Lt. Col. Hugh I. Carnahan:

1. The supplemental rosters of units of the "Botolan Sector Sq B, Magsaysay's Forces, ZND, under the command of Capt Jose Magsayoc, composed of the following units were not favorably considered for recognition:

## 2. Basis of non-recognition:

a. Adequate records were not maintained as to dates of enlistments or joining, dates of promotions, and necessary related info. There are no certifications or supporting papers of any type.

b. Record of services was not established by sufficient acceptable evidence. They claim above men were not included in the previous supplemental rosters because they were not yet paid and that only those already paid were included. This affords no proof that these men deserve to be recognized and paid.

c. There is no proof that above men participated in actual combat or were active against the Japs.

d. This unit has previously had 33 men of Hq Co, 82 men of Co A, 79 men of Co B, 55 men of Co C, 61 men of Co D and 36 men of the RF Bn recognized by AFHQSPAC.

The Commanding General has directed that you be informed that the "supplemental rosters of Hq & Hq Co, and Companies A, B, C, and D, Botolan Sector, Squadron "B", Magaway's Forces, 2ND", purporting to be guerrilla organizations under your nominal control, have not been favorably considered for recognition as an element of the Philippine Army.

A set of general requirements for guerrilla recognition established by General MacArthur during the liberation of the Philippines, has been used as a guide in considering the record of this unit. After careful investigation and full consideration of all available substantiating reports and testimony of witnesses having pertinent knowledge, recognition of this guerrilla unit is not deemed to be warranted because of reasons mentioned below:

Adequate records were not maintained as to dates of enlistments or similar dates of promotions, and necessary relative information.

Records of services was not established by sufficient acceptable evidence.

It is considered that the previous recognition of approximately 356 officers and men of the Hq & Hq Co, Companies A, B, C, and D, and MP Battalion, Botolan Sector, Squadron "B", Magaway's Forces which were recognized by the Commanding General, AFWPAC, for their aid during the liberation of the Philippines constitutes adequate and just acknowledgement of military service.

It is requested that you comply with the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, copy attached.

Report on the Botolan Sector, Squadron "B"  
Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, ZMD

In accordance with verbal instructions from Chief of Section, Guerrilla Affairs, C-3, AFWESPAC, Lieutenant Morris S. Flory proceeded to Botolan, Zambales to contact the Botolan Sector, Magsaysay's Forces, ZMD, in order to determine whether or not this organization should be recognized by the United States Army. The following report is a summary of the investigation and basis for the recommendation.

ALLEGED HISTORY

This unit organized in the middle of 1942 but did not function as a military unit. Members left the unit up until June 1943 when the unit was reorganized with permission of Capt. McGuire, placing Capt. Corum as the Commanding officer with a total strength of over 400 men. From this time until the American occupation of Zambales the unit did patrol and intelligence work, but had no encounters with the Japanese.

On 25 January 1945 they began operations in the mountains of Botolan and contacted the 3rd Bn 152 Inf under Lt. Col. Mongold. On the 29 of January 1945, the unit fought the Japs in the Mountains of Botolan which was the first encounter with the enemy. They remained with the 152 Inf until May 1945, after which time they were used in mopping up details, security guards, and patrols for rice planters.

Capt. Corum was discharged from the unit 18 June, 1945 to take charge of civilian operations in the Botolan mountains. Capt Jose Nepomuceno then took over control of the unit and remained as CO until his discharge from the unit at Camp Ord 31 May 1946.

The unit was composed of a Hq & Hq Co, Cos; A, B, C, & D making one Battalion with a peak strength of approximately 700 (reported) in 1945.

FINDINGS

The following named persons are those interviewed by the contact team and their statements are the basis for the findings:

1. Capt Corum -- Former Sector Commander of subject unit
2. Berysain G Balda -- Hq & Hq Co of subject unit
3. Felino L. Escusa -- Hq & Hq Co of subject unit
4. Eduardo B. Rivera -- Hq & Hq Co of subject unit
5. Rufino de Vilksa -- "B" Co of subject unit
6. Alfredo Gonzales -- Judge -- civilian
7. Capt Blanco -- Co of Botolan Special Regiment
8. 1st Lt. Jose Angeles -- Hq & Hq Co of subject unit
9. Cpl Necitas Garcia -- Hq & Hq Co
10. Cpl Alberto Dimalanta -- Co A of subject unit
11. 1st Lt Nicolas Dial -- Co B of subject unit
12. Sgt Teofilo Landero -- Co B of subject unit
13. Pfc Dionisio Acosta -- Co C of subject unit

Upon investigation it was found that this unit in question did only "Home Guard" duty up to the time of the American landings in Luzon.

In their request for recognition they state the men on the supplementary rosters were not included in the previous supplemental rosters because they were not yet paid and that only those already paid were included. This affords no proof that these men deserve to be recognized as a part of the former initial or supplementary roster. Capt. Corum, former Commanding officer of this unit stated that the names were left off because only the names of those men actually on patrol work were submitted, that those men on the supplementary roster were on other duty such as guard, procurement of supplies, etc., but they have no papers to prove such claim.

The unit was at times at odds with the Botolan Special Regiment under Capt Battad, although the former Botolan Sector Commander, Corum and Battad are cousins.

It was also apparent in the investigation that a rotation system was used by the unit, members working one or two days a week and working on their farms the remainder of the week. It is concluded that members of this organization did not have full time status as a guerrilla, except those already recognized. It is also believed that the members of the unit worthy of recognition have been recognized with the above mentioned units.

POLITICAL ASPECTS

The Botolan Sector, including both the Botolan Special Regiment under Capt Patted, and The Botolan Sector under Nepomuceno, let politics interfere with the guerrilla organization in as much that names were omitted from the rosters unless that person agreed with the political aspirations of the leaders.

RECOMMENDATIONS

After careful consideration of the statements made by the present members and an analysis of the documents presented, it is recommended that with the exception of those members previously recognized, the Botolan Sector, Squadron B, Magsaysay's Guerrilla Forces, Zamboales Military District, be not favorably considered for recognition.

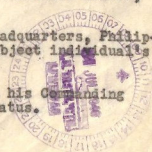

I was a Sergeant in the Western Luzon Guerrilla Forces USAFFE, and therefore a duly recognized guerrilla, our Commanding Officer, Capt. Ralph McGuire, U.S. Army, having assured us that he was authorized by General McArthur, through Col. Thorpe, to organize USAFFE Guerrillas. (See attached copy of certification of Capt. Antonio Decano, former Adjutant to said Capt. Ralph McGuire).

Without going, for the present, into my guerrilla activities prior to the liberation, I enclose herewith copies of certifications and commendation showing my services to the 3rd Bn 152nd Inf. 38 Division, U.S. Army. (Originals are in my position.)

I have not been paid any salary as yet. I have not been processed or demobilized. The Commanding Officer of my Unit has failed to give me the necessary instructions therefore; and whenever I approach him for orders, for some reasons other, he has paid no attention to me.





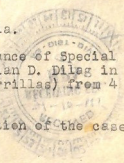

Nov 4- Appointed as 2nd Lt. Luzon Guerrilla Force Botolan Sector by Capt. Ralph McGuire (USA) Commanding Officer Luzon Guerrilla Force (See Attached true copy of my appointment)

1942- 1943:

During this period Guerrilla situation in Zambales was very precarious and critical due to Jap mopping up campaign from all directions of Zambales coordinated by Aerial bombing and Cavalry action in the mountains.

During this period I was assigned as S-2 operative in the barrios of Santiago, Mambog and Taogtog to make reports of Jap movements in those localities and of any contemplated and actual raid of our mountain hideout. This year was the gloomiest year of our Guerrilla activities due to the killing of our Chieftain Capt Ralph McGuire and several others. Due to this untimely death we were disorganized and inactive for a while.

1944:

Resumed my contact with the mountain hideout. During this time I was operating with Lt. Gervasio Dicag and 3 others all of Special Regiment Zambales Guerrillas under Capt Gervasio Blanco. During this time I was feeding several families of Guerrillas in the mountain hideout from my own supply and from my own pocket not a single cent of which was charged to the government.

Sometime in Sept 1944, While the Americans were landing in Leyte, I hid and harbored in my house 2 american aviators who were to report to Col. Merrill with a secret mission. I was informed by Capt Montalla their escort, that he delivered the 2 american pilots to Capt Ramon Magsaysay Executive Officer of Col Merrill safely.

1945:

March 2 - April 28, 1945. Reported to Capt Kimberlain USA, C.O. Co. "K" 152nd Inf 38th Div at Botolan Zambales. While on duty with this outfit I was given the particular assignment of a Guerrilla Mess Officer with specific duties, Guerrillas who were going for combat duties.

April 29-May 6, 1945- At Castilljos Zambales performing same duties as above. May 6- 1945- May 16, 1945- At Montalban with the same outfit and with the same work.




