy, to Lt. Conrado Mangonon, one of our officers, to Major Jesus Vargas who signed our discharge certificates to help explain why our claims should not be favorably considered. None of them could give us a satisfactory answer. These officers even wrote to each other about our cases but their acts were all shrouded with mystery. When Major Jesus Vargas was pressed to give us certificates on which we could pass as legitimate members of the PTMD he informed us that he cannot do it now. However, he gave us the assurance that he can explain our case when directed by the Guerrilla Affairs Division (G-3), PHILRYCOH. This shows that to a certain extent Major Vargas know

something material in our case which he did not deem proper to disclose to us.

What appears to be very ridiculous to us now is the fact that from our return to military control we have enjoyed all the privileges of recognized guerrilla soldiers. To reiterate, we were allotted serial numbers, we were processed and discharged from active service in the Armed Forces.

How then can we be discharged from the Army when from the very beginning we have not been recognized or have been given the status of a legitimate member of a recognized guerrilla unit? Does it mean that induction or recognition follow discharge from the Army? Why did officers of the Philippine Army process us for our claims for arrears in pay if our claims were not backed by evidence sufficient according to the policy of the Army? We believe that it has always been the policy of the Recovered Personnel Division to process only those whose names are carried in recognized rosters, and to that effect those who were not recognized were made to file application for individual recognition with G-3 PHILRYCOM.

We still believe in the justness of our case. We are members of the PTMD from the very time of its organization. If our companions have already reaped the benefits of our common sacrifices in the name of freedom, is it just that we be made to suffer in vain? If it is true that our names were not carried in any roster of the Pangasinan Tarlac Military District, then our Commanding Officer must be investigated. This is an obvious anomaly on the part of those officers of our Unit who were charged with submitting the roster of our unit. We also believe that the dis-

charge certificate issued to us by the army upon our discharge from the service is not just a piece of paper without any evidentiary value.

Only recented the undersigned have received a notice of call from the Headquarters Philippine Army, that in case of a second notice I must report to the unit designated by them for duty, on the ground that since I was a member of a recognized guerrilla outfit (PTMD), my service experience with this unit is tantamount to a military training prescribed by the National Defense Law, and therefore, a member of the reserve force. Here is an assumption that I am a member of a legitimate guerrilla organization that have been recognized. Yet my claim for recognition have been negatively considered for reason that I am not or that we are not members of the Pangasinan Tarlac Military District. Other companions of mine have also received such notices, but the fact remains that RPD cannot consider our claims.

In view of the above we sincerely believe that your offices are the only ones that can give us our rightful shares in this matter, and we have faith in hoping that you will not let us down because all of you are believers of the principle that you must always right the wrong before it is too late.

We are submitting herewith certified copies of our special orders, discharge certificates, affidavit from the Commanding Officer of our Unit, and other special orders to show our attachment with the army. Should further evidence of guerrilla activity be desired we humbly would refer any interested party to check on our indivi-

That I was inducted into the Guerrilla Forces of the Commonwealth of the Philippines on 17 July 1943 at San Carlos, Pangasinan, by the late Captain Charles U. Putnam, then Commanding Officer of the Western Pangasinan Military District, East Central Luzon Guerrilla Area under the overall command of Lt. Col. Edwin P. Ramsey, U.S. Army, with the rank of 1st Lieutenant and assigned as Intelligence Officer of the 2nd Pangasinan Regiment, Western Pangasinan Military District, later I was promoted to Captain and assigned as Deputy (Executive Officer) Commanding Officer of the said guerrilla unit, and finally assumed command of said unit upon the execution by the Japanese of Captain Charles U. Putnam on or about 19 March 1944;

That when the Western Pangasinan Military District, ECLGA, was fused with the Tarlac ECLGA units, the resulting organization was redesignated Pangasinan-Tarlac Military District, ECLGA, I was assigned the Chief of Staff, with Col. Luis A. That at the time the transfer of the foregoing persons was made from the PTMD, ECLGA, to the GHQ, ECLGA, they were not yet attached to any American Army using unit for which reason their names do not appear in any of the recognized rosters of the sub-units of the PTMD, ECLGA, the procedure of attachment to, and recognition, by the U.S. Army was for the U.S. Army unit concerned to requisition from guerrilla units the number of guerrilla personnel they wanted to attach and recommend for recognition, and that not all the members of the guerrilla unit from which the guerrilla soldiers were furnished were all recognized;

That the request of GHQ, ECLGA, for drivers and mechanics was welcomed by the Commanding Officer of PTMD, ECLGA, as a chance to their attachment and consequent recognition as the GHQ, ECLGA, was duly attached and recognized by the 6th Army, USA, and said GHQ, ECLGA, was constructing roads and other installations in the Camp at Bayambang, Pangasinan, and the drivers were used to drive the trucks in hauling gravel and other ^{supplies and} materials from different sources;


That since the various dates of induction of the above-mentioned enlisted men, they were continuously on guerrilla duty in their respective PTMD sub-units, and continuously again from their assignment to the GHQ, ECLGA, until their demobilization at the 2nd Replacement Battalion, PA, APO 70, some in Camp Bayambang, Pangasinan, and others in Camp J.B. Ord, Tarlac, Tarlac, receiving their current pay for the duration of their services with the GHQ, ECLGA, but no salary whatever was paid to them for any of their previous guerrilla services;

That the service records of said enlisted men appear in their processing papers which must now be in the Recovered Personnel Division of Philycoom;







The overall strength of the ECLGA as of 15 May 1942 was approximately 33 officers and 395 EM; as of 31 September 1942 was approximately 315 officers and 2,184 EM; as of 31 December 1942 was approximately 863 officers and 7,006 EM; as of 30 June 1943 was approximately 1,241 officers and 10,513 EM; as of 31 December 1943 was approximately 2,040 officers and 21,832 EM; as of 30 June 1944 was approximately 2,823 officers and 30,228 EM; as of 31 December 1944 was approximately 3,606 officers and 38,624 EM; as of 31 June 1945 was approximately 3,700 officers and 39,500 EM. The above figures include casualties. Strengths indicated, by official rosters, of Headquarters Philippine Army as approved by Headquarters, USAFFE; Headquarters, 6th Army, and Headquarters, AFWESPAC, with the period of service of the individuals not to commence prior to their dates of inductions as shown on the individual reprocessing 201 files in the possession of the Recovered Personnel Division, AGO, AFWESPAC, will not be exceeded in determining personnel entitled to pay. Overall strengths mentioned above indicate maximum figures that will not be exceeded.

4. No commissioned ranks above that of captain are authorized prior to 1 January 1944 with the exception of those USAFFE officers, in the rank of captain and above, who were given original appointments with an increase of one grade above their army ranks. Subsequent to 1 January 1944 ranks of officers, commensurate with their command or staff functions and based upon the tables of organization of a US Infantry Division, less one grade, are authorized

a. Recognition as mentioned in paragraph 1, above, is limited to payments of those units listed that served on the Island of Luzon with the ECLGA.

b. All civilians recruited by or inducted into the ECLGA subsequent to 15 May 1942 are considered to have become members of the Philippine Army, served with the Armed Forces of the United States with entitlement to pay subsequent to that date.

6. The East Central Luzon Guerrilla Area has never printed any script for its operational expenditures, depending almost entirely upon donations in kind from the civilian population for sustenance. No personnel, either officer or enlisted, received any pay from the time of its inception on 15 May 1942, until the recognition of those units of ECLGA by attachment. Personnel were then paid current pay.





1. Section I, General Order #197, issued by H.P.A., dated 17 October 1945, directs the disbandment of G.H.Q., ECLGA, effective 21 October 1945. Section II of the above mentioned General Order directs that personnel assigned and/or attached to the G.H.Q. will be attached unassigned to the 2d Replacement Battalion (PA) not later than 20 October 1945, Section III of the same order directs that equipment of the G.H.Q., ECLGA, shall be turned over to the Commanding Officer, 4th Camp Complement concurrent with the movement directed per Section II.

2. As of 7 November 1945, forty-five (45) officers and sixty-one (61) enlisted men have reported to the 2d Replacement Battalion. The total number due to report is not known, nor has information been made available from H.P.A. upon request, but it is believed that this is not the total number, although ECLGA maintains that it is.

3. Equipment has been turned in to the 4th Camp Complement, but it is rather obvious from the lists that it is excess and unserviceable equipment. It appears that the balance has been transferred to lower echelons, the transaction possibly being post-dated. The records of vehicles of ECLGA are a complicated situation which, to my knowledge, has never been entirely unravelled by anyone. In fact, it is dubious whether it can be unravelled. At present, however, some vehicles of the G.H.Q. have been turned over to the Pangasinan-Tarlac Military District, which is a subordinate unit of ECLGA, some have been turned over to the 4th Camp Complement and the remainder seem to have been signed over to individual officers.

4. In an interview with Col. Villa-Real, Commanding Officer, ECLGA, Lt. Doll and I received the impression that while the G.H.Q. of ECLGA is closed on paper, its functions, responsibility and command have merely been shifted to the Pangasinan-Tarlac Military District, from which headquarters Col. Villa-Real is operating in Dagupan.

5. It is the opinion of this task unit that some supervision should be given ECLGA and investigations made as to why the meaning of General Order #197 has been so evaded. To this end, it is suggested that qualified inspectors be sent from H.P.A. with American Army advisors to ascertain the true situation. Action could then be taken which would be more successful.

6. The records of G-4, ECLGA, have been turned over to the 4th Camp Complement and forwarded by them to H.P.A. In the meantime, ECLGA units are continuing to draw supplies in their lower echelons.

7. It will be noted that none of the provisions of General Order #197 were complied with by the time specified in the order.

8. The undersigned officer realized that this report is far from complete, however to obtain complete information and data would require an experienced team of inspectors who could spend the necessary time on investigating all phases of the situation.
