Dear Mr. Abrencia:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the MP Detachment "C" Company, 1st Battalion, 3rd Pangasinan Regiment, PTMD, ECLGA, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your nominal control, is not favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating records and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

- a. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
- b. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field in opposition to the enemy.
- c. Activities of the unit did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy.
- d. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization.
- e. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.
- f. Many members apparently lived at home, supporting their families by means of farming or other civilian pursuits, and assisted the guerrilla unit on a part time basis only.

It is desired to emphasize that each claimant member

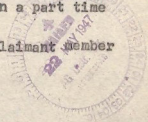

of the unit is considered to have had just and adequate appraisal for recognition when his services were evaluated concurrently with this study of the unit with which he claims membership. Individual requests were not necessary nor appropriate then, or now, as their acceptance would in effect constitute unjustified duplication of consideration of one individual by this headquarters. However, this does not preclude submission for casualty recognition by those individuals who are qualified and feel justified in entering such claims. Upon request by interested individuals appropriate forms will be forwarded.

Report on MP Detachment "C" Co, 1st Bn, 3rd
Pangasinan Regiment PTMD, ECLGA

1. 1st Lt Kenneth H. Neubauer examined this unit's file on 20 May 1947 and deemed a field investigation unnecessary.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See attached Unit File)

3. FINDINGS:

a. The following person was interviewed and his statement is reflected in the findings:

Capt Benigno G. Tabora Jr., G-3 Guerrilla Affairs Div.

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. This unit's claim to be a guerrilla unit is completely refuted by a letter from Overton F. Harris, Lt Col AC, (Res) (Incl #1). Pedro B. Abrencia, claimant CO of the subject unit, has asked for the recognition of 105 guerrillas for services allegedly rendered the U. S. Army. Col Harris specifically states that his organization used but 17 persons, 16 enlisted and one officer, a 2nd Lt. These 17 men were hired as "civilian watchmen" and were duly compensated for their labors (Incl #1). Their primary duties were to keep natives from the squadron area. It is very apparent these "civilian watchmen" cannot be classified as guerrillas. Apparently Capt Abrencia decided to join the guerrilla movement late in 1944. (Incl #2). He assumed command of a unit which had members who claimed to have joined the movement back in 1942. Capt Benigno G. Tabora Jr., who was a member of the 1st Pangasinan Regiment ECLGA and who is very familiar with the guerrilla activities in this area, stated that he had never heard of the MP Detachment of "C" Company 1st Battalion, 3rd Pangasinan Regiment engaging in any guerrilla activities. It is the investigating officer's belief, viewing the evidence presented by Col Harris and the evidence submitted in the unit file, that this organization was not a bona-fide guerrilla unit, but simply a group of civilians employed by the U. S. Army, and who were duly paid for their efforts by the U. S. Government.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field. This unit consisted of civilians employed by the U. S. Government and therefore cannot be classified as guerrillas.

d. Activities did not contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. The few members of this unit

that were used by the U. S. Government were used primarily as civilian watchmen to guard a reconnaissance unit against pilferage and looting by the native population.

e. Unit did not show satisfactory continuity of activity and organization. The small number of members used by the U. S. Forces is the only evidence of activity by this organization and it is not guerrilla activity. The number of men claimed by this unit as guerrillas far exceeds the number actually used by the U. S. Forces (Incl #1).

f. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of civilian occupation. The efforts of this unit are conclusively civilian pursuits in which they were fully compensated.

g. There are no worthy members and the unit suffered no casualties.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: This unit does not appear to have any political affiliations or aspirations.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the MP Detachment, "C" Co, 1st Battalion, 3rd Pangasinan Regiment PTMD, ECLGA consisting of 105 men be not favorably considered for recognition.

Dear Sir:

Your letter dated 30 April 1947 received.

The personnel from the Guerrilla Unit, Company C, 1st Bn, 3rd Pangasinan Regiment, attached to the 17th Reconnaissance Squadron were entered on the civilian labor payroll with the understanding that an adjustment in pay would be made when the unit was recognized as a federalized unit. They were paid as civilian watchmen.

The date on which the detachment was released is not known by myself as I left the theater for the states in July 1945. The Guerrilla Guard Detachment was probably retained until the latter part of August 1945. The 17th Reconnaissance Squadron was moved out of the islands about that time. It was not intended to retain the Philippine guard upon movement. I suggest you write to 17th Bomb Squadron, 5th Air Force, Japan, for information as to date of release.

The number of Philippine personnel from Company C was approximately sixteen (16) enlisted men and one (1) officer, a 2nd Lieutenant. The roster remained constant as I would not permit a rotation of personnel. Their primary duty was to keep natives from the squadron area. In regard to the number of personnel, the Adjutant of Company C submitted monthly payroll lists, not less than six (6) copies, listing all personnel. This was done for the purpose of future recognition. The 3rd Pangasinan Regiment should have these lists. They were verified by my signature or the signature of some other officer of the squadron. They were signed by Major Edwin P. Ramsey.

Company "C", 1st Battalion, 3rd Pangasinan Regiment, PTMD, ECLGA has made request for guerrilla recognition to this office through its then commanding officer, Maj Emilio C. Hilario. As supporting evidence Maj Hilario has submitted an attachment order (Incl #1) and a certificate (Incl #2) signed by you. The attachment order is dated 19 May 1945 but does not show the date on which the unit was relieved from its attachment and duties nor does it show the strength of the unit. A roster of one hundred and five (105) men was submitted by the unit's regimental commander which purports to show the number of men of the unit who were attached to the 17th Reconnaissance Squadron (B) APO 707.

In order that proper disposition may be made of the unit it is requested that you submit the following information, if possible:

1. Information as to whether the guerrilla unit was paid as civilian laborers by the Reconnaissance Squadron.
2. Date on which unit was released from attachment.
3. Number of personnel of the unit who were used by the squadron as interior guards or for other missions.



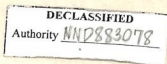
