Dear Mr. Getdula:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 6 May 1948, requesting information concerning the revision of the recognition date of the 5th Pampanga Regiment (PMD), East Central Luzon Guerrilla Area.

The records of this headquarters indicate that the Pampanga Military District, ECLIGA, was recognized by the Commanding General Sixth Army and the Commanding General, AFPAC with an effective date of recognition of 1 February 1945 for some elements thereof and was subsequently extended revision of initial recognition date for some elements to 15 May 1942 by letter, Headquarters, AFRESMAC, dated 10 December 1946.

A protracted reinvestigation revealed that the revision of the recognition date was not justified. As a result, the revised recognition date of all members of the PMD, ECLIGA, established by the letter from this headquarters, dated 10 December 1946, was revoked on 2 April 1948.

It is desired to inform you that the 5th Pampanga Regiment was included among those elements affected by the letter of 2 April 1948. The recognition date of the 5th Pampanga Regiment therefore is established as 12 February 1945.

Dear Mr. Arnedo:

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the 2nd Battalion, 9th Brigade, Panganga Military District, MILF, purporting to be a guerrilla organization under your active control, is not generally considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

I list a "general requirements for guerrilla recognition, established by General Helderbar during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all substantiating reports and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, investigation of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

1. Record of service are not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence.
 2. The unit was not established authoritatively in the field in opposition to the enemy.
 3. Left-leader of the unit did not contact us materially to the eventual benefit of the enemy.
 4. Adequate reports were not maintained (names, ranks, dates of enlistment or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related information).
 5. Members of the unit did not derive their entire income to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations.
- This decision on the proposed unit matter does not preclude relations for individuals and earnest recognition by those individuals who are qualified and feel justified in entering such classes. Upon request by interested individuals, appropriate forms will be furnished.

REPORT ON 3RD BN, 5TH REGIMENT, PAMPANGA MILITARY DISTRICT, ECIGA

1. Lt Peter R Betts and M/Sgt Frank Bernacki proceeded to Apalit, Pampanga, on 1 September 1946 to investigate the 3rd Bn, 5th Regt, Pampanga Military District, ECIGA.

2. ALLEGED HISTORY: (See unit file)

3. FINDINGS:

a. The following persons were interviewed and their statements are reflected in the findings:

b. Record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. Unit had no papers to support claims of intelligence and propaganda work and submitted only a roster and a history.

c. The unit was not maintained satisfactorily in the field against the enemy, nor did its activities contribute materially to the eventual defeat of the enemy. The unit was formed late in 1944, had only three weapons and had no combat duties during the occupation. During the Liberation the unit was in Sta Rita, but was never called upon to serve with an American unit and returned home after a month.

d. Members of the unit did not devote their entire effort to military activities in the field to the exclusion of normal civilian occupation and family obligations as the majority of the members lived at home and carried on with their own various jobs.

e. Col Ramsey did not know enough about this unit to make a definite statement which he would have if the unit was active.

4. POLITICAL ASPECTS: The unit appears to have no political aspects. *AFFILIATIONS OR ASPIRATIONS.*

5. RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that this unit be not favorably considered for recognition.

The Overall strength of the ECLGA as of 15 May was approximately 33 officers and 395 EM; as of 31 September 1942 was approximately 315 officers and 2,184 EM; as of 31 December 1942 was approximately 863 officers and 7,006 EM; as of 30 June 1943 was approximately 1,241 officers and 10,513 EM; as of 31 December 1943 was approximately 2,040 officers and 21,832 EM; as of 30 June 1944 was approximately 2,823 officers and 30,228 EM; as of 31 December 1944 was approximately 3,606 officers and 38,624 EM; as of 31 June 1945 was approximately 3,700 officers and 39,500 EM. The above figures include casualties. Strength indicated, by official rosters of Headquarters Philippine Army as approved by Headquarters, USAFFE, Headquarters, 6th Army, and Headquarters, AFWESPAC, with the period of service of the individuals not to commence prior to their dates of inductions as shown on the individual reprocessing 201 files in the possession of the Recovered Personnel Division, APO, AFWESPAC, will not be exceeded in determining personnel entitled to pay. Overall strengths mentioned above indicate maximum figures that will not be exceeded.

4. No commissioned ranks above that of Captain are authorized prior to 1 January 1944 with the exception of those USAFFE officers in the rank of captain and above, who were given original appointments with an increase of one grade above their army ranks. Subsequent to 1 January 1944 ranks of officers, commensurate with their command or staff functions and based upon the tables of organization of a US Infantry Division, less one grade, are authorized.

5. a. Recognition as mentioned in paragraph 1, above, is limited to payments of those units listed that served on the Island of Luzon with the ECLGA.

b. All civilians recruited by or inducted into the ECLGA subsequent to 15 May 1942 are considered to have become members of the Philippine Army, served with the Armed Forces of the United States with entitlement to pay subsequent to that date.

6. The East Central Luzon Guerrilla Area has never printed any script for its operational expenditures, depending almost entirely upon donations in kind from the civilian population for sustenance. No personnel, either officer or enlisted, received any pay from the time of its inception on 15 May 1942, until the recognition of those units of ECLGA by attachment, Personnel

were then paid current pay.

1. The roster of troops, 3rd Battalion, 5th Regiment, FMD, BOLGA, consisting of five (5) pages, comprising twenty eight (28) Officers and two hundred seventy one (271) ~~EM~~ embodying Battalion Headquarters and four (4) companies (I, K, L and M) is herewith submitted for recognition.
2. This Battalion of the 5th Regiment, FMD, BOLGA, was organized by authority of Lt. Col. F. B. Fabros, Assistant Chief of Staff during the period from June to September, 1944 and the C and ~~EM~~ of this unit were formally inducted beginning September 1, 1944 (see column in roster for induction dates).
3. During the period from October, 1944 to 15 December 1944, Officers of this Battalion dedicated themselves to acquiring finances and supplies for this unit who were encamped in the Candaba Swamps. Anti-Japanese activities of the unit consisted of espionage, anti-puppet propaganda, dissemination of short-wave news, control of civilians in the area for purpose of evacuation, destruction of a battery of four (4) anti-aircraft guns at the foot of Calumpit Bridge and setting afire of ten (10) boxes of rifle ammunition during an American air raid in December, 1944.
4. From 15 January to 17 January 1945, the unit was assembled at Apalit and alerted to move to join the other units of the Regiment and Division at Santa Rita, Pampanga.
5. On 18 January 1945, the unit marched across the Pampanga plain and reached GMQ, FMD, at Santa Rita, Pampanga on 19 January 1945, but not before a patrol annihilated six Jap stragglers and lost three of its men.
6. From 20 January to 15 February 1945 this unit remained in Santa Rita undergoing training and acting as reserve for reinforcements required from time to time from the Headquarters, FMD, by units of the 11th Corps. During this one month period, the C and ~~EMs~~ of this Battalion were receiving rations and clothing from Headquarters.



7. Due to insufficiency of rations and clothing, 40% of the force became sick and due to lack of adequate medical service and with the permission of Col. Abelardo de Dios, CO, PND, the Battalion was returned to the Apalit Area, there to await call for reinforcements. Immediately thereafter, the C and EMO of this unit who were "USAFFE" returned to military control and so the supervision of the casual troops remained with the Office of the Inspector General.

8. Delay in the submittal of this roster was due to the fact that the officers occupying key positions in this Battalion, after returning to military control of the PA, did not find time early enough to get together and submit these papers. Mention should also be made of the fact that the indifference of the Guerrilla Affairs Officers of the United States Army assigned in the Area resulted in discouragement on the part of the guerrilla troops even to the extent of believing that with the arrival of the American Liberation Forces, the importance of the guerrilla movement has ceased and that the men in the resistance movement, except those who by fortune were able to be attached to United States Army units, will remain unrecognized and uncompensated for their sacrifices.

9. In view of the proximity of the last day (March 15) for the submittal of guerrilla rosters, and in order to avoid delay for these papers to reach AFWESPAC, the herein roster is being submitted direct to AFWESPAC by the undersigned without passing them through the Commanding Officer, Pampanga Military District, ECLGA.

TO : See Distribution

1. a. The guerrilla units listed on attached list have been recognized by the Commander-in-Chief as authorized elements of USAFFE. Under the Provisions of Executive Order No. 21, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 28 October 1944, the status of members of those units, who have served while the unit was in direct support of Sixth Army combat operations, is that of officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Army.

b. At such times as additional units are recognized, you will be forwarded supplementary lists.

2. It is desired that you notify those units on the attached list that are operating under your control that they have been recognized. The rosters of such units, as required by paragraph 3, letter this headquarters, AG 384 A-2, Subject: "Recognition of Guerrilla Units", dated 25 February 1945 which have not yet been submitted will be furnished without delay.

3. It has been noted from recommendations for recognition submitted by US Army organizations that frequently individuals, or groups of 2 to 5 persons, from a large guerrilla unit are the only personnel of such unit serving with the US Army organization. In such cases the unit has not been recommended for recognition. For the payment of such individuals for their services, it is desired that they be included on the payroll of a recognized guerrilla unit serving with your command.
