

1. On 21 April 1945, Capt S. C. Buchanan and lst Lt Jaime H. Mansano traveled to the provinces of Paganga and Batean to contact four subordinate unit commanders of the BUGGA. The mission was to deliver latters to the individuals concerned informing them that discrepancies existed between approved strengths unthorized for their particular organizations and the strengths of related rosters on hand. Fertiment data is shown in the following table:

- All the individuals were contacted with the exception of Andreas Migano whose whereabouts is unknown although runor has it that he is in the Visayan Islands and cannot return home for reasons of personal safety.
- 3. This significant that all three persons contacted (Gristobal, Fernandes and Remos) exhibited no surprise when apprised of the initial strengths authorized their units and all three (all interviewed seperately) volunteered the infromation that they did not submit the resters of their units for recognition purposes, but that "somebody" higher up took care of that little item. Fernandes stated that the names of many "bull cert" drivers were submitted along with the names of his "genuine" guerrillas. None of the three displayed overt reluctance to screen their resters to the proper figure.
