- 1. Lt Peter R Betts and M/Sgt Frank Bernacki proceeded to Apelit, Pampanga, on 1 September 1946 to investigate the 3rd En. 5th Regt. Pampanga Military District, ECIGA.
 - 2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See unit file)
 - 3. FINDINGS:
- The following persons were interviewed and their statements are reflected in the findings:

- b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. Unit had no papers to support claims of intelli-gence and propagands work and suinitted only a roster and a history.
- c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field against the enemy or did its activities contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. The unit was formed late in 1944, hed only three wespons and had no combat duties during the occuration. During the Liberation the unit was in Ste Rita, but was never called upon to serve with an american unit and returned home after a month.
- d. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations as the majority of the members lived at home and carried on with their own various jobs.
- e. Col Ransey did not know enough about this unit to make a definite statement which he would have if the unit was active.
- 4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: The unit appears to have no political aspects. AFFILIATION OF ASPIRATIONAL.
- RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that this unit be not favorably considered for recognition.



2. This Battellion of the 5th Regiment, Fib. MIDA, was Srganized by sutherity of Lt. Col. P. 5. Patrox, Assistant Unief of Staff during the period from June to September, 1944 and the C and ZBA of this unit were formally inducted beginning September 1, 1944 (see column in rester for induction dates).

5. During the period from Gotober, 1944 to 15 December 1944, Officers of this Battalion dedicated themselves to nequiring fluences and supplies for this unit who were enoughed in the Gandac Swamps. Anti-Tepmenses activities of the unit consisted of espionage, anti-tpuppet propagada, destrination of short-wave news, control of civiliens in the area for purpose of evecuation, destruction of a battery of four (4) estimatority guarantees and the string end setting size of ten [10] boxes of rifle emmuni-tion during an American sir reid in December, 1944.

4. From 15 January to 17 January 1945, the unit was assembled at applit and elerted to move to join the other units or the Regiment and Division at Sente Atta, Pampanga.

5. On 18 January 1945, the unit marched ecross the Penpange plain and reached GHz, FD, at Sante Rite, Penpange on 19 January 1945, but not before a patrol annihilated six Jap stragglers and lost three of its men.
