This will acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated 16 October 1947, requesting the status of the 51st Infantry, G. del Pilar Division, *ECILGA*.

The request for recognition of this unit was initially not favorably considered on 9 May 1946. However, a request for reconsideration of this unfavorable decision was accepted. After a thorough review of all the information upon which the initial decision of non-recognition was based as well as a careful analysis of all additional evidence submitted with the request for reconsideration, the unit was not favorably reconsidered on 13 October 1947. This constituted the final determination of and action upon the request for recognition of the 51st Infantry, G. del Pilar Division, *ECILGA*.

With regard to your inquiry concerning your inclusion on the unit roster, it is suggested that you communicate with your commanding officer for this information.

We regret that a more favorable reply to your inquiry of 16 October 1947 cannot therefore be made.

  - b. Although certification of Gerardo Tolentino indicates he served in the capacity of Private First Class individual is listed on unit roster as a First Lieutenant.
  - c. Certification cover 3 individuals, recognition is requested for 114.
  - d. Authority of Col Ramsey to organize unit has not been presented.
  - e. No evidence has been presented to substantiate guerrilla activities of unit prior to 1945.

2. In view of the discrepancies noted above this request for recognition is not favorably considered.

(Guerrilla Affairs Section)

1. The undersigned, Commanding Officer of the 51st Infantry Regiment, Gregorio del Pilar Division, was authorized by Captain Joseph Barker and Colonel Ramsey to organize guerrilla resistance unit in Manila, Bulacan, Pampanga and Nueva Ecija.
2. I organized the unit in Baliuag, San Ildefonso, and San Miguel, Bulacan and out of it a company of the 8th Battalion was formed under the command of Pedro B. Tolentino as the unit commander. The officers and enlisted men in this unit have rendered valuable services to the guerrilla resistance movement in their own respective sector by combatting the Japanese and other undesirable elements disloyal to the cause.
3. These are bonafied members of the guerrilla under the command of Col. Ramsey which were inducted way back in 1942. For and in consideration of the services rendered by the members of this unit to the cause at the risk of their lives, the undersigned requests they be given justice and privilege of recognition.
4. Attached are pertinent papers of services rendered with the United States Army of liberation.

HISTORY OF "C" COMPANY 8th Bn. AT THE BEGINNING OF  
ITS ORGANIZATION

Just after Japan had bombed Pearl Harbor on Dec. 8, 1941, Capt. Dominador E. Tombo, was commissioned by Commander Joaquin G. Tolentino of the Farmer's Laborer's Auxiliary Service (FLAS) in Manila on 1st August, 1942, as Capt. then promoted to Major on 10 October 1942 and by the assistance of his Executive Officer Capt. Benito F. Chavez organized Company "C" of San Leonardo, Nueva Ecija. This Company("C") was under the direct command of Capt. Ceferino Jimenez and my-self as the Company's Executive Officer.

This Company did underground activities, such as sabotage, harassing the enemies and intelligence work and this were all reported to Hq. in Manila. Our Hqs. were in Jaen, Nueva Ecija, San Leonardo, Nueva Ecija, (barrio Castellano) and Lawang Capang, San Antonio, Nueva Ecija.

That on May 23, 1943 a complete list of Officers and enlisted men was submitted to Capt. Benito F. Chavez in Corcuera, Tondo, Manila.

On the early morning of 24 September, 1943 we ambushed forty (40) Japs in Lawang Capang, San Antonio, Nueva Ecija and we killed twenty (20) of them and captured twenty five (25) Japs rifles. Others fled to the town of San Antonio.


On 12 December 1943, our credentials or appointment papers were distributed to all officers of this company and some are ~~copy~~ attached; Ruben de Guzman, Valentin Villarosa, Roman Rivera, Manuel Samson and of our Commanding Officer's appointment was already attached in the claim filed by his wife Mrs. Catalina R. Jimenez. These credentials were signed D. Doret as Dominador E. Tombo and Ben. C. Flor as Benito F. Chavez, with the official zeal.

On August 1944 Capt. Ceferino Jimenez was accidentally shot in San Isidro, Nueva Ecija and I took command of the Company.

On 3rd October, 1944 near the boundary of San Anton and Castellano, San Leonardo, Nueva Ecija a truck full of Japanese was ambushed by my men. All the Japs in the group have been liquidated. On this engagement we were able to get sixteen (16) Japanese rifles, several hand grenades and the truck burned.

Another engagement took place when on the night of January 24, 1945 I ordered my men to attack by night the Japanese guarding the rice stationed in the church of San Anton. With good luck guiding my men the five Japs on guard were killed and all the rice were distributed to the town people.

On that time we heard news that the Americans are now in Zaragoza under the command of General Krueger so my men and I traveled by night to meet the Liberators. We did not meet any hindrances on the way, to Zaragoza, Nueva Ecija. We met the Liberators with joy on our hearts. Some of my men together with my Training and Planning Officer 2nd Lt. Valentin Villarosa joined the Liberators. It is under this circumstances that our military operations under the leadership of our Chief Executive Benito F. Chavez ended.

TO : Major General Basilio Valdez, Philippine Army Headquarters, A.P.O. #501.

1. I wish to highly commend two Enlisted Men of the Philippine Army Reserve (inactive status), who have been under my personal observation for the past eight months.

2. These men, 1st Sgt. Eliseo Buan and Sgt. Ricardo Pineda, voluntarily joined this Battalion soon after the initial landing at Lingayen Gulf on 9 January 1945, and have served continuously with this Battalion to date. These men worked very closely with me and the Battalion S-2, proving themselves invaluable as interpreters and intelligence men. Due to their excellent character and intelligence, ever forceful initiative, willingness, and strict devotion to duty, they have distinguished themselves as brave aggressive soldiers, displaying at all times the high standards demanded of the American soldier. These men quickly adopted themselves to our methods of operation and progressively became more valuable as scouts on patrols for which they volunteered, and equally as valuable while doing guard duty on their defensive perimeters day and night.

3. It is my understanding that this letter is to accompany their application for commission in the Philippine Army. I believe 1st Sgt. Buan and Sgt. Pineda to be fully qualified for this status and wish to highly recommend them for same. During their entire service with this Battalion, they have served honorably and faithfully and have at all times observed the fine traditions and high standards of the Army of the United States.

4. Because military necessity no longer requires the service of these two men with this organization, they are hereby released from further duty with this organization effective this date, so that they may enlist in the Philippine Army as soon as travel time will permit, as is their desire.

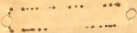
