1. On 21 April 1948, Capt S. C. Buchanan and 1st Lt Jaime H. Mansano traveled to the provinces of Pampanga and Bataan to contact four subordinate unit commanders of the ECLGA. The mission was to deliver letters to the individuals concerned informing them that discrepancies existed between approved strengths authorized for their particular organizations and the strengths of related rosters on hand. Pertinent data is shown in the following table:

2. All the individuals were contacted with the exception of Andres Migano whose whereabouts is unknown although rumor has it that he is in the Visayan Islands and cannot return home for reasons of personal safety.

3. It is significant that all three persons contacted (Cristobal, Fernandez and Ramos) exhibited no surprise when apprised of the initial strengths authorized their units and all three (all interviewed separately) volunteered the information that they did not submit the rosters of their units for recognition purposes, but that "somebody" higher up took care of that little item. Fernandez stated that the names of many "bull cart" drivers were submitted along with the names of his "genuine" guerrillas. None of the three displayed overt reluctance to screen their rosters to the proper figure.

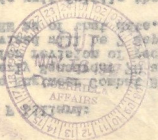

2. Attached hereto are:

a. Certificate, E.P. Ramsey, dtd 22 April 47, stating that Squadrons 70 and 71 were components of ECLGA, organized on 7 Sept 1942 by J.P. Boone and Capt L.M. Bell, and re-organized on 1 Jan 1944, per Ramseys orders, into the Engr Combat Bn, Bataan MD, ECLGA. Aforesaid Sqdns were rlv'd fr duty, Pampanga MD, ECLGA.

The Squadrons were organized in the Gutad, Dampo, Pampanga area were outstanding in their guerrilla services during the early days of guerrilla organization.

I further certify that on 1 Jan 1944, by order of Edwin Ransay, commanding officer of ECLGA, the two Squadrons were organized into the Engineer Combat Battalion under a new Table of Organization issued by that Headquarters.

The approximate strength of the Engineer Combat Battalion at the time of reorganization was 450 officers and men but during the Liberation only 300 men served and were attached to the US Army during the Zigzag campaign.

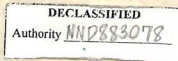
